Notes: A tough, gritty player, Connolly led North Allegheny High School to a school-record 23 wins in 2008 ... has done an excellent job running the scout team in practice ... his brother, Jack, currently plays football at Dickinson College (D-III) ... was a strong safety in football ... was a member of the *Pittsburgh Post Gazette* North Fabulous Five.

Notes: Has made a three-pointer in two of the first five games this season ... his three rebounds and 13 minutes played against Towson tied career highs ... his first career points came on a steal and a breakaway dunk ... an outstanding athlete, Brown has a lot of potential ... played in the WCAC, one of the toughest H.S. conferences in America.

Notes: Since the start of last year, Colbert has a 1.54 (20-to-13) assist-to-turnover ratio and is shooting 53-of-98 (.541) from the field ... has grabbed at least five rebounds in every game but one this year ... is averaging career highs in minutes (26.0), points (7.2), rebounds (5.7) and assists (1.5) ... entered the year averaging just 1.9 rpg for his career.

Notes: Saw his first action of the season, playing 24 minutes against Radford ... missed first five games with a pulled hamstring ... was slated to play about 10-12 minutes against Radford ... one of the top defensive players in the Patriot League, Garcia had two blocks and three steals against Radford ... enjoys being a leader.

Notes: Played well off the bench against UMES, connecting on a three-pointer and all four of his free throws for a season-high seven points ... fouled out in 13 minutes against the Hawks ... had a strong preseason and will be called upon to give the Mids a presence in the middle ... AAU teammate of current teammate Kaleo Kina ... is ambidextrous.

Notes: Ranked eighth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (1.78) a year ago ... has battled leg injuries to give the Mids a strong inside presence ... goes after the rebound relentlessly ... had seven rebounds in just 21 minutes in his first two games ... earned the start against Towson in place of Mark Veazey.

Notes: Had a good game off the bench against Radford, scoring six points in just nine minutes ... has alternated scoring in the last five games, going pointless against St. Francis and UMES ... opened the year making his first five three-point attempts, before missing against William & Mary ... H.S. record holder in points, rebounds and steals.

Notes: Has equaled his career assist production already after having two dimes in first two years at Navy ... was aggressive against UMES, going to the hole hard and connecting on both field goal attempts ... grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against Towson ... eight of his 14 rebounds have come on the offensive end.

Notes: Leads the team in field goal percentage (.700), a total that would rank first had he had enough attempts ... earned second career start against the Highlanders ... per 40 minutes, Wilson is averaging 15.6 ppg and 9.1 rpg ... went 3-of-3 from the field against Towson and 3-of-5 against William & Mary.

Game Preview

▶ The Navy men's basketball team looks to continue its early-season success on Tuesday night as it will play its final home game of a three-game homestand, hosting Texas-San Antonio at Alumni Hall, beginning at 7:00 pm (ET). The Mids, winners of five in a row, boast a 5-1 overall record, including a 4-0 mark at Alumni Hall. The Roadrunners enter the contest with a 2-2 overall mark, having lost tight games to Iowa and Oklahoma State.

▶ Tuesday's game will air on WNAV (1430 AM / WNAV.com) and WFED (1050 AM / FederalNewsRadio.com) as well as on SIRIUS (Channel 127). The game will be streamed online for Navy All-Access users at NavySports.com. **Pete Medhurst** and **Michael Heary**, making his debut as Navy's color man, will call all the action, beginning at 6:45 pm (ET) with Navy basketball pregame show.

Saturday's Radford Recap

▶ For the second time in three games, Navy was forced to go to an extra session, but the result was the same, pulling out a 73-71 overtime victory over Radford on Saturday night at Alumni Hall. The Mids trailed by four at halftime, but led for most of the second half. A late Radford run gave the Highlanders a 61-56 lead with two minutes to play. The Mids would answer with a 7-0 run, and Radford scored with 25 seconds left to force overtime.

▶ In the extra session, **Kaleo Kina's** three-pointer with 20 seconds left proved to be the difference as Navy withstood three Radford shots in the final 10 seconds for the 73-71 overtime victory.

▶ The Mids shot just 35.5 percent from the field, 13.8 percent from three-point range and 61.0 percent from the free throw line, but used a 20-8 advantage in points off turnovers to earn the victory. The Mids forced a season-high 23 turnovers.

▶ Navy shot 18-of-33 (.545) from inside the three-point line, including 8-of-13 (.615) after halftime.

▶ Kina led the Mids with a career-high 30 points, becoming the 23rd player in school history to tally 30 points in a contest. For the second Saturday in a row, Kina scored 26 points after halftime to spark the Navy attack. Kina scored 26 of Navy's 46 points after the break. He added a team-best six rebounds, three steals and two assists.

▶ Navy also got a spark from **Romeo Garcia**, playing in his first game of the year. Garcia scored eight points with three steals, two blocked shots and two rebounds in 24 minutes. He missed the first five games with a hamstring injury.

More Notes From Saturday

▶ Kina moved into 17th place on the career scoring list with 1,094 career points, passing Jack Conrad (1969-71).

▶ Kina grabbed his 150th career steal in the victory.

▶ **Chris Harris** connected on a three-pointer for the 27th consecutive game.

▶ Navy had just one player in double figures for the first time since Feb. 28, 2007, vs. Bucknell. However, Navy had six players score between six and eight points against the Highlanders.

▶ Navy's bench outscored Radford, 28-6. The bench produced 18 of Navy's 27 first-half points.

▶ There were 12 ties and 12 lead changes in the contest.

▶ The game produced 61 fouls and 10 of the 22 players that played had at least four fouls. Navy's 29 fouls were the most since having 30 against Washington (Md.) on Dec. 18, 2005.

▶ Navy's 41 free throw attempts marks the first time that Navy has shot more than 40 free throws in a contest since Jan. 16, 2002, vs. Lehigh. The 41 attempts were the most since Navy shot 42 against Army on Jan. 24, 2001.

▶ Navy's four three-pointers were the fewest in the last 25 games, dating back to a Dec. 3, 2007, contest against Mount St. Mary's, when Navy went 4-of-22 behind the arc. Navy is now just 5-16 under **Billy Lange** when making four or fewer three-pointers in a contest.

▶ Navy improved to 6-4 under Billy Lange in overtime games, including 2-0 this year. Navy was 0-2 in OT games a year ago.

▶ In regulation periods only, the Mids have held five straight opponents to 66 or fewer points.

▶ The win was Navy's 150th all-time in Alumni Hall. In its 18th year in the building, Navy owns a 150-87 (.633) record.

▶ Navy is now 2-0 in games decided by five or fewer points, one year after registering a 3-6 record.

Noteworthy

▶ The Mids are 5-1 for the first time since the 1998-99 season. That team started 6-1 en route to a 20-7 overall record.

▶ Navy is 4-0 at Alumni Hall for the second time in three years (2006-07), and are outscoring its foes by 12.5 ppg (72.5 to 60.0) in games played at the facility. Navy is holding foes to just 36.2 percent shooting and 28.8 percent from three-point range in its four home games. Navy hasn't started 5-0 at Alumni Hall since 1998-99.

▶ Navy has won six straight non-conference games at home for the first time since Nov. 27, 1999, to Feb. 12, 2000, a nine-game streak.

▶ Navy's five-game non-conference winning streak overall is the longest since Dec. 28, 1999, to Feb. 12, 2000.

▶ Navy leads the league in scoring offense (76.7), rebounds per game (42.2) and three-pointers made per game (8.67).

▶ The Mids boast two of the top three scorers in the Patriot League in **Kaleo Kina** (17.8; 2nd) and **Chris Harris** (17.0; 3rd). Navy's **Mark Veazey** also leads the league in rebounding, and Navy has three of the top nine rebounders in Veazey (7.5), Kina (5.7) and **Clif Colbert** (5.7).

▶ Navy is receiving two votes in the CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25, announced on Monday. The Mids are also ranked 11th (out of 29 teams) in the DelMarva/DC College Basketball Rankings, compiled Monday by the Washington Times' **Patrick Stevens**.

Mids Wage Yet Another Classic Battle

▶ Since the start of last year, Navy has played in some rather dramatic contests. In two of the last three games, Navy has been forced to play overtime, winning them both. Saturday's game against Radford was just another classic game in the last year.

▶ Navy has been involved in both triple-overtime games involving Patriot League teams in league history. The first one came against Bucknell (March 5, 2008) and the latest against William & Mary (Nov. 22, 2008)

▶ **Jan. 19, 2008** -- Lafayette battled back from a 15-point second-half deficit to claim a 103-99 overtime victory in Alumni Hall, in what was considered the wildest game, and perhaps the most exciting, in the Patriot League in a long time.

▶ **Jan. 27, 2008** -- **Jarell Brown's** driving layup gave Army a 69-67 victory in a sold-out Alumni Hall. After falling behind, 13-0, Navy led 55-46, before Army rallied with a 23-12 run to end the game.

▶ **Feb. 16, 2008** -- **Cliff Colbert's** eight-foot jumper with 0.4 seconds left gave Navy a thrilling 82-80 victory over Lafayette. The Mids led virtually the entire second half, but **Matt Betley** tied the game with just about 30 seconds left with a three-pointer.

▶ **March 5, 2008** -- **John Griffin** banked in a 40-foot runner as time expired to give Bucknell an 87-86 triple-overtime victory in the Patriot League Quarterfinals. Navy had led 45-28 with 15 minutes to play in the contest, and still led, 86-84, on a T.J. Topercer putbaack with just over two seconds remaining, before Griffin completed the Bucknell comeback.

▶ **Nov. 22, 2008** -- Navy withstood two game-tying three-pointers as the clock was winding down to force overtime and the third overtime in defeating William & Mary, 102-99, in three overtimes. Four players, **Chris Harris (26)**, **Kaleo Kina (26)**, **David Schneider (31)** and **Danny Sumner (30)**, combined for 113 of the 202 points scored in the game.

▶ **Nov. 29, 2008** -- Navy's **Kaleo Kina** connected on huge three-pointers at the end of regulation (42 seconds left) and overtime (20 seconds left) to give Navy a thrilling 73-71 win over Radford. Kina's three in regulation gave Navy a two-point lead, which Radford erased with a basket with 25 seconds left. His three in overtime game Navy a four-point lead with 20 seconds left to play. Kina finished with 30 points, including 26 after halftime, and six coming in the extra session.

Who's Hot

▶ **Kaleo Kina** -- Was named Patriot League Player of the Week after averaging 20.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 2.5 apg and 2.5 spg in two Navy wins last week. Kina has scored in double figures in nine straight games and needs six points for 1,100 in his career. Over the last four games, Kina is averaging 21.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 2.8 apg and 1.8 spg while shooting 28-of-59 (.475) from the field and 8-of-22 (.364) from three three-point line.

▶ **Kaleo Kina After Halftime** -- While averaging just 4.5 ppg and shooting just 31.3 percent (10-of-32) in the first half of games this year, **Kaleo Kina** has picked it up after the halftime break. He is averaging 13.3 ppg and shooting 48.2 percent (27-of-56) from the field after halftime. He has shot just five free throws before halftime this year and 30 after the break.

▶ **Navy In The Second Half** -- Much like Kina, the Navy basketball team has also found success after halftime. The Mids are being outscored in the first half, 30.5 to 29.7, but outscore opponents 39.3 to 33.5 in the second half. In the first half, Navy is shooting just 36.0 percent from the field, while foes are shooting 41.7 percent. However, in the second half, Navy is shooting 43.6 percent compared to opponent's 39.8 shooting percentage.

▶ **Navy's Defense** -- After a lackluster showing in the opener against Towson, Navy's defense appears to have righted the proverbial ship. In the five games since, Navy is allowing just 67.8 ppg, but in regulation play only, the Mids are allowing just 59.6 ppg (William & Mary scored 36 points in OT, while Radford scored 10). During the last five games, Navy is holding foes to shoot just 39.0 percent from the field and 33.3 percent from three-point range and has forced an average of 17.2 turnovers per game. In the opener against Towson, Navy allowed 86 points, the Tigers shot 46.0 percent and had just seven turnovers.

▶ **Romeo Garcia** -- Garcia missed the first five games of the season, but didn't miss a beat in his first action of the year against Radford on Saturday. The 6-4 sophomore guard scored eight points with three steals, two blocks and two rebounds in 24 minutes. He was one of two freshman guards nationally (Arizona State's **James Harden**) to stuff the statsheet like no other a year ago, producing 100 points, 100 rebounds, 30 assists, 25 steals and 17 blocked shots.

▶ **Navy's Bench** -- While nearly the entire starting five was in foul trouble on Saturday night, the Navy bench kept the team afloat and in position to win. The Navy bench scored 18 of Navy's 27 first-half points and finished with a 28-6 points advantage over its Radford counterparts. Navy is outscoring its opponent's bench by seven points (22.3 to 15.3) per game and is shooting 43.1 percent from the field, compared to 39.1 percent by Navy's starters.

Who's Not

▶ **Navy at the Free Throw Line** -- Despite shooting 94 free throws in the last three games, getting to the line has not been that kind for the Navy men's basketball team. The Mids have made just 61 of those 94 attempts for a percentage of 64.9 percent. In the first three games, Navy was 41-of-52 (.788) from the charity stripe. Nonetheless, Navy is outscoring its foes from the free throw line this year, 102-98.

▶ **Navy's Foul Problems** -- In the last three halves (the second half vs. UMES and the entire game against Radford), Navy has committed 46 fouls, resulting in 61 foul shots for opponents. Of the 88 points scored against Navy in the last three halves (not including OT vs. Radford), 36 of the points have come from the free throw line.

▶ **Navy's Three-Point Shooting** -- Entering Saturday's game with Radford, the Mids had been red-hot from three-point range in the previous two games. However, Saturday's performance from behind the arc brought the Mids back to Earth. Navy made just 4-of-29 (.138) three-point attempts on Saturday, and for the season, the Mids are shooting just 32.1 percent from three-point range. Last year's squad made 35.1 percent of its three-point attempts. Navy's three-point percentage dropped 40 points from .361 to .321 from the Radford to UTSA games.

Previewing Texas-San Antonio

▶ Texas-San Antonio enters the game with a 2-2 overall record, with victories over D-III McMurry, 80-55, and D-II East Central, 136-68. The Roadrunners' two losses have come to Oklahoma State (76-57) and Iowa (73-67). In the win over East Central, the Roadrunners set six school records including points (136), scoring margin (+68), field goal attempts (97) and three-pointers made (17) and attempted (43). In the last two games, UTSA has forced 62 turnovers, including 37 steals.

▶ The Roadrunners are led by 5-7 lightning bug **Omar Johnson**, who is averaging 15.3 ppg and 5.0 apg and is shooting 46.2 percent (12-of-26) from three-point range. **Travis Gabbidon** is averaging 13.0 ppg and 4.5 rpg and **Joey Shank** and **Devin Gibson** chip in at 9.8 ppg. Gibson was the NCAA's steals leader as a freshman a year ago and is one of 31 nominees for the Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's best player that stands 6-0 or shorter.

▶ As a team, UTSA is averaging 85.0 ppg and outrebounding foes, 40.2 to 34.8. Opponents have committed 25 more turnovers than UTSA and the squad is shooting 45.0 percent from the field and 37.4 percent from three-point range.

▶ **Brooks Thompson** is in his third year in charge, owning a 22-41 mark in San Antonio. He is 77-55 in his fifth year overall after serving as the

head coach at Yavapai College (Junior College) for three years, posting a 55-14 record there.

Connections With UTSA

▶ Despite being separated by about 2,000 miles, there are several connections between the two teams.

▶ **Kaleo Kina** and **Travis Gabbidon** both hail from Phoenix, Ariz. Kina attended Trevor Browne H.S., while Gabbidon matriculated at Desert Vista H.S.

▶ **Romeo Garcia** considers **Devin Gibson** his best friend from another college team. Garcia and Gibson were AAU teammates on the Houston Heat. Garcia attended Cypress Creek H.S., while Gibson was at Cypress Falls H.S. Gibson was heavily recruited by Navy head coach **Billy Lange**.

▶ Navy has four players on its roster from Texas (**Jeremy Wilson**, **O.J. Awworo**, **Romeo Garcia** and **Clif Colbert**).

▶ Head coaches **Billy Lange** and **Brooks Thompson** both graduated from their respective colleges in 1994. Lange graduated from Rowan, while Thompson graduated from Oklahoma State.

▶ Former Navy great **David Robinson** resides in San Antonio, and runs the Carver Academy, which opened in 2001. The academy is designed to serve elementary-age children from San Antonio's culturally and economically diverse community. Robinson was a perennial all-star for the San Antonio Spurs.

Series With the Roadrunners

▶ UTSA leads the all-time series with Navy, 1-0, defeating the Mids, 77-67, in the Alamodome on Nov. 17, 2007. It is the only meeting all-time for Navy against a Southland Conference team. This is a return trip from that game.

▶ The 2007-08 contest was a warm-up for the 2008 Final Four, hosted in the facility. NCAA rules require at least one regular-season game to be played in the Final Four facility. That was the lone regular-season game.

▶ **Devin Gibson** led a balanced UTSA attack with 19 points, while **Travis Gabbidon** added 16. **Isaiah Allen** and **Joey Shank** had 13 and 12 points, respectively. Navy lost despite outrebounding the Roadrunners, 35-33, and shooting 47.2 percent from the field, thanks in large part to 27 turnovers and 16 UTSA steals. **Clif Colbert**, who played virtually the entire second half with a broken shooting wrist and a cut above his left eye, led Navy with 14 points, while **Greg Sprink** and **Kaleo Kina** added 13 and 10 points, respectively.

▶ **Kaleo Kina** needs just six assists to become the seventh player in Patriot League history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 150 steals. He would become the first Navy player in school history to reach those marks.

▶ Kina became the fourth Navy player with 150 career steals and the third of the four to score 1,000 points. **Chris Williams** and **David Robinson** are the other two Navy players with 1,000 points and 150 steals.

▶ Kina needs 62 rebounds for 400 in his career and reaching that plateau would make him the first Navy player and fifth Patriot Leaguer to reach 1,000 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 150 career steals, joining Holy Cross' **Torey Thomas**, **Kevin Hamilton** and **Jave Meade** and Lafayette's **Brian Ehlers** as league players to reach that mark.

Harris Fills It Up

- ▶ **Chris Harris** is off to another solid start for the Mids, averaging 17.0 ppg, 3.0 rpg and 2.5 apg. He currently owns a 1.67 (15-to-9) assist-to-turnover ratio and ranks third in the league in scoring and second in three-pointers made (20).
- ▶ Over the last 27 games (all with a three-pointer; a school record), Harris has made 100-of-243 (.412) three-point tries.
- ▶ During that 27-game span, Harris has made four or more three-pointers in a game 13 different times, including three games where he has made seven three-pointers, the fifth-best total in a single game in school history.
- ▶ Over the last 27 games, in which Navy is 18-9 overall, Harris is averaging 17.2 ppg and 4.0 apg.

Welcome Back, Romeo

- ▶ Navy got a big boost on Saturday night when sophomore **Romeo Garcia** made his first appearance of the season. Garcia missed the first five games with a pulled hamstring. Although he was cleared to play against William & Mary on Nov. 22, the Navy coaches decided to rest it one more week and wait until Saturday night to put him in the lineup.
- ▶ Garcia, who can fill a statsheet with the best of them, scored eight points with two rebounds, three steals and two blocked shots in 24 minutes against the Highlanders. Lange was planning to play him just 10-12 minutes, but as the game went on, Garcia got stronger and the situation dictated him to play that much. Following the game, Garcia mentioned he was tired, but felt good and should be able to play a bigger role starting Tuesday night.
- ▶ Last year, he became the only freshman in school history to score 100 points, grab 100 rebounds, dish out 30 assists, grab 25 steals and block 15 shots.
- ▶ Garcia will be one of the league's top defensive players for the next three years.

Seniors Learn of Their Service Selections

- ▶ Navy's four seniors all earned their post-graduate service selections in a ceremony on Wednesday, Nov. 19.
- ▶ **Clif Colbert**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** all received Surface Warfare Officer (SWO), while **Brian Richards** received Naval Flight Officer (NFO).
- ▶ A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.
- ▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.
- ▶ Three seniors received their first choice, as Richards was not able to receive his first choice. However, his first choice was pilot and he knew going in that he would not be able to receive that selection, because he is too tall.
- ▶ The four seniors will receive their military billets in mid February.

Struggling to Find the Range

- ▶ Despite starting the year 5-1, Navy hasn't fired on all cylinders yet. The Mids are shooting just 40.3 percent from the field, and 32.1 percent from three-point range.
- ▶ Navy's big three shooters of **Chris Harris**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** are shooting just a combined 86-221 (.389) from the field, including 43-126 (.341) from three-point range.
- ▶ In the last three games, the trio is averaging 53.0 ppg between them, while shooting 48-of-119 (.403) from the field.

▶ **Seventh Year Overall:** 94-86 (.522)

▶ **Fifth Year at Navy:** 55-67 (.451)

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

▶ Last year's team forced 568 turnovers, the third-highest total in school history ... the Mids also averaged 9.1 steals per game a year ago, the first-best mark in school history.

▶ Freshmen have earned five all-Patriot League Rookie Team accolades in Lange's four years ... prior to his arrival, just 11 freshmen won all-rookie team honors in 13 years ... Lange has had at least one freshman in the starting lineup in 111 of the 116 games he has coached at Navy.

▶ The Mids have made at least one three-pointer in every game under Lange and at least three three-pointers in every game but one.

▶ 2008 grad Greg Sprink was named Navy's first Patriot League Player of the Year in school history a year ago ... he was also Navy's first All-American since the great David Robinson in the 1987 season.
