Notes: A tough, gritty player, Connolly led North Allegheny High School to a school-record 23 wins in 2008 ... has done an excellent job running the scout team in practice ... his brother, Jack, currently plays football at Dickinson College (D-III) ... was a strong safety in football ... was a member of the *Pittsburgh Post Gazette* North Fabulous Five.

Notes: Has made a three-pointer in two of the first four games this season ... his three rebounds and 13 minutes played against Towson tied career highs ... his first career points came on a steal and a breakaway dunk ... an outstanding athlete, Brown has a lot of potential ... played in the WCAC, one of the toughest H.S. conferences in America.

Notes: Since the start of last year, Colbert has a 1.90 (19-to-10) assist-to-turnover ratio and is shooting 49-of-88 (.557) from the field ... his rebound putback in the third overtime against W&M was as big of a play as any, cutting the Tribe lead to three ... has grabbed at least five rebounds in every game this year ... tied a career high with three asts. vs. W&M.

Notes: Was one of 23 freshman nationally with 100 pts., 100 rebs., 30 asts., 25 stls. and 17 blks. last year (just two guards accomplished that feat) ... one of the best defensive players in the Patriot League and may be one of the most underrated players as well ... plays much taller than his 6-4 frame, thanks to his instincts ... enjoys being a leader.

Notes: His 17 points against Loyola (Md.) (11-10-06) tied the school record for most points in first game ... grabbed one rebound with one assist in the loss to Towson ... had a strong preseason and will be called upon to give the Mids a presence in the middle ... AAU teammate of current teammate Kaleo Kina ... is ambidextrous.

Notes: Ranked eighth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (1.78) a year ago ... has battled leg injuries to give the Mids a strong inside presence ... goes after the rebound relentlessly ... had seven rebounds in just 21 minutes in his first two games ... earned the start against Towson in place of Mark Veazey.

Notes: An outstanding talent, Sugars scored 12 points with six rebounds, a block and a steal in 16 minutes against Howard ... opened the year making his first five three-point attempts, before finally missing vs. William & Mary ... averaging 5.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 0.7 apg in 13.7 mpg over the last three outings.

Notes: Has equaled his career assist production already after having two dimes in first two years at Navy ... grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against Towson ... seven of his 12 rebounds have come on the offensive end ... played a season-low five minutes vs. William & Mary ... led Wakefield H.S. (N.C.) to state title, hitting the game-winning shot.

Notes: Has come off the bench in two games to impress offensively on the inside ... has scored six points in both games this season, and is shooting 75.0 percent (6-of-8) from the field ... went 3-of-3 vs. Towson and 3-of-5 vs. William & Mary ... averaging 18.5 ppg and 9.2 rpg per 40 minutes of action.

Game Preview

▶ The red-hot Navy men's basketball team looks to continue its winning ways with a Tuesday night tilt against Maryland-Eastern Shore. The Mids have won three games in a row after a season-opening loss and will be looking to remain undefeated at Alumni Hall. The game will be the back end of a women's-men's doubleheader and will tip off 30 minutes after the conclusion of the women's game vs. Dayton, which starts at 5:00 pm (ET). Navy is 3-1 on the year, while Maryland-Eastern Shore is 0-2.

▶ Tuesday's game will air on Navy All-Access only (both video and audio), as WNAV (1430 AM) will carry the Navy football game vs. Northern Illinois instead. **Joe Miller** will handle the call for both games, beginning with the women's game against Dayton.

Saturday's William & Mary Recap

▶ Navy scored an impressive road 102-99 triple-overtime win on Saturday night over a William & Mary squad that advanced to the CAA title game a year ago. It was the first road win over a CAA team since Dec. 22, 2000, also against William & Mary.

▶ Navy fell behind 32-22 just before halftime, but closed the first half on a 7-0 run to trim the margin to three at 32-29. The Mids continued their run, grabbing a 12-point lead four different times in the final eight minutes of the second half, the last coming at 64-52 with 5:13 to play. However, William & Mary outscored the Mids, 14-2, down the stretch to tie the game at 66 heading into overtime.

▶ Navy led by as many as five in the first overtime, but had to weather a **David Schneider** three-point attempt at the buzzer to send the game into a second overtime session.

▶ Freshman **Quinn McDowell** connected on a three-pointer with 2.2 seconds left to tie the game at 86 in the second OT and send the game into a third overtime.

▶ After falling behind by five (91-86) with 3:30 to play, **Clif Colbert** scored on a big rebound putback, and **Kaleo Kina's** three-pointer with 17 seconds left was the difference as Navy outlasted the Tribe, 102-99, in triple overtime.

▶ Kina and **Chris Harris** each scored 26 points, with all of Kina's production coming after halftime. **Adam Teague** added 18 points (six three-pointers) and **Mark Veazey** scored 10 points. Schneider and **Danny Sumner** scored 31 and 30, respectively, for William & Mary.

More Notes From Saturday

▶ **Chris Harris** played every second of the contest, a school-record 55 minutes, and was absolutely exhausted after the game. Not only did he carry a bulk of the offensive burden for the Mids, he ran all over the place on the defensive end, guarding Schneider. Despite Schneider scoring 31 points, Harris actually performed pretty well defensively, as half of Schneider's production came in the first 10 minutes of the contest. Every shot he took was contested hard by Harris and teammates.

▶ Navy scored 100 points in a game for the first time since Dec. 18, 2005, vs. Washington (Md.), a 106-80 win. It was the first time Navy scored over 100 against a Division I opponent since a 100-75 win over Lehigh on Jan. 29, 2000. Lastly, it was Navy's most points against a Division I foe since scoring 109 against Lehigh on Feb. 8, 1997.

▶ Navy has now played two triple-overtime games in the last five outings, dating back to last year, after playing in one in its first 2,116 games in program history.

▶ Navy's 14 three-pointers were a season high and rank as tied for the fifth most in school history. The 36 three-point attempts are the fifth most as well.

▶ **Kaleo Kina's** 26 points were one off his career high and was his 11th career 20-point game and 57th career double-figure game. Meanwhile, **Chris Harris'** 26 points was his 29th career double-figure scoring game and ninth career 20-point outing. He has scored in double-figures in 20 of the last 21 games, dating back to last year. Navy is 6-3 all-time when Harris reaches 20 points and 7-4 when Kina does it.

▶ Navy had two players connect on six three-pointers each (**Adam Teague** and **Chris Harris**) for the first time in school history.

▶ The 201 combined points were the fifth most in school history.

▶ Navy's **Adam Teague** (18 points) was just two points shy of giving Navy three 20-point scorers in a game for only the fourth time in school history, as **Chris Harris** and **Kaleo Kina** each had 26 points. The last time it happened came on Feb. 16, 1985, when **David Robinson** (31), **Vernon Butler** (24) and **Kylor Whitaker** (20) accomplished the feat against William & Mary.

▶ Navy's centers (**Mark Veazey** and **Jeremy Wilson**) went 8-of-10 from the field for 16 points and 10 rebounds in 47 minutes of action.

▶ Navy has seven players averaging at least 5.5 ppg, four players with 5.0 rpg and eight players averaging 10.0 rpg.

Noteworthy

▶ Navy is looking to become 4-1 for the second time in the last three years (2006-07 season started 4-1). Last year's team opened the year 2-3.

▶ Navy will go after its fifth straight non-conference home win on Tuesday night. The last time Navy won five straight non-conference home games came on Nov. 27, 1999 to Feb. 12, 2000, a nine-game streak.

▶ A win over UMES would give Navy its fourth straight win over the Hawks, which would tie for the third-longest active winning streak against one foe (Fairfield and William & Mary - after Saturday's victory).

▶ In regulation periods only, Navy has held three straight opponents to 66 points or less.

▶ Navy won its first game since Jan. 19, 2002, when allowing 90 or more points, with its 102-99 win over William & Mary.

▶ Navy boasts two of the league's top four scorers (Harris - 2nd; Kina - 4th).

▶ The Mids are 32-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than their opponent.

▶ Navy is 33-7 under coach Lange when shooting more free throws than its opponent.

▶ Through Sunday's games, Navy leads the league in scoring offense, rebounds per game, defensive rebounds per game and three-pointers made per game.

Mids Wage Yet Another Classic Battle

- ▶ Since the start of last year, Navy has played in some rather dramatic contests, perhaps none more dramatic than Saturday.
- ▶ Navy has been involved in both triple-overtime games involving Patriot League teams in leagus history.
- ▶ **Jan. 19, 2008** -- Lafayette battled back from a 15-point second-half deficit to claim a 103-99 overtime victory in Alumni Hall, in what was considered the wildest game, and perhaps the most exciting, in the Patriot League in a long time.
- ▶ **Jan. 27, 2008** -- **Jarell Brown's** driving layup gave Army a 69-67 victory in a sold-out Alumni Hall. After falling behind, 13-0, Navy led 55-46, before Army rallied with a 23-12 run to end the game.
- ▶ **Feb. 16, 2008** -- **Cliff Colbert's** eight-foot jumper with 0.4 seconds left gave Navy a thrilling 82-80 victory over Lafayette. The Mids led virtually the entire second half, but **Matt Betley** tied the game with just about 30 seconds left with a three-pointer.
- ▶ **March 5, 2008** -- **John Griffin** banked in a 40-foot runner as time expired to give Bucknell an 87-86 triple-overtime victory in the Patriot League Quarterfinals. Navy had led 45-28 with 15 minutes to play in the contest, and still led, 86-84, on a T.J. Topercer putbaack with just over two seconds remaining, before Griffin completed the Bucknell comeback.
- ▶ **Nov. 22, 2008** -- Navy withstood two game-tying three-pointers as the clock was winding down to force overtime and the third overtime in defeating William & Mary, 102-99, in three overtimes. Four players, **Chris Harris (26)**, **Kaleo Kina (26)**, **David Schneider (31)** and **Danny Sumner (30)**, combined for 113 of the 202 points scored in the game.

Team Update

- ▶ Navy appears to have righted the ship after a lackluster effort in the season-opening loss to Towson. Navy has won three straight games, thanks to strong defensive efforts in games against Howard, St. Francis (N.Y.) and William & Mary. Over the last three games (regulation only), Navy has held its foes to 68-of-166 (.410) from the field and just 184 points (61.3 per game). Then in the overtime sessions against William & Mary, the Tribe shot just 9-of-24 from the field (.375), after shooting 26-of-50 (.520) from the field in regulation. In the season opener against Towson, the Tigers shot 46.0 percent from the field and scored 49 second-half points (86 overall).
- ▶ Navy has taken over the league lead in scoring offense, thanks to a 102-point effort against William & Mary. The Mids, who have led the league in scoring in three of the last four years, are aveaging 77.8 points per game.
- ▶ However, thanks to allowing 99 points against the Tribe, Navy is now last in the league in scoring defense at 75.8 ppg. The Mids finished last in the league last year (league games only) in scoring defense.
- ▶ One area that Navy has really improved on since last year is in the rebounding department. Navy has outrebounded two of its four opponents by double-digit margins (Towson and William & Mary), been even with another foe (St. Francis) and lost by two on the glass to Howard. Navy is outrebounding foes, by an average of 5.8 per game, and has grabbed an average of 14.8 offensive rebounds per game, resulting in 52 second-chance points (13.0 ppg).
- ▶ The rebounding effort has helped Navy dominate the paint so far this year, outscoring foes, 134-98, an average of 9.0 points per game. Last year, Navy was outscored in the paint, 887-746, an average of over five points per game.
- ▶ Over the last two games, Navy has recorded 36 assists to 32 turnovers for a ratio of 1.13. In the first two games, Navy had 20 assists against 32 turnovers (0.63 ratio).
- ▶ Navy is shooting 76.2 percent from the free throw line in the last four minutes and overtime. Nineteen of Navy's 36 points in overtime against William & Mary came from the free throw line.
- ▶ Navy is shooting 36.6 percent (15-of-41) from three-point range at home, but is just 31.1 percent (19-of-61) away from Alumni Hall. In addition, Navy is at 80.0 percent (32-of-40) at home from the free throw line, but just 70.7 percent (29-of-41) away from home.

- ▶ Navy is shooting for its fifth straight non-conference home win, and needs just two wins for 150 all-time at Alumni Hall.

Previewing Maryland-Eastern Shore

- ▶ Maryland-Eastern Shore enters Tuesday night's contest with an 0-2 record after falling to Longwood in its home opener on Saturday, 61-49. Dating back to last year, the Hawks have lost nine straight games. UMES boasts a roster with three seniors, two juniors, three sophomores and six freshmen.
- ▶ UMES has struggled on the offensive end this year, being outscored by Stony Brook, 60-44, and by Longwood, 61-49. The Hawks rank 341st (our of 343) in scoring offense at just 46.5 ppg, and are 329th nationally in field goal percentage at 33.9 percent. However, UMES is winning the battle of the glass, outrebounding foes by four rebounds a game.
- ▶ The Hawks are led by junior forward **Neal Pitt** at 17.5 ppg and 10.5 rpg, ranking 39th nationally in rebounding. In the contest against Longwood, Pitt scored 21 (of the team's 49) points to go with 15 rebounds (nine offensive). Freshman **Keishawn Mayes** averages 11.0 ppg and 7.0 rpg.
- ▶ Frankie Allen is in his first year as UMES' head coach, boasting a 223-296 career record. He has served as the head coach at Virginia Tech, Tennessee State and Howard, as well as an assistant coach at UMBC for the past two years.

Series With the Hawks

▶ Navy leads the all-time series with Maryland-Eastern Shore, 4-1, and has won three meetings in a row by an average margin of 19.3 points per game. Navy will be looking for its fourth win in a row, which would tie Fairfield and William & Mary as the third-longest active winning streak against one opponent.

▶ The Mids are 1-1 all-time against UMES in Alumni Hall, falling to the Hawks, 82-71, on Dec. 11, 1993, before defeating UMES, 82-59, on Nov. 21, 2006.

▶ UMES will be the second of two MEAC opponents for Navy this year. The Mids defeated Howard, 66-55, on Nov. 16, and own a 9-2 all-time record against teams currently in the MEAC. Navy is 7-1 under **Billy Lange** against MEAC teams.

Last Meeting With the Hawks

▶ Navy cruised past UMES last year, 85-61, in Princess Anne, Md. The game was Navy's final contest before the Christmas break and during the last three years, the game has been the final game before a major holiday (2007 and 2009 seasons before Thanksgiving; 2008 before Christmas).

▶ Navy surged to a 41-23 halftime advantage, then watched UMES whittle the lead to six at 41-35 on the strength on a 12-0 run to start the second half. Navy answered by outscoring the Hawks, 44-26, during the final 15 minutes for the comfortable victory. Navy did turn the ball over 20 times in the win, while forcing just 15 UMES mistakes.

▶ Navy shot 50.8 percent from the field, and connected on 14-of-25 three-point tries. **Kaleo Kina** led three Navy players in double figures with 20 points, while **Chris Harris** had 19 and **Greg Sprink** had 15 points and nine rebounds. **Romeo Garcia** also had a strong game with six points, six rebounds and five assists.

▶ **Ed Tyson** led UMES with 16 points, while **Josh Bright** had 13 points on just 4-of-17 shooting. Just three current UMES players saw action against Navy last year.

Centers Give a Lift

▶ Navy's centers have taken ownership of the position, and are playing at a high level during Navy's three-game streak.

▶ **Mark Veazey** has started the last three games, and is shooting 73.3 percent (11-of-15) from the field. He went 5-of-5 from the field against William & Mary with 10 points and six rebounds. He has made six shots in a row dating back to the St. Francis (N.Y.) contest.

▶ **Jeremy Wilson** went 3-of-5 from the field against the Tribe, scoring on a wide variety of post moves. He scored six points, tying a career high, while setting career highs in minutes (15) and rebounds (4).

▶ The duo went 8-of-10 from the field with 16 points, 10 rebounds, one assist, one turnover and one block in 47 minutes.

▶ For the season, the pair is shooting a combined 17-of-23 (.739) from the field, and averaging 14.7 ppg and 11.3 rpg in 40.3 minutes of action.

▶ The duo is a big reason why Navy is outscoring foes in the paint by almost nine points per game and is averaging nearly 15 offensive rebounds per game. The pair has hauled down 13 offensive rebounds between them in four games.

Home Is Where You Can Find the "W"

▶ Navy has turned around its offensive fortunes in the last three games, starting with Navy's first two home games of the year. The Mids have won the games by an average of 11.5 points per game, while shooting 41.6 percent (47-of-113) from the field, and 80.0 percent (32-of-40) from the free throw line, while committing just 28 turnovers and recording 27 assists.

▶ In Navy's lone loss this year, on the road to CAA member Towson, Navy shot just 37.5 percent and turned the ball over 18 times with just 10 assists.

▶ Navy has won four non-conference home games in a row and has a chance to run the streak to five on Tuesday when Maryland-Eastern Shore comes to town.

▶ In addition, Navy has won five of its last six home games, with the lone loss coming on a 40-foot miracle shot by Bucknell's **John Griffin** in the third overtime of last year's Patriot League Tournament quarterfinals.

Early-Season Struggles

▶ *Navy's big three shooters of Chris Harris, Kaleo Kina and Adam Teague have yet to find their offensive range.*

48 points between them. Then, in the win over William & Mary, the trio scored 70 points on 20-of-45 (.444) from the field, including 13-of-30 (.433) from the three-point line.

▶ In the last two games, the trio is averaging 59.0 ppg between them, while shooting 37-of-78 (.474) from the field, including 19-of-46 (.413) from three-point range. In addition, they are averaging 13.0 rpg and 9.5 apg during that span.

Struggling to Find the Range

▶ Despite starting the year 3-1, Navy hasn't fired on all cylinders yet. The Mids are shooting just 41.5 percent from the field, and 33.3 percent from three-point range.

▶ Navy's big three shooters of **Chris Harris**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** are shooting just a combined 58-of-149 (.389) from the field, including 26-of-78 (.333) from three-point range.

▶ However, the trio is showing signs of turning it around, connecting on 17-of-34 (.500) field goal attempts and 6-of-16 (.375) three-point attempts in the win over St. Francis (N.Y.), scoring

Harris Getting It Done at the Line

- ▶ When **Greg Sprink** graduated last year, many wondered who would get to the line for the Mids. **Chris Harris** has filled that role admirably and has made it count at the line.
- ▶ Harris leads the Patriot League in free throws made (24) and free throw attempts (28). He ranks sixth in the league in free throw percentage (.857), but no one else in the top 10 has shot more than 19 free throws (Holy Cross' **Adam May**).
- ▶ While Harris is shooting 85.7 percent from the line (24-of-28), including 88.9 percent (16-of-18) in the last four minutes and overtime, teammates are shooting just 69.8 percent (37-of-53) from the stripe, and 66.7 percent (16-of-24) in the last four minutes and overtime.
- ▶ If you exclude Kaleo Kina (11-of-13 fts) from the mix, Navy is just 26-of-40 (.650) from the stripe.
- ▶ Harris has already been to the line 10 or more times in a game twice this year (Howard & William & Mary).
- ▶ Harris ranks 19th nationally in free throws made, and His free throw attempts account for 34.6 percent of all of Navy's made free throw attempts, the 16th highest figure nationally.

Kina About to Join Elite Company

- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** became Navy's newest member of the 1,000-point club with his 11-point performance against Howard. He followed up that performance with his best games of the young season in Navy's last two wins. Over the last two outings, Kina is averaging 22.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 3.0 apg and 1.0 spg, while shooting 57.1 percent (16-of-28) from the field.
- ▶ Kina's 26 points against William & Mary came after the halftime break and were just one point shy of his career high, set against Bucknell (27 on Feb. 9, 2008)
- ▶ Kina needs just 11 assists and four steals to become the seventh player in Patriot League history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 150 steals. He would become the first Navy player in school history to reach those marks.

Seniors Learn of Their Service Selections

- ▶ Navy's four seniors all earned their post-graduate service selections in a ceremony on Wednesday, Nov. 19.
- ▶ **Clif Colbert**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** all received Surface Warfare Officer (SWO), while **Brian Richards** received Naval Flight Officer (NFO).
- ▶ A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.
- ▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.
- ▶ Three seniors received their first choice, as Richards was not able to receive his first choice. However, his first choice was pilot and he knew going in that he would not be able to receive that selection, because he is too tall.
- ▶ The four seniors will receive their military billets in mid February.

- ▶ American was a "unanimous" pick to repeat gathering 14 (of a possible 14) first-place votes. Holy Cross, who was selected third, earned the other two first-place votes.
- ▶ The Mids return seven of their top eight scorers off last year's team that finished second in the league race. Last year's squad was picked seventh in the preseason poll.

Head Coach Billy Lange

▶ **Seventh Year Overall:** 92-86 (.517)

▶ **Fifth Year at Navy:** 53-67 (.442)

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

▶ Last year's team forced 568 turnovers, the third-highest total in school history ... the Mids also averaged 9.1 steals per game a year ago, the first-best mark in school history.

▶ Freshmen have earned five all-Patriot League Rookie Team accolades in Lange's four years ... prior to his arrival, just 11 freshmen won all-rookie team honors in 13 years ... Lange has had at least one freshman in the starting lineup in 111 of the 116 games he has coached at Navy.

▶ The Mids have made at least one three-pointer in every game under Lange and at least three three-pointers in every game but one.

▶ 2008 grad Greg Sprink was named Navy's first Patriot League Player of the Year in school history a year ago ... he was also Navy's first All-American since the great David Robinson in the 1987 season.

▶ Lastly, team GPA has increased every year since Lange took over ... the team GPA has increased by 0.30 points since his arrival ... eight players a year ago recorded a GPA of 2.72 or better during the spring semester.
