GAME PREVIEW

• After picking up a 14-3 victory over Lehigh in Annapolis on Tuesday, Navy (5-1, 2-0 Patriot League) will look to keep its three-game winning streak intact when it battles league foe Holy Cross (3-2, 0-2 Patriot League) on Saturday in Dallas ... the two teams are slated to faceoff at 1:00 pm Eastern, 12:00 pm Central at Texas Stadium, the home of the Dallas Cowboys.

• There will be NO radio coverage for the game, however fans are invited to follow the game via Gametracker which is located on Navy's official web site, www.NavySports.com.

• Eight different players scored goals, including junior mid-fielder **Sean Standen** who turned in his first collegiate hat trick, to lead the Mids to their 23rd consecutive win over Lehigh ... Navy owned a 3-0 advantage after the first quarter, a 6-1 lead at the half and owned a 10-1 advantage after three quarters of play ... the Mids' defense not only held Lehigh without a goal in the opening period of action, the Mountain Hawks were unable to get a shot off.

• Since picking up an impressive 7-6 victory over Yale on Feb. 24, the Crusaders have dropped two of their last three, both game against Patriot League teams ... Holy Cross is coming off a 15-5 loss at the hands of Colgate ... Edison Parzanese and Luke Marchand each scored markers for the Crusaders.

TEXAS WELCOMES NAVY

• This is the second year in a row that Navy has traveled to the state of Texas to play a regular-season contest.

• Last year, Navy defeated Patriot League foe Holy Cross, 12-2, at SMU's Ford Stadium in Dallas ... it was the first Div. I men's lacrosse game in the Dallas Metroplex and the first trip back to the state since the Mids beat Johns Hopkins, 9-6, on May 8, 1971, at the Houston Astrodome.

• Navy returns to Dallas this Saturday where it will once again compete against Holy Cross, but this time Texas Stadium will play host to the Mids and Crusaders.

• The Navy-Holy Cross game is part of a four-game showcase dubbed the 2008 Ford Patriot Cup which will feature some of the nation's premier collegiate and high school programs.

• As title sponsor of the event, the North Texas Ford Dealers will present a check in the amount of \$20,000 to the North Texas Chapter of U.S. Lacrosse and donate 1,000 tickets to Navy and Army personnel.

• All proceeds from the event will benefit the Wounded Warrior Project, a non-profit organization which provides programs and services to the severely injured service members returning home from Iraq and Afghanistan.

NAVY VS. HOLY CROSS — THE SERIES

• Saturday's contest between Navy and Holy Cross will be just the fifth meeting between the two programs, while it is the second consecutive year in which the Mids and Crusaders battle in Dallas.

• Navy has won all four games in the series, including the inaugural meeting in which the Mids man-handled the Crusaders, 23-5, in Annapolis.

• Navy has scored eight or more goals in all four games, while producing double figure markers in three of the four ... the Mids' defense, however, has held Holy Cross to five or fewer goals in every game.

TAKING THE FIELD IN ...

10 - Dating back to last year's Johns Hopkins game, senior attack **Nick Mirabito** has produced an assist in 10 straight contests.

9 - Sophomore **Tim Paul** has turned in nine multi-goal games during his career, including a team-best four this season.

8 - Eight of Navy's 15 players who have scored goals this season are first-time goal scorers ... only two of the eight are freshmen.

7 - Navy has scored seven or more goals in all six games this year.

6 - With his two-goal, four-assist performance against Lehigh on Tuesday, senior **Nick Mirabito** tied his career with six points.

5 - Over the last five years, Navy, along with Johns Hopkins, own the most wins in D-I lacrosse with 54.

4 - Navy's defense has held four of its six opponents scoreless in the opening period, including each of the last three.

3 - Coming into this season, senior **Gregory Clement** had scored three of his four career goals against Holy Cross, including two in last year's game played in Dallas.

2 - Since the beginning of 2004, Navy has lost just two games against unranked opponents (32-2).

1 - Senior **Nick Mirabito** has been held without a point just once in his 52-game career, last year's double overtime loss to Maryland.

THE LAST TIME ...

- Attack **Nick Mirabito** scored three goals and assisted on two others to lead the fifth-ranked Navy Midshipmen to an easy 12-2 Patriot League victory over Holy Cross in front of 4,482 fans at Gerald J. Ford Stadium on the campus of Southern Methodist University.
- The game was the first Division I lacrosse game played in the Dallas Metroplex area.
- Mirabito scored an unassisted goal in the first period, scored off an assist from **Terence Higgins** in the second, scored off an assist from Billy Looney in the third and then assisted on back-to-back goals by Ian Dingman to end the third period.
- The Mids' defense was sensational all day, shutting out the Crusaders until late in the fourth period.
- Senior goalie **Colin Finnegan** came up with nine saves and did not allow a goal before leaving the contest with 3:46 left.
- The Navy offense also got goals from Higgins in the first, **Basil Daratsos** and **Matt Guido**, off an assist from Dingman, in the second, **Gregory Clement**, who was returning to his hometown, scored two fourth-quarter goals, **Joe McAuliffe** scored his first-career goal off the first-career assist from **Dan Vassar** in the fourth and **Andy Tormey** scored his first-career goal on a man down situation to round out the scoring.

NEUTRAL GROUND

• As a whole, neutral site games have been an oddity during the 101-year history at the Naval Academy ... just 16 games have been played on neutral ground.

• That said, during head coach Richie Meade's tenure, 13 games have been played at a neutral site with Saturday's Navy-Holy Cross game being the 14th.

• Navy owns a 10-6 overall record in neutral site matches, including a 9-4 mark under Meade.

• Over the last five seasons Richie Meade's Midshipmen have become accustomed to playing at least one neutral site regular-season game ... in 2004 Navy played Colgate in Orlando, in 2005, Navy opened the season against Providence by playing at Branford High School in Connecticut and later played Colgate in Orlando ... in 2006, Navy and Bucknell battled one another in San Diego at the First 4 Invitational ... in 2007, Navy faced Holy Cross in Texas ... this season, the Mids dropped a heartbreaker to Cornell in overtime in Long Island on Feb. 23.

FAST FACTS

• Navy senior attack **Nick Mirabito** has turned in a goal or an assist in 51 of the 52 games in which he has played during his career ... his 40-game streak was snapped against Maryland last spring and was the second-longest active streak in Div. I lacrosse at the time ... he is currently riding an 11-game consecutive points run, including six straight games with a goal and 10 straight with an assist.

• Two players have turned in hat trick this season ... Nick Mirabito has pitched a hat trick in two of the last four games, while junior **Sean Standen** is coming off his first collegiate three-goal performance in Navy's win over Lehigh.

• Navy has held the lead at halftime in every game this season ... the Mids have lost 12 in a row when trailing at the break and 57 straight when trailing after three quarters of play.

• The Mids have held five of their six opponents to seven or fewer goals this season ... Navy has won 17 in a row when achieving this feat.

• Navy's defense has held four of its six opponents scoreless in the opening period, including each of the last three ... the Mids have outscored their opponents, 14-3, in the first quarter, 5-0 in league action.

• Navy has put more shots on goal in the first half (70) than its opponents have shot as a whole in the first half (60, 32 on goal)

• Five different players have accounted for Navy's five game-winners this season ... ironically, the two top goal producers on the team, **Nick Mirabito** and **Tim Paul**, are without a game-winner.

MEET THE MIDS

• Navy will hold its annual "Meet the Mids" event on Saturday, March 29, following Navy's game against nationally-ranked Georgetown (5:00 pm) at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium.

• Members of the 10th-ranked Navy men's lacrosse team will be available for autographs on the Blue Concourse, with the first 300 kids in line for the postgame autograph session receiving a Navy lacrosse "Meet the Mids" t-shirt, compliments of Chick-fil-A.

• In addition, Navy's 2008 lacrosse poster and an autograph card will be available, while prizes will be handed out.

PATRIOT LEAGUE SUCCESS

- Since joining the Patriot League in 2004, Navy is 33-2 (.943) against opponents from the league, including an 8-0 mark in the Patriot League Tournament ... the Mids lost regular-season contests to Bucknell in '05 and Colgate in '06.
- The Mids have produced undefeated marks in conference action in two of the last four-plus years ... 7-0 in 2004 and 6-0 in '07.
- Navy has won at least a share of the Patriot League regular-season title in each of its first four years as a member of the league ... additionally, the Mids have claimed the league's tournament crown all four years.
- 24 different Mids have garnered All-Patriot League recognition, while 13 of the 24 have earned honors multiple times.
- Richie Meade was named the 2004 Patriot League Coach of the Year after leading the Mids to a flawless 7-0 mark in league competition ... he received the award a second time after guiding Navy to a 6-0 record last spring.

A DOMINANT STRETCH

- Navy is in the midst of one of its most dominant five-year runs in school history ... since the start of the 2004 season, Navy owns a 54-16 record (.771).
- Along with Johns Hopkins, Navy's 54 wins are the most in the country, while the Mids' .771 winning percentage is third behind Johns Hopkins (.818) and Cornell (.787).
- During that same stretch, Navy is 22-14 (.611) against ranked teams and 32-2 mark (.941) against unranked foes.
- Since the start of the 2004 season, Navy owns a 7-6 (.538) record against teams ranked higher than it in the USILA Coaches Poll ... against lower ranked or unranked teams, Navy is 47-10 (.825).
- The Mids have posted a 28-6 (.824) record at home, outscoring their foes, 388-215 during that span ... just four teams have reached double digits on Navy's home field during that stretch.
- The Mids are also respectable on road, owning an 18-7 record in true road affairs over the last five years and defeating 11 ranked teams in the process ... two of Navy's seven road losses have come against unranked Patriot League opponents.
- Over the last four-plus seasons, the Mids have produced the top-three win totals in school history ... in 2004, Navy won 15 games en route to its NCAA Championship game appearance and in 2005, the Mids produced 12 wins in earning their second-consecutive NCAA Tournament berth ... Navy won 11 games in 2006 and '07.
- The Class of 2007 became the winningest class in school history on March 21, 2007, when it claimed its 45th win in 56 contests ... the Class of '07 graduated having won 49 of its 64 contests (.766) ... the Class of '06 turned in a 44-18 record (.710) ... the Class of '08 owns a 39-13 record (.750).

MORE ON THE MIDS' SUCCESS

- Behind a 12-1 win over Army in the Patriot League Tournament semifinals last spring, the Mids picked up their 10th win of the season, marking the fourth consecutive year Navy has won 10 or more games ... it's only the second time in program history and the first time since 1975-78, the Mids have strung together double-figure wins in four straight years (15 in 2004, 12 in 2005, 11 in 2006 and 11 in 2007).
- Navy's defense has given up double-figure goals just five times (Army in '06, Colgate, Georgetown, Johns Hopkins and North Carolina in '07) in its last 36 games (2006-present), seven times in the last 52 (2005-present) and 11 times in the last 70 games (2004-present) ... dating back to 2003, Navy has won 32-straight games when holding its foes to five or fewer goals.

MIRABITO CLIMBS THE CHARTS

- Senior attack **Nick Mirabito** is active on Navy's career leader board in four categories — points, goals, assists and shots.
- Mirabito is one of just six players in the program's 101-year history who has scored 80 goals, dished out 50 assists and topped 100 points.
- Behind a career-high tying six-point performance against Lehigh on Tuesday, Mirabito jumped from 15th to 12th on the Mids' career points list with 135 ... he is only five points shy of tying future Hall of Famer Glen Miles who amassed 140 (65-75) between 1983-86.
- Mirabito is 15 points away from becoming only the ninth player in program history to reach 150 points ... should he achieve that feat, he would be the third player under Richie Meade's guidance to do so and the third in the last three years (Jon Birsner with 154 in 2006; Ian Dingman with 188 in '07).
- Mirabito broke into the program's top 10 for career goals thanks to his pair against the Mountain Hawks ... he is tied for 10th with 84, alongside all-time leading points producer Jeff Long (1974-77).
- Mirabito has turned in 20 or more goals in each of the previous three seasons and midway through the year, he is halfway there with a team-leading 11 markers.
- With 51 career assists, Mirabito is 14th on the helpers chart, needing three to tie Syd Abernethy (1978-81) ... Mirabito needs 17 assists over the next seven-plus games to finish his career in the top 10.
- Finally, Mirabito is ranked 18th in career shots, blasting 236 over four years ... he is three behind 17th-place Matt Long (1992-95) and 60 away from being in the top 10.

MAKING THEIR MARK

- Plenty has been said about the number of new faces Navy has put out on the field this season ... and plenty has been produced in turn by those new names.
- Six of Navy's top 10 scorers have recorded more points already this season than they had coming into the year ... only senior **Nick Mirabito**, and sophomores **Tim Paul** and **Basil Daratsos** had turned in more points ... the 10th player is newcomer **Andy Warner** who was a senior in high school a year ago.
- Excluding Warner, three of the players had never scored a point prior to this season.

FIRST-TIMERS

- Fifteen different players have scored goals for the Midshipmen this season ... eight of those 15 are first-time scorers and only two of the eight are freshmen.
- Scoring their first collegiate goals this season are: senior **Dan Decker**, juniors **Michael Beggins**, **Shane Durkin** and **Bobby Lennon**, sophomores **Brendan Connors** and **Joe Lennon** and rookies **Brian Striffler** and **Andy Warner**.

DINOLA NAMED TO TEWAARATON WATCH LIST

- Senior close defenseman **Jordan DiNola** has been named to the 2008 Tewaaraton Award Preseason Watch List ... the Tewaaraton Trophy is awarded to the nation's top lacrosse player.
- DiNola is among 51 players named to the preseason list released Feb. 21.
- A two-time All-American, DiNola has seen action in 48 of the 52 games over his three-plus year career ... he's been a starter on Navy's nationally-ranked defense in each of the last three seasons ... he was voted the 2008 Patriot League Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.
- It's the fifth consecutive year a Navy player has been named to the watch list, joining Ian Dingman in 2004, Graham Gill Mitch Hender, Steve Looney and Matt Russell in 2005, Ian Dingman, Billy Looney, Steve Looney and Matt Russell in 2006 and Billy Looney in 2007.

TOUGH "D"

- Since 2000, Navy's defense has been ranked No. 1 in the country three times, including 2005 and '06 ... the Mids have been ranked in the top four in each of the last five years.
- Navy has held 31 of its last 70 opponents to five or fewer goals, and only 10 foes (Ohio State, Army and Syracuse in '04, Georgetown and Virginia in '05, Army '06 and Colgate, Georgetown, Johns Hopkins and North Carolina in '07) have managed to reach double figures.
- Since 2004, Navy has held 35 of its 70 opponents to 25 or fewer shots and is 32-3 (Ohio State 2004, Colgate 2006, Maryland 2007).
- Navy has lost just eight games when holding foes to nine or fewer goals since 2004, posting a 46-8 mark ... two of the losses came in overtime during the 2005 campaign (Bucknell and Johns Hopkins), losses in '06 were to Colgate, Georgetown (twice) and Johns Hopkins, while Maryland managed to nip the Mids in overtime in '07, as did Cornell in '08.

NATIONAL LEADER BOARD

- The NCAA released its first round of statistics last Tuesday morning ... the Mids are among the top 10 in scoring defense (4th) and man-down defense (8th) ... the Mids' man-down team has surrendered just two goals on 11 opportunities this season ... Navy is ranked in the top 20 in three additional categories; face-off percentage (12th), extra-man offense (14th) and scoring margin (14th).
- Junior keeper **Matt Coughlin** owns the third-lowest goals-against average in the country, giving up 5.40 goals per game, while he is ranked 33rd in save percentage (.542) ... he improved upon both of those averages following the Lehigh game and now owns a 5.10 GAA and 55.9 save percentage.
- Senior faceoff specialist **Mikelis Visgauss** is No. 5 in the nation with a 63.0 draw percentage and is 24th in ground balls per game (5.3).
- Senior **Nick Mirabito** is among the top 60 in points per game (24th), goals per game (56th) and assists per game (20th).
- Navy finished the 2007 campaign ranked among the top 10 in five statistical categories.
- Navy was the only program in the country a year ago to have both its extra-man and man-down units ranked among the top 11 ... the Mids finished 11th on extra-man offense (.365) and sixth on man-down defense (.784).
- Navy finished the 2007 campaign as one of five teams ranked among the nation's top 10 in both scoring offense and defense ... Navy was 10th in scoring offense (11.00) and third in scoring defense (6.60) ... joining the Midshipmen were Cornell (1/5), Duke (3/8), Notre Dame (4/4) and Ohio State (8/9).

A CLOSER LOOK AT NAVY'S SCHEDULE

- Seven of Navy's 13 regular-season opponents this season are among the nation's top 20 teams according to the March 10 edition of the USILA Coaches Poll ... Johns Hopkins is the highest ranking foe at fourth, while Maryland is sixth and Cornell is 10th ... Georgetown is just outside of the top 10 in 12th, while Patriot League foes Bucknell (T14th) and Army (18th) are among the top 20 ... Ohio State inched its way back into the rankings this week at No. 19 after beating Penn State over the weekend.
- Navy owns a 1-1 record against its foes who currently appear in the national rankings.
- Since the start of the 2004 season, Navy has played 36 of its 70 games against teams ranked in the top 25, posting a 22-14 record ... two of the losses have come against the No. 1-ranked team in the country at the time (Johns Hopkins twice) ... meanwhile, four of the losses have been at the hands of Georgetown ('05, '06 2x, '07) ... other losses to ranked teams in that span were against No. 20 Ohio State ('04), No. 4 Syracuse ('04), No. 7 Georgetown ('05), No. 6 Virginia ('05), No. 5 Georgetown ('06), No. 12 Johns Hopkins ('06), No. 5 Georgetown ('06), No. 7 Georgetown ('07), No. 11 Maryland ('07), No. 7 Johns Hopkins ('07), No. 9 North Carolina ('07) and No. 6 Cornell ('08).
- In fact, since the start of the 2000 campaign, 66 of Navy's 122 games have been against ranked teams ... in those games against ranked opponents, Navy is 34-32 (.523).
- In games against unranked foes since 2000, Navy is 51-5 (.911) ... the losses have come to UMBC ('01), Air Force and Penn State ('03), Bucknell ('05) and Colgate ('06).

NAVY TRIO HONORED BY THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

- Three Navy players have garnered weekly recognition from the Patriot League this season.
- Patriot League Preseason Defensive Player of the Year **Jordan DiNola** was the league's defensive player of the week in the inaugural week of selections (2/19), while first-year starting keeper **Matt Coughlin** picked up goalkeeper of the week honors.
- DiNola and Coughlin helped lead Navy to a pair of victories to open the season ... Navy's defensive unit held VMI to just a pair of goals, while surrendering just seven goals in the Mids' 8-7 overtime win at Ohio State.
- The following week senior attack **Nick Mirabito** was named the offensive player of the week after pitching in his first hat trick of the season in a tough 8-7 overtime loss to sixth-ranked Cornell.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE

- Since the start of 2004, Navy has been on television 24 times (7 appearances in '04, 6 in '05 and '06, five in '07).
- The Mids will make a minimum of six appearances on television this season ... the Colgate (3/23), Georgetown (3/29) and Johns Hopkins (4/19) will be televised by CBS College Sports Network, while back-to-back road games at Maryland (4/4) and Army (4/12) will be aired by ESPNU ... the Mids' neutral site matchup against Cornell was televised tape-delayed by MASN on Feb. 28.

Navy's Success Under Meade

- Among active coaches, he's ranked 13th by wins (142) and 17th in winning % (.622)
- He is the 39th winningest coach in NCAA history by wins and 41st by winning %.
- Has led Navy to four-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 1986-87-88-89.
- Led the Mids to the National Championship Game in 2004 for the first time since 1975.
- In 2004, became the fourth coach in school history to receive the Morris Touchstone Memorial Award as the National Coach of the Year.
- Has helped mold an All-American in all 13 seasons at the Naval Academy with 16 different players earning the distinction.
- Seven players earned All-America honors in 2004, the most since the 1975 campaign.
- Produced Navy's first Kelly Award winner, Mickey Jarboe in 1999 and 2000, since Leonard Supko garnered the honor in 1970. Matt Russell, a 2006 graduate, received the Kelly Award in 2004.
- Navy has won 10 or more games in each of the last four seasons for only the second time in program history and the first time since 1975-78.

A balanced attack and a stifling defense led 12th-ranked Navy (1-0) to a 10-2 victory over VMI (0-1) in Annapolis. It was the earliest Navy has played a season-opener and the first game on tap this season in Div. I lacrosse.

The Mids' balanced offensive attack featured eight different players scoring Navy's 10 goals, including four first-time scorers.

Navy opened up a 3-0 lead after the first 15 minutes of play with sophomore attack **Tim Paul** punching in the season's first goal for the Mids at the 8:27 mark. The play was cued by first-year starting keeper **Matt Coughlin** whose outlet pass to mid-field field set up the goal. A few quick one-timers around and rookie attack **Andy Warner** saw Paul cutting to the crease and Paul popped it in over VMI keeper Sean McCoy's shoulder.

Navy's next two goals were near mirror images of one another as sophomore middle **Patrick Moran** ripped the back of the next from 10 yards out at 7:20, followed by junior midfielder **Shane Durkin's** first-collegiate goal from just outside of 10 yards.

VMI finally got on the board when Hill made a sensational move curling around the backside of the goal and shooting the ball as he left his feet. Horizontal to the goal, Hill somehow threaded the ball between the defender and Coughlin to narrow the margin to two (3-1) with more than 10:30 remaining in the second quarter.

While Navy would go on to get just one goal in the second stanza, the marker by sophomore midfielder **Joe Lennon**, his first, at 5:30 would be the first of seven consecutive goals for the Midshipmen.

Navy pushed its lead to 8-1 after three quarters with goals from senior **Nick Mirabito**, **Sean Standen**, Warner and **Bobby Lennon**. Warner, meanwhile, scored his first collegiate goal when senior midfielder **Terence Higgins** intercepted a pass at mid-field and got it to Mirabito who then fed Warner. Additionally, the elder Lennon, Bobby, also scored his first collegiate goal, as senior attack **Matt Guido** sent him the ball with 1:02 remaining in the third quarter.

Paul scored his second goal off Mirabito's second assist at 9:19, while Standen turned in his second collegiate multi-goal game when he punched in his second with 7:43 remaining in the game to give Navy a 10-1 lead.

The Keydets stopped the Navy run at 6:06 when Tim Moran fed Brett Leonard for the score with 6:06 to go in the contest.

Navy's defense forced 21 Keydet turnovers, including 13 in the first half. Meanwhile, it held VMI to just 21 shots.

Scoring his first-collegiate goal, junior midfielder **Michael Beggins** ripped a shot at keeper Stefan Shroder's ankles just over two minutes into overtime to lead 12th-ranked Navy (2-0) to an 8-7 victory over Ohio State (0-1) at The 'Shoe in Columbus, Ohio.

Navy, who led by as many as four goals early in the second half, held a one-goal lead with 10 seconds remaining when OSU forced a Navy turnover. The Buckeyes sent an outlet pass up the sideline where it was met by Preseason All-American attack Kevin Buchanan who took a shot from eight yards out on the right wing and scored as time ran out.

Navy senior **Mikelis Visgauss** won a crucial faceoff to start the overtime period, giving the Mids possession. Navy would fired off five shots, including a one-timer by Beggins that would be knocked down by Shroder, but kept in play. Sophomore **Joe Lennon** took the next shot that clanged off the far post before **Basil Daratsos** hit the cross bar. Finally, Beggins was fed the ball and fired in what will be a memorable goal for he and his teammates.

It was a battle for momentum throughout the game, as Navy opened up a 3-0 lead with 4:45 remaining in the first period. Sophomore **Tim Paul** gave Navy the lead just 46 seconds into the game, as he scored an extra-man goal after a slashing was called on on the opening face-off.

OSU finally got on the board when Buchanan punched in the first of his three goals at 3:52 in the first stanza.

The Buckeyes did a fine job of possessing the ball in the early minutes of the second quarter. Junior Peet Poillon pulled the Buckeyes to within one at 3-2 when he topshelved his shot past junior keeper **Matt Coughlin** at 10:32.

Navy, though, cushioned its lead when senior **Gregory Clement** found Lennon who was successful by going high to low and sneaking his shot past Shroder's right ankle.

Leading 4-2 to open the second half, Navy wasted little time in attacking, as Paul produced his second goal of the day on a 10-yarder 53 seconds into the third, followed by a pretty play by Daratsos who threaded a pass through OSU's zone and found **Nick Mirabito**.

Joel Dalgarno's goal with 10:34 left in the third was the first of four-consecutive goals for the Buckeyes which featured back-to-back goals just 33 seconds apart that knotted the game at six apiece.

At the 4:20 mark, Clement scored the go-ahead goal for the Mids when he was met by an Ohio State defender and was forced to shoot the ball behind his back. The pretty shot surprised Shroder who stood between the pipes and gave way to a 7-6 Navy lead.

Junior attack Chris Finn scored an unassisted goal just over a minute into overtime to lead No. 6 Cornell (1-0) to an 8-7 victory over 12th-ranked Navy (2-1) at Mitchel Athletic Complex in Uniondale, N.Y. Navy held a two-goal lead with a minute remaining in regulation, but goals by Ryan Hurley (0:53) and All-American Max Seibald (0:12) left Navy without an answer to the Big Red's furious fury in suffering its first loss of the 2008 campaign.

Cornell took an early 2-0 lead in the game as Ryan Hurley fed Mike Corbolotti from behind the cage and Corbolotti stuck the goal from the crease. With just under four minutes remaining in the opening period, Hurley curled around the right side of the cage, sneaking his shot past junior keeper **Matt Coughlin**.

Navy trimmed the lead to one just a minute later when Cornell keeper Jake Myers was unable to come up with the ball after stopping **Shane Durkin's** shot. The ball popped back out in front of the cage where senior **Nick Mirabito** scooped up the ball and scored.

Navy ended the half by scoring four goals in just over four minutes, including a 10-yarder from sophomore midfielder **Basil Daratsos** who was able to get around his defender and spark the Navy run at 4:07.

With just 15.6 seconds remaining in the opening half, Navy took a 5-4 lead when rookie **Andy Warner** curled around the right side of the cage looking for a crease man to cut. His pass ricocheted off a Cornell defender and shot up over the keeper's reach and into the goal.

Navy's defense played its best game of the year in the third quarter, holding the Big Red to just one shot.

With four seconds remaining in the quarter, Myers had the ball in the cage where he was looking to throw an outlet pass. Instead, his pass went straight into the outstretched stick of Mirabito standing at the crease and Mirabito completed the hat trick, giving the Mids a 6-4 lead heading into the final stanza.

The Mids took advantage of a Cornell foul as Mirabito found sophomore **Patrick Moran** to push Navy's lead to a comfortable three-goal margin at 7-4.

John Espey cut the Navy lead to two when he wrapped around the left side and sent a shot from five yards out.

Cornell forced a Navy turnover with just over a minute to play with Seibald throwing the outlet pass to Glynn who found Hurley and he sank his 10-yard shot with 53 seconds remaining.

With 12.8 seconds left, Seibald sank an 8-yard shot over the shoulder of Coughlin and sent the game into OT.

Navy's starting attack scored six goals and pitched in five assists to lead the 10th-ranked Midshipmen to a 12-5 victory over Mount St. Mary's (0-2) at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium.

Senior **Nick Mirabito** led the Mids with five points on a team-best three goals and two assists. Navy saw second-year attack **Tim Paul** punch in two goals, while assisting on two others and senior **Gregory Clement** turned in a goal and an assist.

The game got off to a slow start as both teams found it difficult to take care of the ball. Though Mount St. Mary's seemed to have possession for much of the early portion of the game, it managed just one shot in the opening 15 minutes. Navy finally got on the scoreboard when Paul fed Clement from behind the goal and Clement stuck the ball over rookie keeper T.C. DiBartolo's shoulder at 4:37.

Navy added to its lead just before the end of the quarter when sophomore **Brendan Connors** found **Michael Beggins** who ripped a 10-yarder from the left side with 51 seconds remaining. It was the first assist of Connors' career.

Mount St. Mary's briefly stopped the Mids by scoring an extra-man goal at 12:09 in the second stanza. Top returning scorer Joe Derwent worked with Geery Grant to narrow Navy's lead to just one (2-1).

The Mids went on to score the next three goals to lead 5-1 with 3:27 to go in the opening half. Among the three goals was a nice transition play that began behind the Mount St. Mary's cage with defensive midfielder **Bobby Lennon** picking up the loose ball. Lennon sent an outlet pass to mid-field where **Zack Schroeder** quickly found Paul. Paul took off with only the keeper to beat and after cocking back, he unleashed a powerful shot that rippled the back of the net before DiBartolo realized it was out of Paul's stick.

It was the Mount who got the final say by half's end as Dan Mohr stationed himself on the far left crease where Jim O'Shea threaded a pass and Mohr scored on an ankle biter to send Mount St. Mary's to the locker room down, 5-2.

Navy opened up an 8-2 lead four minutes into the final half by scoring three quick goals, including an extra-man strike by sophomore **Joe Lennon** 21 seconds into the half.

The two teams traded goals to wind down the third period with the Midshipmen holding a comfortable 9-3 lead.

The fourth quarter featured five goals, three by Navy and a pair by the Mount. Two of Navy's three goals in the final stanza were scored by sophomore local product **Patrick Moran**, who finished with two goals and an assist.

The Mount, whose team is made up of half freshmen, were led by Mohr and O'Shea who each pitched in a pair of goals to go along with Geery's strike. Making just his second collegiate appearance, DiBartolo was sensational in the goal early on, making 13 stops.

Tenth-ranked Navy (4-1, 1-0 PL) let little stand in its way of picking up a victory over Lafayette (2-2, 0-1 PL) in its Patriot League opener, not even the weather. After a 15-minute delay due to lightning, the Mids braved a driving rain storm that included periods of sleet and wind gusts of 20 miles per hour as they cruised to an 8-5 win over the Leopards.

Due to the rain-soaked turf and the pouring rain, both teams had a difficult time holding onto the ball early in the game. The two teams finally settled down and into an offense after the first five minutes and Navy got on the scoreboard when Sophomore midfielder **Joe Lennon** found an opening past Lafayette keeper Jeff Canfield at the 8:30 mark. Just under two minutes elapsed when senior **Nick Mirabito** sat behind the goal and found **Gregory Clement** standing on the crease, giving Navy a 2-0 advantage.

The Mids pushed their lead to 4-0 when junior **Shane Durkin** and Lennon scored back-to-back goals a minute apart from nearly the same position on the field. Lennon's shot was perfectly placed as he was able to bounce it through Canfield's legs for his second score of the day.

To Lafayette's credit, it remained poised and freshman attack Tom Perini, like so many times this season, carried the torch to get his Leopards back into the game. Working with second-year attack Matt Mersky, Perini punched in back-to-back goals at 6:52 and 4:09 to narrow the Mids' lead to just two.

Navy, answered however, as Mirabito fed sophomore attack **Tim Paul** at the crease and Paul was forced to shoot the ball from over his shoulder, rippling the net to give Navy a 5-2 lead with three minutes remaining in the half.

With 2:02 to go, the Mersky-Perini combination struck once again with Perini turning in the hat trick to cut Navy's lead to 5-3 heading into the half.

The Mids opened the second half with a quick strike from Clement, who fired off a 10-yard shot from the left side off Lennon's pass. Though Navy struck quickly, it would be the only goal scored in the period by either team, as the Mids' defense held the Leopards to just one shot in the third.

Lafayette cut into Navy's lead just eight seconds into the final stanza when Mersky was found to be in the right place at the right time. He picked up a ground ball on the doorstep after Navy's **Matt Coughlin** stopped a Lafayette shot, but was unable to reel it in. Mersky grabbed the grounder and poked it in. The Leopards got as close as just one goal with 10 minutes remaining in the game when starting middle Steve Serling scored an unassisted goal.

Less than 90 seconds later, Lennon fed sophomore midfielder **Patrick Moran** to push Navy's lead to two and Mirabito fired in his lone goal of the day to seal the win for the Mids with 4:18 remaining.

Turning in his first collegiate hat trick, junior midfielder **Sean Standen** was one of eight different players to score for the Mids as 11th-ranked Navy rolled to a 14-3 victory over Lehigh at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. The Mids, who are now 5-1 overall and 2-0 in conference play, have won 23 consecutive games against the Mountain Hawks.

Not only did Standen score goals a plenty, so, too, did **Gregory Clement**, **Tim Paul**, **Nick Mirabito** and **Patrick Moran**, who each pitched in a pair of goals, while Mirabito added a career-high four assists to finish with six points.

Navy's defense complemented its offense, holding Lehigh without a shot in the opening period and 23 for the game. It marked the fourth time this season that Navy's opponent has been held scoreless in the opening 15 minutes of action, including the third straight game. The Mountain Hawks scored their first goal of the game at 8:29 in the second and would not score again until two minutes into the fourth quarter.

The Mids opened up a four-goal lead by the early minutes of the second quarter. Moran punched in a pair of goals, including the game's opening marker just 1:05 into the contest. Mirabito, meanwhile, fed Navy's final three goals in the run.

Lehigh briefly interrupted Navy's run when Max Dahlem fired in a shot off an unsettled play at 8:29.

Navy answered seven minutes later when senior Clement scored an extra-man goal off a pass from none other than Mirabito. His goal at 1:39 was the first of six straight goals for the Mids.

The Mids ended the half leading 6-1 after Clement tucked in his second goal with just 14 ticks remaining in the opening half. Coughlin stepped up and made a sensational save against defenseman Dan Honeywell, he then sent the outlet pass to Paul who was stationed at mid-field. Paul sprinted towards the box and made the pass to Clement who sent it sailing over the shoulder of Lehigh's Eric Spirko.

Navy outscored Lehigh 4-0 in the third quarter, which featured several impressive plays by the Mids. Paul fired a shot at 12:17 that came out of his stick so hard and so fast, Spirko never moved. Less than a minute later, defensive midfielder **Geoff Leone** quickly grabbed the ball after Lehigh was offside and threw it from the sideline to Mirabito, who was unmarked on the crease, and scored.

The Mids owned a 10-1 lead after three quarters and went on to outscore the Mountain Hawks 4-2 in the final stanza. Two of the four goals were scored by faceoff specialists **Mikelis Visgauss** and **Dan Decker** who each won the draw and took it to the cage. For Decker, it was his first collegiate goal.
