**Notes:** A tough, gritty player, Connolly led North Allegheny High School to a school-record 23 wins in 2008 ... has done an excellent job running the scout team in practice ... his brother, Jack, currently plays football at Dickinson College (D-III) ... was a strong safety in football ... was a member of the *Pittsburgh Post Gazette* North Fabulous Five.

**Notes:** Has made a three-pointer in two of the first three games this season ... his three rebounds and 13 minutes played against Towson tied career highs ... his first career points came on a steal and a breakaway dunk ... an outstanding athlete, Brown has a lot of potential ... played in the WCAC, one of the toughest H.S. conferences in America.

**Notes:** Since the start of last year, Colbert has a 1.78 assist-to-turnover ratio (16-9; 5-1 this year) ... has been a statsheet stuffer his whole career at Navy ... led Navy in scoring with 14 points and tied a career high with eight rebounds against Towson ... has had at least five rebounds in all three games ... scored 17 points in last year's Star Game win over Army.

**Notes:** Was one of 23 freshman nationally with 100 pts., 100 rebs., 30 asts., 25 stls. and 17 blks. last year (just two guards accomplished that feat) ... one of the best defensive players in the Patriot League and may be one of the most underrated players as well ... plays much taller than his 6-4 frame, thanks to his instincts ... enjoys being a leader.

**Notes:** His 17 points against Loyola (Md.) (11-10-06) tied the school record for most points in first game ... grabbed one rebound with one assist in the loss to Towson ... had a strong preseason and will be called upon to give the Mids a presence in the middle ... AAU teammate of current teammate Kaleo Kina ... is ambidextrous.

**Notes:** Ranked eighth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (1.78) a year ago ... has battled leg injuries to give the Mids a strong inside presence ... goes after the rebound relentlessly ... had seven rebounds in just 21 minutes in his first two games ... earned the start against Towson in place of Mark Veazey.

**Notes:** An outstanding talent, Sugars scored 12 points with six rebounds, a block and a steal in 16 minutes against Howard ... has made all four of his three-point attempts this year ... Millbrook High School's career leader in points (1,323), rebounds (623) and steals (190); third in assists (181) ... led H.S. team to a 29-1 record and a state title.

**Notes:** Has equaled his career assist production already after having two dimes in first two years at Navy ... grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against Towson ... has given the Mids an athletic presence in the middle ... an outstanding leaper, Brooks rises above everyone to get rebounds ... led H.S. team to state title, hitting the game-winning shot.

**Notes:** Was a perfect 3-of-3 from the field against Towson, his first career field goal attempts ... has a strong offensive game, but needs to work on his defense ... set career highs in points (6), rebounds (2) and minutes (11) against Towson ... earned the start last year against UTSA in a homecoming game ... has met President George W. Bush.

## Game Preview

▶ Looking for its third straight win after losing its season opener, the Navy men's basketball team hits the road for the second time this season when it travels down I-95 to Williamsburg, Va., for a tilt against William & Mary, beginning at 7:00 pm (ET) on Saturday night. The Midshipmen are one of five Patriot League teams (through Thursday's game) to have two wins under their belts and are 2-1 after Tuesday night's 75-63 win over St. Francis (N.Y.). William & Mary earned its first win of the young season with a 74-58 win over Norfolk State on Wednesday night, in what was its first home game of the season.

▶ Saturday's game will air on WNAV (1430 AM in Annapolis) and online at www.WNAV.com. **Pete Medhurst** will handle the call, beginning with the Navy basketball pregame show at 6:45 pm (ET). Live stats will also be available at William & Mary's athletics website, www.TribeAthletics.com.

## Tuesday's St. Francis (N.Y.) Recap

▶ Navy pieced together its most complete game of the young season with a 75-63 win over St. Francis (N.Y.) on Tuesday night. The win was Navy's second in a row after dropping its season opener to Towson on Nov. 14.

▶ Navy jumped out to a 14-2 lead six minutes into the game, but St. Francis whittled the lead to one at halftime, then took its first lead of the game with the first basket of the second half at 32-30. Navy responded with a 9-0 run to push the lead back to seven, and the Terriers would get no closer than five points the rest of the way.

▶ The Mids recorded season highs in field goal percentage (.491), three-point percentage (.400) and assists (17). Navy also had just 14 turnovers, with only three (two on charge calls) in the second half.

▶ Navy was led by senior **Kaleo Kina**, who scored 19 points on 8-of-13 shooting. **Chris Harris** added 17, **Adam Teague** had 12 and **Mark Veazey** scored 10. Veazey also added a career-high 11 rebounds for his first career double-double. Navy's bench scored just 11 points, and the Mids outscored the Terriers in the paint, 30-18. Nine of 10 Navy players that played scored points in the contest.

## Team Update

▶ Navy appears to have righted the ship after a lackluster effort in the season-opening loss to Towson. Navy has won two straight games, thanks to strong defensive efforts in both games against Howard and St. Francis (N.Y.). Over the last two games, Navy has held its foes to 42-of-116 (.362) from the field and just 118 points (59.0 per game). In the season opener against Towson, the Tigers shot 46.0 percent from the field and scored 49 second-half points (86 overall). In the second half of the last two games, Navy has allowed just 60 combined points and foes are 21-of-60 (.350) from the field.

▶ Navy has gotten off to fast starts the last two games. The Mids jumped out to a 9-2 lead three minutes into the contest against Howard and led 14-2 six minutes into the game against St. Francis.

▶ The Mids' 55 points allowed against Howard equaled the fewest since a Jan. 21, 2007, contest against Army (Army win, 53-50). The 118 points allowed in the last two games is the fewest combined points in a two-game span since Jan. 21-24, 2007, vs. Army (53) and American (55).

▶ In the win over St. Francis (N.Y.), Navy shot over 40.0 percent for the first time since Feb. 16, 2008, vs. Lafayette, a span of eight games. Amazingly, Navy went 5-3 during that stretch.

▶ A lot of talk has been made about Navy's three-point shooting, but it is the inside play that is carrying Navy this year. The Mids have outscored their opponents, 96-74, in the paint this year, for an average of 32.0 to 24.7.

▶ Meanwhile, Navy has scored just 60 points from behind the three-point line.

▶ Navy won its fourth straight non-conference home game with the win over St. Francis (N.Y.). The average margin of victory during the four wins (vs. NJIT, Longwood, Howard, St. Francis) has been 17.5 ppg.

▶ Navy has been held to 69 or fewer points twice this year already, after being held to 69 or fewer points just five times all of last year.

▶ Navy has had three different players (**Cliff Colbert** vs. Towson; **Chris Harris** vs. Howard; **Kaleo Kina** vs. St. Francis (N.Y.)) lead the team in scoring this year. Just five players led the team in scoring a year ago.

▶ Despite posting a 2-1 record, Navy's offense still hasn't fired on all cylinders. Navy is shooting just 20-of-66 (.303) from three-point range. Navy's three primary three-point shooters (**Chris Harris**, **Adam Teague** and **Kaleo Kina**) are just a combined 13-of-48 (.271) from long distance. For their careers, they are a combined 355-of-970 (.366). Each member of the trio has made at least 117 three-pointers and attempted at least 316. For comparison purposes, the other 11 members of the team are 51-of-172 (.297) from three-point range in their careers.

## Noteworthy

▶ Navy is looking for its first road win against a CAA team since Dec. 22, 2000, an 85-69 win at William & Mary.

▶ The Mids are 0-1 on the road, after falling to CAA member, Towson, 86-68, on Nov. 14. Both of Navy's road games after this weekend will have come against CAA foes.

▶ Navy is looking to become 3-1 for the second time in the last three years (2006-07 season started 4-1). Last year's team opened the year 1-3.

▶ The Mids are 32-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than their opponent.

▶ Navy is 32-7 under coach Lange when shooting more free throws than its opponent.

▶ Navy is 8-1 during its last nine games when holding foes to 40.0 percent or less from the field.

▶ Through Thursday's games, Navy does not lead any Patriot League category. The Mids are second in FT percentage (.788).

## Team Update, Part Two - The Frontcourt

▶ **Mark Veazey's** return to the lineup after missing the opener against Towson has given the Mids a boost in the middle. Veazey ranks fourth on the team in scoring (8.0 ppg), first in rebounding (9.5 rpg) and first in blocked shots (1.5 bpg). He leads the team in field goal percentage (.600) and free throw percentage (1.000).

▶ In addition, he is second in the league in rebounding (9.5 rpg) and fifth in blocked shots per game (1.5 bpg).

▶ Veazey recorded his first career double-double in the win over St. Francis (N.Y.), matching his career high with 10 points (5-of-8 shooting) and adding a career-high 11 rebounds (six offensive). It was the first double-double of the year for the Mids.

▶ Senior **Adam Teague** has been Navy's starter in the first three games at power forward, averaging 7.7 ppg and 5.7 rpg. He corralled a career-high 13 rebounds in the season-opening loss to Towson, which were the most for a Navy player since Greg Sprink had 13 against Lehigh on Feb. 19, 2005. Teague is averaging a career-high 26.7 minutes per game.

▶ Teague has connected on 117 career three-pointers, good for 10th on the Navy career list (tied with **Kaleo Kina**). He is seventh on the career three-point percentage list (.366) and ninth in three-point attempts (320).

▶ Teague has played in 89 career games with 29 starts and has scored

in all but 11 of them. His start against Towson was his first since Jan. 21, 2007, against Army.

▶ **Scott Brooks** has seen an increase in minutes since the start of last year, manning the center position in a reserve role. Brooks grabbed a career-high seven rebounds in just 14 minutes against Towson. He is averaging 2.7 ppg, 3.7 rpg and 0.7 apg in a career-best 11.0 minutes per game. Six of his 11 rebounds have been offensive.

▶ Navy's frontcourt has taken a hit early this year, as sophomore **Romeo Garcia** (6-4, 207) has missed the first three games of the year and is doubtful for Saturday night's game against William & Mary. A natural guard that plays in the frontcourt, Garcia is Navy's best defensive player and was one of two freshman guards (Arizona State's **James Hardin**) nationally last year to score 100 points, grab 100 rebounds, dish out 30 assists, grab 25 steals and block at least 17 shots, showing his versatility as a player. Garcia, who is slowly getting back into shape, has a hopeful target date to return of Dec. 20 vs. Canisius (according to Lange).

## Team Update, Part Three - The Backcourt

▶ Navy's backcourt is loaded with talent and will likely carry Navy's success again in 2008-09. Leading the way is junior guard **Chris Harris**, who was a preseason All-Patriot League selection in voting done by the league coaches and SIDs. Harris leads the team, and is fourth in the Patriot League, in scoring at 16.0 ppg. Harris has scored in double figures in 19-of-20 games, dating back to last year, and has connected on at least one three-pointer in 24 straight games.

▶ Much like last year, Harris is off to a relatively slow start. In the nine games a year ago, Harris averaged 7.9 ppg and connected on just 11-of-37 (.297) from three-point range. In the last 21 games last year, Harris went 80-of-181 (.442) from three-point range and averaged 17.3 ppg during that span.

▶ So far this year, Harris is just 6-of-23 (.261) from three-point range and 13-of-37 (.351) from the field. If Harris were to shoot his percentages from last year, he would be averaging 21.3 ppg so far this year.

▶ **Kaleo Kina** became Navy's newest member of the 1,000-point club with his 11-point performance against Howard. He followed up that performance with his best game of the young season in Navy's 75-63 win over St. Francis. He scored 19 points (8-of-13 shooting) and added four rebounds and two assists. He is second on the team in points (13.3) and assists (2.0) and is fourth on the team with a 4.7 rpg average.

▶ Kina needs just 15 assists and five steals to become the seventh player in Patriot League history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 150 steals. He would become the first Navy player in school history to reach those marks.

▶ Kina ranks ninth on the career assists list at Navy (285) and fourth in steals (145).

▶ **O.J. Awworu** returned to the court after a 20-month hiatus and is slowly rounding into form. The super-quick lefty is averaging 5.0 ppg, 4.7 apg and 2.3 rpg in three games this year. After a slow start against Towson, Awworu has 12 assists in the last two games, dishing out seven against St. Francis (N.Y.). So far this year, Awworu has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.44 (13-to-9), after having a 1.30 (95-to-73) ratio as a freshman at Idaho in 2006-07.

▶ Over the last two games, Awworu is averaging 5.0 ppg, 6.0 apg and 3.0 rpg in 28.0 minutes of action.

▶ **Clif Colbert** has been very solid off the bench for head coach **Billy Lange**, averaging 8.3 ppg and 6.3 rpg in 27.0 minutes per game. Colbert scored 14 points with a career-best eight rebounds against Towson. In the last two games, Colbert has added 11 points, 11 rebounds and three assists.

▶ Colbert recorded his first turnover in 81 minutes of action on the year, with a first-half miscue against St. Francis (N.Y.). However, he has a 5.00 (5-to-1) assist-to-turnover ratio for the season, and in 22 games since the start of last year, Colbert has a 1.78 (16-to-9) assist-to-turnover ratio.

▶ Freshman **Jordan Sugars** had a big game against Howard, leading the Midshipmen to a 66-55 victory. Sugars scored 12 points with six rebounds off the bench, and connected on a pair of big three-pointers in the second half to rally Navy.

▶ Sugars has started his career making all four of his three-point attempts (1-of-1 vs. Towson; 3-of-3 vs. Howard).

### Previewing William & Mary

▶ William & Mary enters Saturday night's contest with a 1-2 overall mark. The Tribe lost their first two games to Penn State (65-51) and Ohio (74-55), but cruised past Norfolk State on Wednesday night, 74-58. William & Mary led Norfolk State, which placed second in the MEAC last year and was picked fourth in the preseason, 30-21 at halftime, then opened the second half on a 19-2 run to blow the game open. **Danny Sumner** and **David Schneider** combined for 44 points and seven assists in Wednesday's win, and the Tribe shot 53.2 percent from the field, including 62.3 percent in the second half. The Tribe had 18 turnovers, but won the battle of the boards, 36-30. William & Mary also made 10-of-23 three-point tries.

▶ Sumner, who has led the Tribe in scoring all three games, is averaging 17.0 ppg and 5.0 rpg to lead William & Mary in both categories. He has connected on 51.3 percent of all field goal attempts, including 7-of-16 three-pointers. Schneider follows at 11.3 ppg, but is shooting just 32.1 percent from the field. **Sean McCurdy**, a transfer from Arkansas, averages 6.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 4.0 apg, but will likely miss the game after suffering a severely sprained ankle in practice on Tuesday night.

▶ As a team, the Tribe is shooting 44.6 percent from the field and 32.8 percent from three-point range, while averaging 60.0 ppg. William & Mary has been hampered by turnovers, committing 52 (17.3) in the three games so far.

▶ Defensively, foes are averaging 65.7 points per contest and are shooting 44.2 percent from the field, including 41.7 percent from three-point range.

▶ Head coach **Tony Shaver** owns a 414-216 overall record in his 23rd year and is 56-95 in his sixth year at William & Mary. He was last year's CAA Coach of the Year after leading the Tribe to a fifth-place finish and an appearance in the 2008 CAA Championship game. Last year's squad finished with a 17-16 record.

### Series With the Tribe

▶ Navy leads the all-time series with William & Mary, 39-19 and has won three games in a row between the two teams. The 58 meetings is the fifth most against any one opponent (tied with Maryland) and the three-game winning streak in the series is the fourth-longest current winning streak against an opponent (tied with five other teams). Since the 1994 season, Navy has won six of the eight contests.

▶ Navy is 11-10 all-time against the Tribe in Williamsburg, Va., including 2-3 since Navy joined the Patriot League in 1991.

▶ In the last three games (Jan. 31, 2000; Dec. 22, 2000; Nov. 28, 2006), all Navy wins, the Mids have outscored the Tribe by an average of 13.3 ppg.

### Last Meeting With the Tribe

▶ Navy defeated William & Mary, 79-63, on Nov. 28, 2006, in Annapolis. Navy led 38-28 at halftime, before outscoring the Tribe, 41-35, in the second half for the victory. Navy shot 61.4 percent in the contest, including 64.3 percent from the three-point line, Navy's highest percentage in the **Billy Lange** era.

▶ After William & Mary crawled to within 49-40 with 12:49 to play, the Mids went on a 25-9 to take a 74-49 lead, the largest of the game with 3:43 to play.

▶ One game after leaving the Villanova contest with an apparent concussion, **Kaleo Kina** scored 18 points with seven rebounds, six assists and five steals in just 29 minutes of action. **Greg Sprink** totaled 15 points and **Corey Johnson**, now Navy's starting outside linebacker on the bowl-bound football team, added 10 points.

▶ William & Mary, which entered the game following close losses to Kansas State and Holy Cross, shot 40.0 percent from the field, but went just 4-of-21 (.190) from three-point range, and turned the ball over 18 times.

▶ The Tribe was led by **Adam Payton** and **Adam Trumbower**, each with 12 points. **Danny Sumner** scored four points on 2-of-8 shooting in 19 minutes for the Tribe.

### Home Is Where You Can Find the "W"

▶ Navy has turned around its offensive fortunes in the last two games, coincidentally, with Navy's first two home games of the year. The Mids have won the games by an average of 11.5 points per game, while shooting 41.6 percent (47-of-113) from the field, and 80.0 percent (32-of-40) from the free throw line, while committing just 28 turnovers and recording 27 assists.

▶ In Navy's lone loss this year, on the road to CAA member Towson, Navy shot just 37.5 percent and turned the ball over 18 times with just 10 assists.

▶ Navy has won four non-conference home games in a row and has a chance to run the streak to five next Tuesday when Maryland-Eastern Shore comes to town.

▶ In addition, Navy has won five of its last six home games, with the lone loss coming on a 40-foot miracle shot by Bucknell's **John Griffin** in the third overtime of last year's Patriot League Tournament quarterfinals.

## Seniors Learn of Their Service Selections

▶ Navy's four seniors all earned their post-graduate service selections in a ceremony on Wednesday, Nov. 19.

▶ **Clif Colbert**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** all received Surface Warfare Officer (SWO), while **Brian Richards** received Naval Flight Officer (NFO).

▶ A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.

▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

▶ Three seniors received their first choice, as Richards was not able to receive his first choice. However, his first choice was pilot and he knew going in that he would not be able to receive that selection, because he is too tall.

▶ The four seniors will receive their military billets in mid February.

## Struggling to Find the Range

▶ Despite starting the year 2-1, Navy hasn't fired on all cylinders yet. The Mids are shooting just 40.0 percent from the field, and 30.3 percent from three-point range.

▶ Navy's big three shooters of **Chris Harris**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** are shooting just a combined 38-of-102 (.373) from the field, including 13-of-48 (.271) from three-point range.

▶ However, the trio is showing signs of turning it around, connecting on 17-of-34 (.500) field goal attempts and 6-of-16 (.375) three-point attempts in the win over St. Francis (N.Y.), scoring

▶ American was a "unanimous" pick to repeat gathering 14 (of a possible 14) first-place votes. Holy Cross, who was selected third, earned the other two first-place votes.

▶ The Mids return seven of their top eight scorers off last year's team that finished second in the league race. Last year's squad was picked seventh in the preseason poll.

## Mids Earn Preseason Honors

▶ Navy had three players earn preseason accolades, highlighted by **Chris Harris** being named a preseason all-Patriot League selection in voting done by the league coaches and sports information directors. Harris is the league's fourth-leading returning scorer, is fifth among returnees in assists and led the league in steals last year.

▶ Harris was also named a preseason first-team selection by *The Sporting News* and a second-team selection by *Lindy's Magazine*. Harris averaged 14.5 ppg and 3.7 apg a year ago, while making a school-record 91 three-pointers.

▶ **O.J. Awwo** was named *Lindy's* Newcomer of the Year in the Patriot League. Awwo sat out last year after transferring from the University of Idaho. He averaged 3.6 ppg, 3.1 apg and 2.6 rpg in 24 starts for the Vandals in 2006-07. He added a 1.30 assist-to-turnover ratio for the 4-27 Vandals, and will give Navy a "true" point guard that it desperately needed.

▶ **Kaleo Kina** was also named a second-team selection by *Lindy's* after averaging 14.1 ppg, 4.1 rpg, 3.5 apg and 1.8 spg for the Midshipmen a year ago.

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

▶ Last year's team forced 568 turnovers, the third-highest total in school history ... the Mids also averaged 9.1 steals per game a year ago, the first-best mark in school history.

▶ Freshmen have earned five all-Patriot League Rookie Team accolades in Lange's four years ... prior to his arrival, just 11 freshmen won all-rookie team honors in 13 years ... Lange has had at least one freshman in the starting lineup in 111 of the 116 games he has coached at Navy.

▶ The Mids have made at least one three-pointer in every game under Lange and at least three three-pointers in every game but one.

▶ 2008 grad Greg Sprink was named Navy's first Patriot League Player of the Year in school history a year ago ... he was also Navy's first All-American since the great David Robinson in the 1987 season.

▶ Lastly, team GPA has increased every year since Lange took over ... the team GPA has increased by 0.30 points since his arrival ... eight players a year ago recorded a GPA of 2.72 or better during the spring semester.
