Notes: Has made a three-pointer in two of his first five games this season ... his three rebounds and 13 minutes played against Towson tied career highs ... his first career points came on a steal and a breakaway dunk ... an outstanding athlete, Brown has a lot of potential ... played in the WCAC, one of the toughest H.S. conferences in America.

Notes: A very solid player, Colbert is averaging career highs in points (6.4), rebounds (5.1), assists (1.4) and minutes (23.9) ... ranks ninth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (2.00) ... shooting 19-of-32 (.594) from inside the three-point arc ... has 21 assists and 15 turnovers since the start of last year.

Notes: Played well off the bench against UMES, connecting on a three-pointer and all four of his free throws for a season-high seven points ... had a strong preseason and will be called upon to give the Mids a presence in the middle ... is ambidextrous ... when Navy SID Chris Forman gives him a piece of gum before the game this year, Navy is 6-0.

Notes: Ranked eighth in the Patriot League in offensive rebounds per game (1.78) a year ago ... has been plagued the last two years with a variety of leg injuries ... goes after the rebound relentlessly ... had seven rebounds in just 21 minutes in his first two games ... earned the start against Towson in place of Mark Veazey.

Notes: Had a good game off the bench against Radford, scoring six points in just nine minutes ... averaged 13.5 mpg in the first four games, but just 6.0 mpg in the last three ... opened the year making his first five three-point attempts, before missing against William & Mary ... H.S. record holder in points, rebounds and steals and is third in assists.

Notes: Has equaled his career assist production already after having two dimes in first two years at Navy ... was aggressive against UMES, going to the hole hard and connecting on both field goal attempts ... grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against Towson ... eight of his 15 rebounds have come on the offensive end.

Notes: Has made a three-pointer in all seven games this year ... ranks eighth on the career three-pointers made list (132) ... in the last five games, Teague is averaging 13.2 ppg while shooting 23-of-42 (.548) from the field and 16-of-30 (.533) from three-point range ... has eight assists against one turnover in the last three games ... 13 rebs. vs. Towson.

Notes: Leads the team in field goal percentage (7-of-10; .700), a total that would rank first in the Patriot League had he had enough attempts ... earned second career start against Radford ... went 3-of-3 from the field against Towson and 3-of-5 against William & Mary ... per 40 minutes, is averaging 14.8 ppg and 8.7 rpg.

Mids Head to City of Brotherly Love To Battle Quakers at Historic Palestra

The Navy men's basketball team looks to continue its impressive start on Friday night with a 7:00 pm tilt against Penn in the historic Palestra in Philadelphia. The game will be broadcast over the radio waves with **Pete Medhurst** and **Michael Heary** calling all the action, beginning with the Navy basketball pregame show at 6:45 pm.

The Midshipmen (6-1) are coming off a 78-65 victory over a strong Texas-San Antonio team on Tuesday night and have won six games in a row after a season-opening setback to Towson. During the Mids' six-game streak, Navy has outscored its foes by 11.0 points per game and has won two of the games in overtime.

In the win over UTSA, **Kaleo Kina** led four Navy players in double figures with 29 points, while **Adam Teague** scored 16 points on 6-of-6 shooting, **Mark Veazey** contributed a career-high 14 points (4-of-4 from the field) and **Chris Harris** scored 12. The Mids shot a blistering 71.4 percent from the field, including 84.2 percent in the second half.

Penn is 1-5 on the season, but its five losses have come to No. 1 North Carolina, Drexel at 10:00 in the morning, Penn State, Albany and 17th-ranked Villanova. The Quakers fell in their first Big 5 game of the year on Tuesday night to Villanova, 69-47.

This will be the 80th meeting between the two regional rivals, as Penn holds a 57-22 advantage. The Quakers are Navy's second-most frequently played opponent (behind Army), and Friday's meeting marks the fourth straight year the two teams have played. Penn was Navy's second opponent ever on Dec. 28, 1907. The Corcoran Cadets were Navy's first opponent on Dec. 14, 1907.

Quickie Notes

▶ Navy is off to its best start since the 1998-99 season. That team also went 6-1. With a win on Friday night against Penn, the Mids would be 7-1 for the first time since the 1983-84 team opened the year 8-0.

▶ Navy's 71.4 field goal percentage against UTSA is the best single-game percentage in the country this year.

▶ Navy is now 19-7 in the last 26 games, dating back to last year. In the previous 26 games, Navy went 7-19.

▶ Navy owns a perfect 5-0 home record, winning the five games by an average of 12.6 ppg.

▶ Penn's seven-game win streak over Navy is tied with Colgate for the fourth-longest active streak for an opponent over Navy. Duke has the longest active streak with a 12-game winning streak over the Mids.

Next Up

Navy will head to the nation's capital to face ACC member Virginia Tech in the BB&T Classic on Sunday, starting at 5:00pm. The contest will be televised regionally by MASN.

It will be Navy's first game against an ACC foe since an 87-65 loss to 23rd-ranked Wake Forest on Jan. 7, 2002. Navy has lost five straight games against foes currently in the ACC. Navy's last win against a current ACC team was on Feb. 7, 1987, a 78-62 triumph over Miami (Fla.). Navy's last win over an ACC foe at the time of the game was on Dec. 30, 1971, a 72-62 win over Wake Forest.

Last Time Out

Navy recorded a remarkable performance in defeating Texas-San Antonio, 78-65. The win was Navy's sixth in a row with five of the victories coming at home.

Navy shot 71.4 percent (25-of-35) from the field, including a blistering 84.2 percent (16-of-19) in the second half to overcome a seven-point halftime deficit and outscore the Roadrunners, 49-29, in the second half. The percentage was the highest ever against a UTSA opponent.

Kaleo Kina led Navy with 29 points and seven rebounds, while **Adam Teague**, **Mark Veazey** and **Chris Harris** added 16, 14 and 12 points, respectively.

Navy trailed 36-29 at halftime, but scored the first seven points of the second half to tie the game at 36. UTSA still led 39-38, but Kina converted a three-point play to give Navy the lead for good with 15:03 to play. The Mids' defense clamped down on the Roadrunners in the second half. After allowing UTSA to connect on 8-of-18 three-point tries in the first half, UTSA went just 3-of-15 in the second half. Navy also outrebounded UTSA handily, 37-26.

Mids Set the Nets on Fire

Navy has struggled at times from the field this year, but you would have never known it on Tuesday night. After missing its first five shots of the game, Navy connected on 25 of its last 30 field goal attempts (.833), including 7-of-8 from three-point range (.875), in the game's last 34 minutes.

Navy finished the game shooting 71.4 percent from the field, the first time over 70.0 percent since Feb. 24, 1987, and the fourth-highest percentage in school history. In addition, Navy's 84.2 percent in the second half was tied for the third-best percentage in a half in school history, and the 71.4 overall percentage is the highest in the NCAA this year.

Mids Also Red-Hot From Three

Not only did Navy shoot well from the field against UTSA, but the Mids also found themselves in the record books in three-point percentage as well. Navy shot 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from beyond the arc, and after missing its first three three-point attempts, the Mids finished the game making seven of their last eight attempts. The percentage is tied for the seventh-best three-point performance in school history.

Navy Defense Rises to Occasion

Lost in all the hype with Navy's stellar shooting percentage in the win over UTSA was the role Navy's defense played. The Mids held the Roadrunners to shoot just 33.8 percent for the game and to just 30.0 percent (12-of-40) in the second half. In addition, the Roadrunners shot just 20.0 percent (3-of-15) from the three-point line in the second half after shooting 44.4 percent (8-of-18) in the first half.

Navy has held its last six foes to under 66 points each (regulation periods only), after allowing 86 to Towson in the season opener.

In the last six games, Navy is allowing foes to shoot just 38.1 percent from the field and has allowed just 60.5 ppg in regulation periods over the last six games.

Navy's field goal percentage defense of 39.2 percent ranks first in the Patriot League and 63rd nationally. Last year's team ranked seventh in the Patriot League in all games played in field goal percentage defense (.434).

Navy does rank sixth in scoring defense (70.0 ppg), but when you account for just regulation periods only, the Mids are allowing 64.1 ppg, which would rank second. Navy has allowed 41 overtime points this year.

We're Going Streaking

The Navy men's basketball team is on several impressive streaks, and look to continue them at Penn on Friday.

▶ Navy is on a six-game winning streak, matching the longest of the Billy Lange era (Feb. 9, 2008 to Feb. 27, 2008). A win on Friday over Penn would give Navy its first seven-game win streak since a 13-game run from Jan. 23, 2000, to March 5, 2000.

▶ Navy's six-game non-conference win streak is the program's longest since winning six non-league games in a row from Dec. 28, 1999, to Feb. 12, 2000. Navy's last seven-game non-conference winning streak came on Dec. 8, 1984, to March 4, 1985, a nine-game streak.

▶ Navy is 5-0 at Alumni Hall for the first time in school history. Alumni Hall was opened in 1991-92.

▶ Navy has made at least three three-pointers in 111 consecutive games, and at least one three-pointer in 161 straight contests.

Halftime Adjustments

So far this year, Navy is 3-1 in games when trailing or tied at halftime, rallying to beat William & Mary, Radford and Texas-San Antonio. This comes on the heels of last year when Navy went 8-4 in games when it was behind or tied at halftime. Since the start of last year, Navy is 11-5 when tied or trailing at halftime.

Kina Pouring In The Points

Senior guard **Kaleo Kina** has provided the bulk of Navy's offense this year, scoring in double figures in all seven games (10 in a row overall) and leads the league in scoring at 19.4 ppg. He also ranks seventh in rebounding and sixth in steals and surpassed the 1,100-point plateau in the win over Texas-San Antonio.

Kina tallied 29 points against the Roadrunners on 9-of-11 shooting, which came one game after tallying a career-high 30 points against Radford (11-29-08). For his efforts last week (20.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 2.5 apg and 2.5 spg) in wins over Radford and Maryland-Eastern Shore, Kina earned Patriot League Player of the Week accolades, and with his performance against UTSA, he stated his case to win this week's award as well.

Dating back to last season, Kina has scored in double-figures in 29-of-37 games and has topped the 20-point mark in 10 of those games.

Over the last two weeks, Kina has saved his best for late in games. After halftime, he is averaging 14.7 ppg while shooting 60.0 percent from the field. In the first half, he averages just 4.7 ppg and shoots 34.3 percent.

In wins over William & Mary, Radford and UTSA, Kina scored a combined 73 points after halftime, pouring in 26 in games against William & Mary and Radford and 21 in Tuesday's game against Texas-San Antonio.

Kina About to Join Elite Group

Kaleo Kina needs just four assists to become the seventh player in Patriot League history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 150 steals. He would become the first Navy player in school history to reach those marks.

Kina became the fourth Navy player with 150 career steals and the third of the four to score 1,000 points. **Chris Williams** and **David Robinson** are the other two Navy players with 1,000 points and 150 steals.

Kina needs 55 rebounds for 400 in his career and reaching that plateau would make him the first Navy player and fifth Patriot Leaguer to reach 1,000 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 150 career steals, joining Holy Cross' **Torey Thomas**, **Kevin Hamilton** and **Jave Meade** and Lafayette's **Brian Ehlers** as league players to reach that mark.

An area of concern entering the year has turned into one of Navy's strengths; the interior. The Mids are outbounding their foes by three rebounds a game to rank third in the Patriot League in rebounding margin.

The leader of the group in sophomore center **Mark Veazey**, who paces the Patriot League by averaging 7.2 rpg. Navy has not had a player lead the league in rebounding since **Francis Ebong** in 2001-02 (7.3 rpg).

Veazey has helped Navy outscore its opponents in the paint, 200-168, an average of 4.6 points per game. In addition, Holy Cross is outscoring its foes in second-chance points, 75-68, while grabbing 12.4 offensive rebounds per game. That number took a hit on Tuesday as Navy missed just 10 shots from the field. Navy did grab five of the 15 available offensive boards.

Harris Fills It Up

Chris Harris continues to play at a high level, ranking fourth in the Patriot League in scoring at 16.3 ppg and 11th in assists at 2.7 apg. In addition, Harris is second in the league in three-pointers made per game (3.29).

Harris went 3-of-5 from three-point range against Texas-San Antonio for his 138th career three-pointer, moving him into a tie for fourth with **Jimmy Hamilton** (1993-96) on the career three-pointers made list.

Over the last 28 games, Harris has made a three-pointer in every game and is 103-of-248 (.415) in that span.

Also a very good ballhandler, Harris owns a 1.90 (19-to-10) assist-to-turnover ratio this year and since the start of last year has 129 assists against just 98 turnovers (1.32 ratio).

Teague With Strong Performance

One of the more underrated players in the league, **Adam Teague** continues to play at a very high level. Teague ranks 11th in the Patriot League in scoring (11.0 ppg), 16th in rebounding (5.0 rpg), 12th in field goal percentage (.458), second in three-point percentage (.474), fourth in three-pointers per game (2.57) and 13th in blocked shots (0.57 bpg).

Teague went 6-of-6 from the field and 4-of-4 from three-point range against UTSA. His performance ranks as the fourth best nationally in the category of points / weighted shot (measures how efficiently a player translates field goal attempts and free throw attempts into points).

When Teague scores in double figures in his career, Navy is 15-6 all-time, including 4-0 this year.

Seniors Learn of Their Service Selections

Navy's four seniors all earned their post-graduate service selections in a ceremony on Wednesday, Nov. 19.

Clif Colbert, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** all received Surface Warfare Officer (SWO), while **Brian Richards** received Naval Flight Officer (NFO).

A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.

A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

Three seniors received their first choice, as Richards was not able to receive his first choice. However, his first choice was pilot and he knew going in that he would not be able to receive that selection, because he is too tall.

Navy-Penn Series History

The second-most frequently played rivalry in Navy basketball history, the Midshipmen and Quakers will square off for the 80th time on Friday night. Penn owns a 57-22 advantage and has won seven series in a row between the two squads. Navy is looking for its first win against Penn in the Palestra since Dec. 5, 1959, a span of 15 games.

Navy had its chances last year to end the skid two days after Thanksgiving, but succumbed at the end of the game in a 71-67 setback. Navy led 26-23 at halftime and still led 55-54 with three minutes left, but Penn used a quick 6-0 burst and made 9-of-12 free throws in the last minute to hold off the Mids.

The Quakers won the game at the free throw line, making 30-of-42 attempts, including 23-of-29 in the second half. Meanwhile, Navy shot just 22-of-72 (.306) from the field and 5-of-28 (.179) from three-point range.

Greg Sprink scored 22 points to pace Navy, while **Brian Grandier** led four Penn players in double figures with 18.

Only the Army-Navy series (108) has been played more often than the Navy-Penn battle (79).

Navy vs. The Ivy League

This will be the 209th meeting all-time against an Ivy League squad, posting an 89-119 record. Navy has lost three games in a row against Ivy League foes.

Navy is 2-6 under head coach Billy Lange against the Ivy League, with both of the wins coming against Brown (2005-06 and 2006-07 seasons). Lange is 0-3 against Penn, 0-2 against Yale and 0-1 against Columbia. He is 2-0 against Brown.

Navy vs. the State of Pennsylvania

Almost 19 percent of Navy's 2,124 all-time games have come against the state of Pennsylvania. Friday's game will be the 400th all-time against the Keystone State, with Navy

owning a 209-190 advantage against the state.

Navy has played 14 Division I schools from Pennsylvania, and has played six of them at least 36 times. Besides Penn being the second-most frequently played opponent, Lafayette (61 meetings) is fourth on the list.

Lange is 12-20 all-time against Pennsylvania (2-8 vs. Bucknell; 0-1 vs. Drexel; 5-3 vs. Lafayette; 5-3 vs. Lehigh; 0-3 vs. Penn; 0-1 vs. Robert Morris; 0-1 vs. Villanova).

▶ **Seventh Year Overall:** 95-86 (.525)

▶ **Fifth Year at Navy:** 56-67 (.455)

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

▶ Last year's team forced 568 turnovers, the third-highest total in school history ... the Mids also averaged 9.1 steals per game a year ago, the first-best mark in school history.

▶ Freshmen have earned five all-Patriot League Rookie Team accolades in Lange's four years ... prior to his arrival, just 11 freshmen won all-rookie team honors in 13 years ... Lange has had at least one freshman in the starting lineup in 111 of the 116 games he has coached at Navy.

▶ The Mids have made at least one three-pointer in every game under Lange and at least three three-pointers in every game but one.

▶ 2008 grad Greg Sprink was named Navy's first Patriot League Player of the Year in school history a year ago ... he was also Navy's first All-American since the great David Robinson in the 1987 season.

▶ Lastly, team GPA has increased every year since Lange took over ... the team GPA has increased by 0.30 points since his arrival ... eight players a year ago recorded a GPA of 2.72 or better during the spring semester.
