Mids Look for Second Win in a Row on Tuesday Night Against St. Francis

▶ Fresh off its first win of the year on Sunday against Howard, the Navy men's basketball team looks for its second win in a row on Tuesday night, hosting St. Francis (N.Y.) for a 7:00 pm tipoff at Alumni Hall. The Mids enter the contest with a 1-1 record, while St. Francis is 0-1. The contest will conclude a three-game in five-day season-opening stretch for the Mids.

▶ The game will be broadcast over the radio waves by WNAV (1430 AM; wnav.com), WFED (1050 AM; federalnewsradio.com), WWWT (820 & 1500 AM) and SIRIUS Radio (Channel 125) with **Pete Medhurst** handling the call, beginning with the Navy basketball pregame show at 6:45 pm (ET). In addition, the game will be video streamed on Navy All-Access at NavySports.com.

The Book on Navy

▶ Navy is coming off an impressive defensive performance on Sunday's 66-55 win over Howard. After giving up 86 points in Friday's loss to Towson, the Mids held the Bison without a field goal in the last nine minutes and outscored Howard, 17-1, during that stretch to earn their first win of the year. Navy held Howard to just 32.3 percent from the field and 18.8 percent from three-point range in equaling Navy's lowest defensive output since Jan. 21, 2007, against Army (loss, 53-50).

▶ **Chris Harris** led Navy with 22 points, including three three-pointers. Harris had 12 of his points in the first half and also went 9-of-10 from the free throw line to keep Howard at bay. Freshman **Jordan Sugars** tallied 12 points, six rebounds, one steal and one block in just 16 minutes of action and sparked a game-ending 20-4 run with a pair of three-pointers in the final 11 minutes.

▶ **Kaleo Kina** was the third Navy player in double figures with 11 points and seven rebounds. Kina became the newest member of Navy's 1,000-point club, reaching the plateau on a lay-up with 2:48 to play in the first half. He is the 18th player in school history to score 1,000 career points.

▶ **Mark Veazey**, **Clif Colbert** and **O.J. Awworo** also sparked the Mids by combining for 16 points, 18 rebounds and seven assists. Veazey had six points and tied a career high with eight rebounds, while Colbert had six points and six rebounds. Awworo continues to show improvement, scoring four points with four rebounds and five assists.

Navy Stock Tips

▶ Navy is looking to become 2-1 for the third time under head coach Billy Lange. Navy was also 2-1 in the 2004-05 and 2006-07 seasons.

▶ The "three-game in five-day stretch" is not uncommon under Lange. Once in each of Lange's four years at Navy, Navy has played this grueling stretch. Navy has won the third game in the stretch three previous times.

▶ The Mids have won three straight non-conference home games by an average margin of 19.3 points per game.

▶ Navy is 20-14 under Lange when making at least 10 three-pointers in a game, including 9-6 a year ago.

▶ Navy was 8-2 last year when scoring more than 80 points, with both of the losses coming in overtime. The Mids are 20-5 under Lange when reaching 80 points.

▶ The Mids are 31-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than their opponent.

▶ Navy is 31-7 under coach Lange when shooting more free throws than its opponent.

▶ Navy is 8-1 during its last nine games when holding foes to 40.0 percent or less from the field.

▶ Navy has not shot above 40.0 percent in its last seven games, dating back to last year.

▶ Navy's 96 combined rebounds are the most in a two-game span since grabbing 99 in wins over Morgan State (Dec. 8) and Washington College (Dec. 18).

▶ The Mids are 6-3 all-time when **Clif Colbert** reaches double-digit scoring after falling to Towson on Friday.

▶ Navy is 11-5 all-time when **Adam Teague** tallies 10 or more points.

▶ Navy is 15-8 all-time when **Kaleo Kina** scores 10 points with four assists in the same game. On the flipside, the Mids are just 4-8 all-time when **Chris Harris** reaches those marks.

▶ The Mids improved to 5-3 all-time when **Chris Harris** scores 20 points in a game. Navy is 15-12 when **Chris Harris** scores in double-figures.

The Book on St. Francis (N.Y.)

▶ St. Francis (N.Y.) enters the game with a 0-1 record after falling in its season opener to Seton Hall, 88-61. The Terriers actually led, 17-14 early on, before the Pirates turned on the jets and outscored St. Francis (N.Y.) the rest of the way, 74-44, for the easy victory. The Terriers finished last year with a 7-22 overall record and went 4-14 in the NEC.

▶ The Terriers were led by forward **Kayode Ayeni** with 19 points and a career-high 13 rebounds and three blocked shots. **Ricky Cadell** and **John Gooden** added nine points each. The Terriers were outrebounded, 38-32, and turned the ball over 18 times. St. Francis shot just 35.1 percent from the field and went just 5-of-27 (.185) from three-point range.

Series History

▶ This will be the eighth meeting all-time between the two teams, with Navy owning a 5-2 series advantage. The Mids took last year's meeting, 85-83, in Brooklyn Heights, N.Y.

▶ Navy is 3-0 all-time against St. Francis in Annapolis and has won two in a row in the series. The two teams, however, haven't met in Annapolis since Feb. 27, 1975.

▶ Navy's 110 points (110-80 victory) against the Terriers on March 3, 1973, are tied for the fourth most in school history.

Navy Against the NEC

▶ Navy is scheduled to play two NEC teams this year, and the Terriers will be the first NEC team on the slate this year. Navy will also played NEC favorite Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 9, in Emmitsburg, Md.

▶ Navy has played six of the 11 teams currently in the NEC and currently own a 20-10 all-time record against the NEC. Navy has not played Central Connecticut State, Monmouth, Quinnipiac, Sacred Heart and Wagner.

▶ Navy's seven games against St. Francis are the second most against a team from the NEC (Mount St. Mary's - 11).

A Navy Win Would...

▶ Give Navy a 6-2 series lead over St. Francis and be the third in a row against the Terriers. Navy would improve to 21-10 against the NEC all-time.

▶ Push Navy's record to 2-1 overall for the the third time in the Billy Lange era. The other 2-1 starts under Lange came during the 2004-05 and 2006-07 seasons.

▶ Improve Navy's home record to 2-0 for the first time since 2006-07.

▶ Push Navy's non-conference home winning streak to four games, dating back to last year. During Navy's current three-game non-conference winning streak, Navy's average margin of victory is 19.3 points.

▶ Be **Billy Lange's** 91st career victory and 52nd win at Navy.

▶ Give Navy 148 victories all time at Alumni Hall (147-87).

The Last Time - Dec. 29, 2007

BROOKLYN HEIGHTS, N.Y. - **Greg Sprink** scored 33 points and grabbed nine rebounds to lead Navy to an 85-83 victory over St. Francis. **Kaleo Kina** added 23 points, six rebounds and six assists as Navy moved to 5-8 on the season.

▶ Navy led virtually the entire first half, with the lone exception of a 17-17 tie with about 12 minutes to play. However, the Mids reclaimed the lead with a 7-0 run to grab a 24-17 advantage 8:47 to play on a Chris Harris (Mechanicsville, Va.) three-pointer. The Mids would push the lead to 10 twice in the first half, thanks to **Kaleo Kina** (Phoenix, Ariz.) and **Greg Sprink** (Cardiff by the Sea, Calif.), the last time at 40-30, before the Terriers scored the final four points to trim the margin to 40-34 at the break.

▶ Kina connected on a pair of three-point bombs in the final three minutes, and Sprink totaled 12 points on five-of-nine shooting in the opening 20 minutes. The duo of Sprink and Kina would score 25 of Navy's 40 first-half points, and Lange got a strong contribution from **T.J. Topercer** (Scottsdale, Ariz.) off the bench. Topercer was scoreless entering the contest, but scored six points on three-of-three shooting and dished out two assists in the opening half.

▶ The Mids bumped the lead back to 10 at 46-36 moments into the second half, but the Terriers' Rocco Rubino connected on back-to-back three-pointers to cap off an 8-0 run and tie the game at 50 with 12:51 to play.

▶ However, just as quick as St. Francis got back into the game, Navy went on a 9-0 run of its own to take a 59-50 cushion with eleven minutes to play. Sprink started the run with a three-pointer in the corner to start the run and Kina scored on a pair of lay-ups to aid the Mids.

▶ After SFC tied the game at 68, Sprink went on his own personal 8-0 run, including a pair of three-pointers to give Navy the lead for good. The Mids then closed the game by converting nine-of-10 free throws in the final 1:17 for the two-point win.

▶ Sprink's 33 points are the most for a Navy player since he scored a career-best 34 against Brown on Dec. 22, 2005, during his sophomore year. He finished the game 11-of-18 from the field and 7-of-9 from the charity stripe. He also added three assists, a block and a steal.

Looking Back on Howard

▶ Navy improved to 1-1 for the third straight year. Navy avoided its first 0-2 start since the 2005-06 season with the 66-55 win over Howard.

▶ Navy improved to 12-6 (.667) all time in Alumni Hall openers with the victory over Howard, and to 5-5 since 1999.

▶ Navy is now 3-2 under head coach **Billy Lange** in Alumni Hall openers.

▶ Navy won its third straight non-conference home game, winning the three games by an average of 19.3 ppg.

▶ Navy's 55 points allowed equaled the fewest since allowing 53 against Army on Jan. 21, 2007. The Mids held three other teams to 55 points during that span.

▶ The Mids' 66 points against Howard were the fewest in a victory since scoring 60 against Lafayette in a 60-44 win on Jan. 13, 2007. The win snapped a 17-game losing streak when being held to 69 or fewer points, dating back to that Lafayette victory.

▶ The Mids took better care of the ball, committing 14 turnovers, two days after turning the ball over 18 times in Friday's loss to Towson. Coupled with Friday's second half against Towson, Navy has 19 turnovers in its last 60 minutes of action, with four of them on illegal screens.

▶ Navy shot just 34.5 percent from the field. Coupled with its 37.5 percent shooting percentage against Towson, the Mids have shot just 36.2 percent in the first two games. Navy has not shot over 40.0 percent from the field in its last seven games, and hasn't been over 50.0 percent in 18 games (vs. NJIT; Jan. 2, 2008).

▶ **Kaleo Kina** became the 18th player in school history to score 1,000 points when he connected on a lay-up with 2:48 to play in the first half. He is the seventh player in school history to score 1,000 points with 250 assists.

▶ **Chris Harris** made a three-pointer in his 23rd straight game, an ongoing school record. He has now made three or more three-pointers 22 times in 62 career games.

▶ Harris scored 22 points against Howard, his eighth career 20-point game.

▶ **Mark Veazey's** eight rebounds tied a career high.

▶ **Jordan Sugars** tallied career highs in points (12), rebounds (6), steals (1), blocks (1) and minutes (16). Sugars sparked a second-half rally with seven points, five rebounds, a block, a steal and two three-pointers in 11 second-half minutes.

Struggling to Find the Range

▶ Despite starting the year 1-1, Navy hasn't fired on all cylinders yet. The Mids are shooting just 36.2 percent from the field, and 26.1 percent from three-point range.

▶ Navy's big three shooters of **Chris Harris**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** are shooting just a combined 21-of-68 (.309) from the field, including 7-of-32 (.219) from three-point range.

▶ Comped to last year's stats, that is a far cry to what Navy fans have come to expect from the trio.

Defense Puts on the Clamps

▶ Through the first 30 minutes of Sunday's win over Howard, Navy's defense was solid, but not spectacular. However, over the last 10 minutes, the Mids' defense turned to spectacular, and gave Navy the lift it needed for the victory.

▶ Navy held Howard to 0-of-10 from the field and just one point in the last nine minutes of the second half, to turn a five-point deficit into an 11-point victory. Navy also forced six turnovers during that span.

▶ It marked the first time Navy held a foe under 60 points in the last 17 games, dating back to 73-55 win over Longwood on Jan. 5, 2008.

▶ Entering the final nine minutes, Howard was 20-of-52 (.385) from the field, but finished the game shooting just 20-of-62 (.323). The 32.3 percent shooting effort was the lowest since Longwood shot 26.2 percent on Jan. 5, 2008. It was also the first time Navy held a foe under 40 percent since the American game on Jan. 30, 2008, a span of 11 contests.

▶ Navy, which also struggled on the defensive glass in the first 11 minutes of the second half, allowed just three offensive rebounds in the final nine minutes. Navy gave up eight in the first 11 minutes of the final frame.

Kina Joins Elite Company

▶ **Kaleo Kina** joined some elite company on Sunday on both the Navy level and Patriot League level. A three-year starter for the Midshipmen, Kina is putting the finishing touches on a stellar caeeer in Annapolis.

▶ Kina became the 18th player in school history to score 1,000 points when he tallied 11 points against Howard. Now with 1,008 points, Kina became the seventh player in school history with 1,000 points and 250 assists. He currently has 1,008 points and 283 assists.

▶ If Kina were to reach 400 assists (needing 117), he would become the third Navy player (**Kylor Whitaker** and **Rob Romaine**) to score 1,000 points with 400 assists.

▶ Kina needs 17 assists to become the 24th player in Patriot League history with 300 career dimes.

▶ Kina ranks fourth already on the Navy career steals list and needs 55 to tie **Chris Williams** for the top spot with 209. Kina needs just six steals to become the 20th player in Patriot League history with 150 career steals.

▶ Once Kina hits the 1,000-point / 300-assist / 150-steal plateaus, he will become the seventh player in Patriot League history to reach those marks.

▶ Kina became just the second player (**Kylor Whitaker**, 1985) in school history to score 400 points, grab 100 rebounds and dish out 100 assists in a season, accomplished last year.

▶ Kina ranks ninth on the career assists (283) list and fourth on the career steals (144) list. He has a great shot at becoming the first player in school history with 1,000 points, 350 assists and 175 steals.

Harris Starts Slow, Picks Up Pace

▶ If Sunday is any indication, **Chris Harris** may be finding his shooting stroke earlier this year than last.

▶ Harris went 3-of-7 from three-point range against Howard, two days after struggling through a 1-for-9 night at Towson from behind the arc.

▶ However, the slow start is nothing new to Harris, who started slow last year, before turning on the jets in the last half of the season. In the first nine games of last year, Harris went just 11-of-37 (.297) from three-point range and averaged 7.9 ppg. In the last 21 games of last year, Harris went 80-of-181 (.442) from long distance and averaged 17.3 ppg during that span.

▶ Harris also showed an ability to get to the free throw line on Sunday, tying a career high with 10 free throw attempts. He is currently 11th in the league in free throw percentage (.917) and leads the league with 12 free throw attempts. However, none of the 10 players ahead of Harris have shot more than four free throws. Harris is 31st in the country in free throws made (11).

▶ Harris recorded his eighth career 20-point game with his 22-point effort against Howard and he has scored in double figures in 18 of the last 19 games, dating back to last year.

Pour Some Sugars on Me

▶ **Jordan Sugars** has played just two games in a Navy uniform, but he has shown what kind of player he might be.

▶ Sugars recorded a very solid effort in Navy's win over Howard, scoring 12 points with six rebounds, a steal and a block. He fueled a second-half rally with a pair of three-pointers to help start a 20-4 run to end the game, and his second three-pointer in the span gave Navy a 57-54 lead it would not relinquish with just over six minutes to play.

▶ He showed his athleticism on his blocked shot, as Howard's Randy Hampton had a breakaway layup and Sugars pinned the ball on the backboard.

▶ Sugars has also shown a pretty good touch from downtown, connecting on his first four three-point attempts of his career.

▶ Per 40 minutes, Sugars is averaging 23.4 ppg and 11.0 rpg. It should not come as a surprise as he finished his high school (Millbrook H.S.) career as the school's all-time leader in points, rebounds and steals and was third in assists.

Colbert Cleans Up The Trash

▶ **Clif Colbert** may not be the flashiest player in a Navy lineup, but he is finding a way to get the job done.

▶ In the opener against Towson, Colbert led Navy with 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting and grabbed a career-high eight rebounds. Then in Sunday's win over Howard, Colbert scored six points with six rebounds and two assists.

▶ Colbert has yet to turn the ball over in 54 minutes this year, and owns a 1.75 assist-to-turnover ratio since the start of last year (15-to-8).

▶ He is averaging 10.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg and 2.0 apg in 27.0 minutes per game, all career highs.

Aworo Shaking Off the Rust

▶ **O.J. Aworo** appears to finally be getting back into game shape after a strong floor game against Howard on Sunday. The slippery sophomore scored four points, grabbed four rebounds and a steal and dished out five assists in 30 minutes of action.

▶ The assist average figures to go up once Navy's shooting percentage improves.

▶ Aworo dished out his 100th career assist (95 at Idaho; six at Navy) in the win over Howard.

▶ Aworo currently boasts a 1.20 assist-to-turnover ratio for the season and has a 1.29 career ratio.

Dominant Effort on The Glass and In the Paint

▶ One positive aspect from Friday's loss to Towson was the effort on the glass and in the paint. The Mids owned a +10 advantage on points in the paint (42-32) and outrebounded the taller, more athletic Tigers, 50-35.

▶ Navy grabbed 19 offensive rebounds, despite not playing its regular starting center, **Mark Veazey**, resulting in 13 second-chance points.

▶ Navy's +15 rebound margin was the largest against a Division I opponent since a +27 margin against Morgan State on Dec. 8, 2005. In addition, Navy's 50 rebounds were the most since that day.

▶ In addition, it marked the third straight game, dating back to last year, Navy had at least 19 offensive rebounds.

The Bench Produces Nicely

▶ Another positive for head coach Billy Lange was the play of his bench. In fact, one could make an argument that the bench outplayed the starters in game one against Towson.

The Stripe Has Been Kind

▶ Another area that has seen dramatic improvement under Lange has been Navy's free throw shooting. The Mids set a school record last year by converting on 74.9 percent of their free throw attempts. The average hiked up to 78.2 percent in the 14 Patriot League games.

▶ Three of the top seven single-season three-point percentage performances have come under Lange.

▶ Navy is just the fourth team in Patriot League history to lead the league in free throw percentage two straight years, and the first since Lehigh in 2003 and 2004. No team has ever led the league in free throw percentage three straight times.

▶ Navy's 74.9 percent was the sixth-highest percentage in league history. The league record is 76.9 percent set by Army in 2005.

▶ Already this year, Navy is off to another record-breaking pace at the stripe, converting on 82.4 percent of its 34 free throw attempts (making 28). ▶ The Navy men's basketball team was selected to finish sixth in the preseason Patriot League poll in voting done by league coaches and sports information directors. Coaches and SIDs were not able to vote for their own squad.

▶ American was a "unanimous" pick to repeat gathering 14 (of a possible 14) first-place votes. Holy Cross, who was selected third, earned the other two first-place votes.

▶ The Mids return seven of their top eight scorers off last year's team that finished second in the league race. Last year's squad was picked seventh in the preseason poll.

▶ This marks the highest that Navy has been picked in the preseason under Lange, joining the 2005-06 squad that was also picked sixth in the preseason. In every season but one (2005-06) under Lange, Navy has exceeded its preseason rank, including a five-spot jump last year.

Mids Earn Preseason Honors

▶ Navy had three players earn preseason accolades, highlighted by **Chris Harris** being named a preseason all-Patriot League selection in voting done by the league coaches and sports information directors. Harris is the league's fourth-leading returning scorer, is fifth among returnees in assists and led the league in steals last year.

▶ Harris was also named a preseason first-team selection by *The Sporting News* and a second-team selection by *Lindy's Magazine*. Harris averaged 14.5 ppg and 3.7 apg a year ago, while making a school-record 91 three-pointers.

▶ **O.J. Avworo** was named *Lindy's* Newcomer of the Year in the Patriot League. Avworo sat out last year after transferring

from the University of Idaho. He averaged 3.6 ppg, 3.1 apg and 2.6 rpg in 24 starts for the Vandals in 2006-07. He added a 1.30 assist-to-turnover ratio for the 4-27 Vandals, and will give Navy a "true" point guard that it desperately needed.

▶ **Kaleo Kina** was also named a second-team selection by *Lindy's* after averaging 14.1 ppg, 4.1 rpg, 3.5 apg and 1.8 spg for the Midshipmen a year ago.

Mids Pile Up The Points...

▶ Since head coach **Billy Lange** took over the Navy basketball program before the 2004-05 season, the Midshipmen offense has flourished. That is likely to be the case against in 2008-09, as Lange welcomes back seven of the team's top eight scorers from a year ago, over 68 percent of team's scoring from last year and almost 72 percent of the team's three-pointers made from last year. Returnees shot 42.0 percent from the field, including 37.1 from three, last year.

▶ In three of the last four years, Navy has led the Patriot League in scoring, including last year's team that averaged 76.3 points per game, the highest average for a Patriot League team since the 1995-96 season (Holy Cross - 77.2).

▶ Last year's team ranked seventh on the Navy single-season points per game list and it was the highest average (76.3) in 17 years, when the 1990-91 team averaged a school-record 84.1 points per game. The 2007-08 version ranked 46th nationally in scoring offense.

▶ Despite the offensive success, however, Navy wound up seventh in the Patriot League in scoring defense (73.6) and field goal percentage defense (.434). The Mids were also tied for sixth in rebounding margin (-2.7).

▶ In league games only, Navy was eighth in scoring defense (74.8), eighth in field goal percentage defense (.460) and fifth in rebounding margin (-1.3).

▶ Last year's defensive average of 73.6 points per game was the sixth-highest average in school history, and two of the top six averages have come under Lange (2005 - fifth).

Statistical Anomaly

▶ Navy had a remarkable year in 2007-08, despite some rather dismal statistics. The Mids finished second in the Patriot League with a 9-5 record, but in league games only, finished last in scoring defense (74.8 ppg), last in field goal percentage (.391), last in field goal percentage defense (.460) and fifth in rebound margin (-1.3).

▶ Navy made its mark, however, in several other key statistics. The Mids ranked first in scoring offense (77.8 ppg), free throw percentage (.782), three-pointers made per game (10.21), assist-to-turnover ratio (0.97), turnover margin (+4.14) and steals per game (9.29).

▶ Coupled with the turnover margin (+4.14) and offensive rebounds per game (14.4 per game -- led the league), the Mids recorded an extra 18.5 possessions per game a year ago.

Navy Finds Success Behind the Arc

▶ Over the last four years, few teams nationally have enjoyed as much success behind the arc as Navy. Since 2004-05, Navy has increased its three-pointer total, setting school records last year for three-pointers made and attempted.

▶ Last season, Navy finished 21st nationally in three-pointers made (288) and 14th in attempts (820). However, the Mids were sixth nationally in three-pointers made per game (9.6), and the Mids saw their production increase to 10.2 in league games.

▶ In addition, Navy made at least 10 three-pointers 15 times in 2008, and 13 of the 18 occurrences of 13 three-pointers or more in a game in Navy history have come under Lange.

▶ In 2005, eight different players made three-pointers, and four players recorded at least 29 three-pointers.

▶ In 2006, eight players netted three-pointers and six players connected on at least 17 three-pointers.

▶ In 2007, 10 different players connected on three-pointers, with nine of them reaching double-digits. The nine players to make at least 10 three-pointers were tied for the most in the country, and the eight players to hit three-pointers against Brown was one shy of the NCAA record.

▶ Last year, Lange saw 11 players make three-pointers, with four making at least 44. Navy was one of four schools nationally to have four players make at least 44 three-pointers.

Freshmen See Time Under Lange

▶ Head coach **Billy Lange** hasn't been shy about starting freshmen during his first four years at Navy.

▶ In Lange's 118 games at Navy, at least one freshman has been in the starting lineup 111 times. Two freshmen have started the same game 62 times, and three freshmen have started 16 times.

▶ Entering the St. Francis (N.Y.) game, just seven times in Lange's 118 games as the head coach, has the starting lineup not featured a freshman.

▶ Freshmen have earned spots on the Patriot League all-rookie team five times. **Corey Johnson** and **Greg Sprink**

(2005), **Kaleo Kina** (2006), **Trey Stanton** (2007) and **Romeo Garcia** (2008) all earned spots on the squad.

▶ However, this year's starting lineup likely won't feature a freshman, but Lange will get solid contributions from both **Jordan Sugars** and **Ted Connolly**.

Harris One of the Nation's Most Improved Scorers

▶ **Chris Harris** stepped up big in 2007-08, earning second-team All-Patriot League honors after averaging 14.5 ppg, 3.7 rpg and 1.9 spg. In addition, Harris smashed the school record for three-pointers in a season with 91 while shooting 41.7 percent from long distance.

▶ It came after a freshman year in which he averaged just 3.5 ppg while shooting just 32.0 percent from long distance.

▶ In league games as a sophomore, Harris contributed 17.6 ppg, 3.9 rpg, 3.5 spg and 2.0 spg.

▶ His improvement of 11.0 ppg in all games played was the third-best jump for a player nationally, as was his 15.0 ppg improvement in league games.

▶ Navy Director of Athletics **Chet Gladchuk** announced on March 12, 2008, that the Naval Academy Athletic Association extended the contract of **Billy Lange** through the 2013 season.

▶ Lange led the Midshipmen to a 16-14 record and a 9-5 Patriot League record, good for a second-place finish in the regular-season standings. The Mids, which were picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll, played an exciting brand of basketball, leading the league in scoring, three-pointers made per game, free throw percentage and turnovers forced.

Ginyard Joins Basketball Staff

▶ **Ron Ginyard** joined the program's staff as an assistant coach in June. Ginyard comes to Navy after spending one year in the same capacity at The Citadel. The Citadel went 6-24 a year ago, but boasted the nation's youngest lineup with 14 freshmen on its roster.

▶ Ginyard replaces **Matt Sladky**, who left to pursue other career opportunities.

Success at the Ticket Window

▶ Navy averaged 3,083 fans during its Patriot League season a year ago, to rank second behind Bucknell (3,584). The NAAA made a decision prior to the year to move all its games to 7:00 pm, and the results were outstanding. Navy drew over 3,000 fans in four of its seven home league games and had at least 2,135 fans for the other three games.

▶ In addition, the crowd of 5,710 against Army on Jan. 27, 2008, was the second-largest on-campus crowd in league history, behind just the 6,310 that filled Alumni Hall on Jan. 21, 1995.

Garcia, Veazey Give Mids a Boost

▶ A pair of Navy sophomores gave the Mids a big defensive boost a year ago and are looking to do more of the same in their sophomore campaigns.

▶ **Romeo Garcia** was a Patriot League all-rookie team selection after averaging 4.4 ppg and 3.9 rpg. However, it was his defense that caught the attention of coaches and fans. In addition to his scoring and rebounding, Garcia grabbed 25 steals and blocked 17 shots on the season, becoming the first freshman, and the 11th player (17th time overall) in school history with 100 points, 100 rebounds, 30 assists, 25 steals and 17 blocked shots in a season.

▶ According to the website, www.bbstate.com, Garcia was just one of 23 freshmen (all positions) nationally to reach those marks, and one of just two freshman guards in the country in 2007-08 to eclipse the above-mentioned plateaus.

▶ After struggling offensively in non-conference play, Garcia averaged 5.2 ppg and 4.1 rpg in essentially the same amount of minutes during league play. He also shot 46.0 percent from the field in league play (compared to 36.5 in non-conference) and 43.8 from three-point range (compared to 25.0 percent in non-conference games). Over the last five games, Garcia averaged 7.2 ppg and 4.8 rpg.

▶ Meanwhile, **Mark Veazey** started 19 games a year ago and averaged 3.7 ppg and 4.1 rpg. Veazey gave the Mids a solid defensive stopper in the middle, as he blocked a Navy freshman-record 38 shots, including four in the Patriot League Tournament against Bucknell, setting a new single-game freshman record.

▶ Veazey started the non-conference year on fire, averaging 5.9 ppg and 4.6 rpg in the year's first 10 games. However, in the last 20 games, Veazey averaged just 2.7 ppg and 3.9 rpg. Veazey has gotten stronger and has worked on his offensive game relentlessly and will be looked upon for more in the upcoming year.

New Voices on the Airwaves

▶ The Navy men's basketball team will feature some new voices handling the call on the airwaves for the upcoming season. **Pete Medhurst** will take over the play-by-play duties for all 30-plus Navy games. Medhurst, who filled in at times for Bob Socci over the past few years, will call all the games for Navy's flagship station, WNAV (1430 AM: Annapolis).

▶ In addition, Medhurst will get some help this year. Former Navy star **Michael Heary** will join forces with Medhurst for a handful of games this winter, serving as Medhurst's color commentator. Heary was a four-year letterwinner for the Mids from 1995-98, and currently ranks fifth on the school's career scoring list with 1,590 points. Heary was a two-time All-Patriot League performer and held the school's career three-point record with 201, until **Greg Sprink** passed him last season.

The Last Word

▶ In its preseason conference rankings, Rivals.com ranked the Patriot League as its 15th-best conference nationally.

▶ **Seventh Year Overall:** 90-86 (.511)

▶ **Fifth Year at Navy:** 51-67 (.432)

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

▶ Last year's team forced 568 turnovers, the third-highest total in school history ... the Mids also averaged 9.1 steals per game a year ago, the first-best mark in school history.

▶ Freshmen have earned five all-Patriot League Rookie Team accolades in Lange's four years ... prior to his arrival, just 11 freshmen won all-rookie team honors in 13 years ... Lange has had at least one freshman in the starting lineup in 111 of the 116 games he has coached at Navy.

▶ The Mids have made at least one three-pointer in every game under Lange and at least three three-pointers in every game but one.

▶ 2008 grad Greg Sprink was named Navy's first Patriot League Player of the Year in school history a year ago ... he was also Navy's first All-American since the great David Robinson in the 1987 season.

▶ Lastly, team GPA has increased every year since Lange took over ... the team GPA has increased by 0.30 points since his arrival ... eight players a year ago recorded a GPA of 2.72 or better during the spring semester.
