Notes: Has had at least two assists in seven straight games, averaging 3.9 apg during that span ... also has 24 turnovers in the last seven games ... still learning the Navy offense after transferring from the University of Idaho following his freshman year ... grabbed his 100th career rebound against UTSA and now has over 100 points, rebounds and assists ... was 2-of-2 from the field against Penn.

Notes: Harris was named preseason first-team All-Patriot League ... played a school-record 55 minutes against William & Mary (every second of a triple-overtime win) ... has scored in double figures in 23 of the last 25 games; Navy is 18-7 in that span ... three-pointer in 29 straight games; has 106 three-pointers in that span ... fourth player in school history with 140 career three-pointers.

Notes: Named Patriot League Player of the Week on Dec. 1 ... has scored 30, 29 and 28 points in the last three games, shooting 26-of-48 from the field ... has shot 42 free throws in the last three games, making 32, including 9-of-9 vs. Penn ... his 59 free throw attempts rank as the 11th most nationally ... in six Navy wins, he is averaging 22.0 ppg and 6.0 rpg, while shooting 49.5 percent; in one loss, 10.0 ppg and 3.0 rpg.

Notes: Missed the first five outings with a pulled hamstring ... one of the top defensive players in the Patriot League, Garcia has four blocks and four steals in just three games ... still shaking off the rust, but will be called upon for a much bigger role this year ... one of two freshman guards nationally a year ago with 100 pts, 100 rebs, 30 asts, 25 steals and 17 blocks.

Notes: Continues his development, scoring a career-high 14 points against UTSA ... leads the Patriot League in rebounding (6.9) ... has had two games this year where he was perfect from the field (5-of-5 vs. William & Mary; 4-of-4 vs. UTSA) ... leads the team in field goal percentage (.594) and free throw percentage (.840) ... needs three blocks for 50 in his career; celebrating 20th birthday on Sunday.

Notes: A tough, gritty player, Connolly led North Allegheny High School to a school-record 23 wins in 2008 ... has done an excellent job running the scout team in practice ... his brother, Jack, currently plays football at Dickinson College (D-III) ... was a strong safety in football ... was a member of the *Pittsburgh Post Gazette* North Fabulous Five.

Notes: Has made a three-pointer in two of his first five games this season ... his three rebounds and 13 minutes played against Towson tied career highs ... his first career points came on a steal and a breakaway dunk ... an outstanding athlete, Brown has a lot of potential ... played in the WCAC, one of the toughest H.S. conferences in America.

Notes: A very solid player, Colbert is averaging career highs in points (6.4), rebounds (5.1), assists (1.3) and minutes (23.0) ... ranks ninth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (2.25) ... shooting 21-of-37 (.598) from inside the three-point arc ... has six games of at least five rebounds this year.

Notes: Played well off the bench against UMES, connecting on a three-pointer and all four of his free throws for a season-high seven points ... had a strong preseason and will be called upon to give the Mids a presence in the middle ... is ambidextrous ... when Navy SID Chris Forman gives him a piece of gum before the game this year, Navy is 7-0.

Notes: Ranked eighth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (1.78) a year ago ... has been plagued the last two years with a variety of leg injuries ... goes after the rebound relentlessly ... had seven rebounds in just 21 minutes in his first two games ... earned the start against Towson in place of Mark Veazey.

Notes: Had a good game off the bench against Radford, scoring six points in just nine minutes ... averaged 13.5 mpg in the first four games, but just 6.0 mpg in the last three ... opened the year making his first five three-point attempts, before missing against William & Mary ... H.S. record holder in points, rebounds and steals and is third in assists.

Notes: Has equaled his career assist production already after having two dimes in first two years at Navy ... was aggressive against UMES, going to the hole hard and connecting on both field goal attempts ... grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against Towson ... eight of his 17 rebounds have come on the offensive end.

Notes: Has made a three-pointer in all eight games this year ... ranks tied for seventh on the career three-pointers made list (134) ... in the last six games, Teague is averaging 12.7 ppg while shooting 27-of-48 (.563) from the field and 18-of-33 (.545) from three-point range ...has nine assists against one turnover in the last four games.

Notes: Leads the team in field goal percentage (7-of-10; .700), a total that would rank first in the Patriot League had he had enough attempts ... earned second career start against Radford ... went 3-of-3 from the field against Towson and 3-of-5 against William & Mary ... per 40 minutes, is averaging 14.8 ppg and 8.7 rpg.

Navy Faces Stiff Challenge on Sunday in the BB&T Classic Against Virginia Tech

The Navy men's basketball team aims to continue its best start in 25 years with its stiffest challenge of the season, battling Virginia Tech in the BB&T Classic on Sunday afternoon at 5:00 pm in the Verizon Center in Washington, D.C. The Mids enter the contest with a 7-1 overall record, while Virginia Tech is 4-3 overall. The game will be the first end of a doubleheader as Maryland and George Washington will battle in the nightcap, beginning at approximately 7:30 pm.

The game will be televised by MASN with **Bob Carpenter** and **John Feinstein** calling all the action. On the radio waves, **Pete Medhurst** will handle the call on WNAV (1430 AM), WFED (1050 AM) and SIRIUS (Channel 152), beginning with the Navy basketball pregame show at 4:45 pm.

Quickie Notes

- ▶ Navy's 7-1 start is the program's best since starting 8-0 in the 1983-84 season, **David Robinson's** freshman year.
- ▶ Navy's seven-game winning streak is the longest since 1999-2000, and the longest of the **Billy Lange** era.
- ▶ The seven-game non-conference winning streak is the longest since Dec. 8, 1984, to March 4, 1985, a nine-game streak.
- ▶ Navy's 71.4 percent (25-of-35) shooting against Texas-San Antonio is the nation's best single-game percentage early on this year. In addition, the percentage is the fourth-best total in school history and best since 1987.
- ▶ The Mids' 84.2 shooting percentage (16-of-19) in the second half was the third best percentage in a half in school history.
- ▶ In the win over Texas-San Antonio, Navy started the game 0-of-5, but made 25 of its last 30 shots in the last 34 minutes.
- ▶ Navy's win over Penn on Friday night snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Quakers, the third-longest active streak against one foe.
- ▶ The victory was also Navy's first in the Palestra against Penn since Dec. 5, 1959, a span of 49 years to the day. The Quakers had won 15 straight games against Navy in the Palestra, prior to Friday night.
- ▶ The Mids are 36-7 under **Billy Lange** when attempting more free throws than their opponent.
- ▶ Navy leads the Patriot League in scoring offense (76.8), scoring margin (+7.4) and rebounds per game (41.4).
- ▶ Navy owns a 98-93 record all-time against the Atlantic Coast Conference, but is looking for its first win over an active member of the ACC in almost 37 years. Navy's last win against an opponent that was in the ACC at the time of the game came on Dec. 30, 1971, against Wake Forest (72-62).
- ▶ Navy is just 6-13 on the anniversary of the bombing of Pearl Harbor. The Mids have lost 10-of-11 games on the date.
- ▶ Navy is 3-2 all-time against Virginia Tech, but this will be the team's first meeting since 1963-64.
- ▶ Navy will be celebrating two birthdays on Sunday. Sophomore center **Mark Veazey** will turn 20 on Sunday and athletic trainer **Adam Pecina** will be 33 years old.

Navy Defense Notes

- ▶ Navy has held seven straight foes to 66 points or less in regulation periods. Radford scored 71 in a single-overtime game, but had 63 in regulation. William & Mary scored 99 points in three overtimes, but had 66 in regulation.
- ▶ During Navy's seven-game win streak, the Mids have held foes to an average of 67.0 ppg and just 38.8 percent shooting for the field. Foes are connecting on 33.1 percent of three-point attempts, and have turned the ball over 16.4 times a game.
- ▶ Four straight foes have shot under 43.6 percent.
- ▶ In addition, Navy owns a +3.6 rebound margin. The Mids are third in the league in rebounding margin and second in the Patriot League in field goal percentage defense, one year after finishing sixth and seventh, respectively.

Navy Individual Notes

- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** has scored in double figures in 11 straight games. He is the league's leading scorer (20.5 ppg) and is averaging 24.8 ppg in the last five games with four 20-point performances. He scored a career-high 30 points in the win over Radford. In addition, Kina is averaging 12.3 ppg in the second half of games. In the last five games, Kina is averaging 19.4 ppg after halftime (26 vs. William & Mary, 7 vs. UMES, 26 vs. Radford, 21 vs. UTSA and 17 vs. Penn).
- ▶ **Chris Harris** ranks fourth in the Patriot League in scoring (16.5 ppg) and has made 26 three-pointers this year. Harris has 141 career three-pointers to become the fourth player in school history with 140 or more three-pointers. Harris has made a three-pointer in a school-record 29 straight games, with 106 three-pointers during that span.
- ▶ **Adam Teague** is third on the team in scoring (10.9 ppg). When Teague scores in double figures in his career, Navy is 16-6. Teague has made a three-pointer in every game this year and has 134 career three-pointers to rank tied for seventh on the career three-pointers made list. Over the last six games, Teague is averaging 12.7 ppg on 27-of-48 (.563) from the field.
- ▶ **Romeo Garcia** missed the first five games of the season with a pulled hamstring, but has shown his versatility and value lately. In the win over Penn, Garcia scored four points with a team-best seven rebounds, two assists, two blocks, one steal and three drawn charges. Garcia was one of two freshman guards nationally last year (Arizona State's **James Harden**) with at least 100 points, 100 rebounds, 30 assists, 25 steals and 17 blocks. A 6-4 guard, Garcia has 21 blocked shots in 31 career games.
- ▶ **Mark Veazey** has been a big reason for Navy's inside presence. Veazey is averaging a Patriot League-best 6.9 rebounds per game, in addition to averaging 8.4 ppg. Veazey recorded his first career double-double (10 p, 11 r) in the win over St. Francis (N.Y.) and then scored a career-high 14 points against Texas-San Antonio. He has grabbed at least five rebounds in all seven games he has played in and has 47 career blocked shots in 37 career games.

Navy-Virginia Tech Series History

This will be just the sixth meeting between the two teams, as Navy leads the series, 3-2. The Mids won the first three games in the series, but the Hokies are on a current two-game winning streak over the Mids.

The Hokies won the last meeting, 79-54, in Blacksburg on Feb. 15, 1964. Navy's three wins came in the 1913-14, 1921-22 and 1936-37 seasons.

Navy vs. The Atlantic Coast Conference

Navy leads the Atlantic Coast Conference in 191 meetings all-time, 98-93. The Mids last win over a team that was in the ACC at the time of the game came on Dec. 30, 1971, a 72-62 win over Wake Forest in Pittsburgh, Pa.

Navy did defeat Miami (Fla.), 78-62, on Feb. 7, 1987, but the Hurricanes were not a member of the ACC at the time of the contest.

Navy has lost 18 straight games against ACC foes, dating back to the 1971 win over the Demon Deacons.

Navy vs. the State of Virginia

Navy has played 12 schools from the state of Virginia and lead the all-time series, 140-83. Navy is already 2-0 this year against Virginia, defeating William & Mary, 102-99 in three overtimes on Nov. 22, and topping Radford, 73-71 in overtime on Nov. 29.

Besides the contest with Virginia Tech, Navy will also play the Farmville, Va., school, Longwood, on Dec. 30.

Navy has won seven straight games against the state of Virginia, dating back to a 78-73 loss to Virginia Military on Nov. 28, 2004. Lange is 7-1 against Virginia schools.

On This Date - December 7

The Navy basketball team has not performed well on the anniversary of Pearl Harbor (Dec. 7, 1941), recording just a 6-13 record on the date. The Mids have lost 10 of their last 11 games on December 7.

Four of Navy's six wins on the date have come against non-Division I schools, giving the Mids just a 2-13 mark against Division I foes on Pearl Harbor Day.

▶ **Seventh Year Overall:** 96-86 (.527)

▶ **Fifth Year at Navy:** 57-67 (.460)

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

▶ Last year's team forced 568 turnovers, the third-highest total in school history ... the Mids also averaged 9.1 steals per game a year ago, the first-best mark in school history.

▶ Freshmen have earned five all-Patriot League Rookie Team accolades in Lange's four years ... prior to his arrival, just 11 freshmen won all-rookie team honors in 13 years ... Lange has had at least one freshman in the starting lineup in 111 of the 116 games he has coached at Navy.

▶ The Mids have made at least one three-pointer in every game under Lange and at least three three-pointers in every game but one.

▶ 2008 grad Greg Sprink was named Navy's first Patriot League Player of the Year in school history a year ago ... he was also Navy's first All-American since the great David Robinson in the 1987 season.

▶ Lastly, team GPA has increased every year since Lange took over ... the team GPA has increased by 0.30 points since his arrival ... eight players a year ago recorded a GPA of 2.72 or better during the spring semester.
