### Mids Finish Pre-Exam Schedule on the Road at Mount St. Mary's

The Navy men's basketball team will wrap up its pre-exam schedule with another road game on Tuesday night at Mount St. Mary's in Emmitsburg, Md. The game will be aired on WNAV (1430 AM / www.WNAV.com) with **Pete Medhurst** calling the action beginning with the Navy pregame show at 6:45 pm (ET).

Navy enters the contest with a 7-2 overall record after seeing its seven-game winning streak snapped in a 79-70 set back to ACC member Virginia Tech on Sunday. Navy's 7-1 start had been the program's best since the 1983-84 team opened the year 8-0.

Mount St. Mary's is 3-4 overall, having lost its last two games by a combined six points. Both of the losses were in Northeast Conference play for the preseason league favorites, falling to Sacred Heart (80-75) and Central Connecticut State (66-65 in overtime).

The Mount is led by guard Jeremy Goode, who is averaging 19.9 ppg and 3.4 apg. Jean Cajou averages 13.4 ppg. The Mountaineers are being outscored by one point on the season, averaging 68.0 ppg. Mount St. Mary's is shooting 43.7 percent from the field, but foes are shooting 44.5 percent against them.

This will be the 12th meeting between the two teams, with Navy holding a slim 6-5 advantage. The series began in 1919 and following a game in 1920, it had been 67 years between meetings until a 1987 meeting. The two teams have met five previous times since 2000.

### Quickie Notes

- ▶ Navy's 7-2 start marks the second time in three years that the Mids have started 7-2. The other time came in the 2006-07 season. Navy finished that year with a 14-6 mark.
- ▶ Navy is 5-0 at home, but is just 2-2 away from Annapolis. Navy is allowing 82.2 points per game away from Annapolis, while giving up just 61.0 at home.
- ▶ The Mids have held five straight opponents under 45.0 percent shooting, and not one team has cracked 50.0 percent against the Navy defense this year. The Mids rank 76th nationally in field goal percentage defense, one year after ranking 147th.
- ▶ Opponents are making just 44.0 percent of their two-point attempts this year, ranking 74th nationally in two-point defense.
- ▶ Over the last seven games, Navy has 101 assists (14.4 apg) against just 106 turnovers (15.1 tpg) for an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.95.
- ▶ Navy is shooting 42.5 percent from the field, ranking 209th nationally. Navy ranked 297th in the country a year ago.

### Next Up

Navy will break for 11 days for final exams (which start Thursday). The Mids will conclude their pre-Christmas slate at Canisius (Dec. 20) and 17th-ranked Villanova (Dec. 22).

### Last Time Out

Navy put together a valiant effort but fell short to ACC power Virginia Tech, 79-70, in front of 10,419 fans at the Verizon Center on Sunday. The game was the first contest of the BB&T Classic as Maryland routed George Washington, 76-53, in the nightcap.

Navy trailed 20-10 early on in the first half, but used a 24-8 run over the last 12 minutes to grab a 34-28 lead at half-time. Navy still led 36-32 early in the second half, before Virginia Tech went on a 17-1 run to grab a 49-37 advantage with 12 minutes to play. Navy wouldn't fold, chipping away at the lead and cutting the margin to four points with 39 seconds left, but Virginia Tech made all six of its free throw attempts to grab the 79-70 victory.

The Hokies pulled away in the second half, in large part to shooting 62.5 percent from the field, after shooting just 30.0 percent in the first half. Virginia Tech also held a commanding 45-28 rebounding advantage to offset Navy's +5 margin in turnovers.

**Kaleo Kina** continued his remarkable run against the Hokies, leading Navy in points (18), rebounds (10), assists (6) and steals (3). It was his third career double-double and two of them have come against national powers, Villanova (Nov. 25, 2006) and now Virginia Tech. **Adam Teague** also scored 18 points for Navy, while **Malcolm Delaney** led the Hokies with 21 points, including 11-of-11 from the free throw line. **Jeff Allen** and **A.D. Vassallo** added 17 points each. Virginia Tech won the game at the free throw line, connecting on 29-of-34 attempts, while Navy was just 10-of-15.

### Noting The Virginia Tech Game

- ▶ Navy saw its seven-game winning streak end in the loss to Virginia Tech. Navy had won seven straight games by an average of 11.0 ppg.
- ▶ Navy fell to 6-14 all-time on the anniversary of the bombing of Pearl Harbor. Navy has lost 11 of its last 12 games on the date.
- ▶ Virginia Tech became the first team since Towson in the season opener to score more than 66 points in regulation.
- ▶ Navy has held five straight foes under 45.0 percent shooting. Virginia Tech shot 44.4 percent from the field, including just 30.0 percent in the first half, and 15.4 percent from three-point range for the entire game.
- ▶ Navy turned the ball over just 11 times, including four in the first half.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** has now scored in double figures in 12 straight games. He recorded his first double-double (18 p, 10 r) of the season and third of his career (13 p, 10 r vs. Villanova on Nov. 25, 2006; 18 p, 10 r vs. Lafayette on Jan. 17, 2008). Kina also recorded season highs in assists (6) and steals (3).
- ▶ Kina is averaging 23.7 ppg, 6.8 rpg and 3.2 apg in the last six outings. He also became the seventh player in Patriot League history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 150 career steals. He has 1,169 points, 304 assists and 155 steals
- ▶ **Adam Teague** tied a season high with 18 points and now has made 21 three-pointers in the last six games. He has 138 three-pointers to move into a tie for fifth with Jimmy Hamilton on the career three-pointers list. Over the last seven games, Teague is averaging 13.4 ppg. Navy dropped to 16-7 all-time when he scores in double figures.
- ▶ **Chris Harris** made a three-pointer for the school-record 30th straight game. Over the last 30 games, Harris has 109 three-pointers.

## Familiar Foes

Both Mount St. Mary's and Navy gave ACC power Virginia Tech all it could handle this year. The Hokies defeated Mount St. Mary's, 62-57, on Nov. 17, while Virginia Tech dealt the Mids a 79-70 setback on Sunday.

In addition, Mount St. Mary's defeated Patriot League favorite American, 57-52, on Dec. 1.

## Navy's Start Matches The Best

Since 1938-39 (first year of the NCAA Tournament), Navy has started 7-1 or better 10 times. Three of those teams made the NCAA Tournament (1947, 1953, 1960) and the worst winning percentage of any of those teams was .667 (14-7 in 1949-50).

## Busy Mids to Get Much-Needed Break

With its game on Tuesday against Mount St. Mary's, Navy will conclude its pre-final exam schedule by playing in its 10th game of the season. Navy will play its fourth game in eight days on Tuesday and third in five days.

The grueling stretch is nothing new to the Mids, who endured a three-game in five-day stretch to start the season as well.

Navy will be off for 11 days after Tuesday's game, as final exams start on Thursday.

## Mids Set the Nets on Fire

Navy has struggled at times from the field this year, but you would have never known it last Tuesday night against Texas-San Antonio. After missing its first five shots of the game, Navy connected on 25 of its last 30 field goal attempts (.833), including 7-of-8 from three-point range (.875), in the game's last 34 minutes.

Navy finished the game shooting 71.4 percent from the field, the first time over 70.0 percent since Feb. 24, 1987, and the fourth-highest percentage in school history. In addition, Navy's 84.2 percent in the second half was tied for the third-best percentage in a half in school history, and the 71.4 overall percentage is the highest in the NCAA this year.

## Navy Defense Rises to Occasion

Lost in all the hype with Navy's stellar shooting percentage in the win over UTSA was the role Navy's defense played. The Mids held the Roadrunners to shoot just 33.8 percent for the game and to just 30.0 percent (12-of-40) in the second half. In addition, the Roadrunners shot just 20.0 percent (3-of-15) from the three-point line in the second half after shooting 44.4 percent (8-of-18) in the first half.

Navy had held six straight foes under 66 points (in regulation only) until Virginia Tech scored 79 points on Sunday.

In the last eight games, Navy is allowing foes to shoot just 39.4 percent from the field and has allowed just 63.4 ppg in regulation periods during that span.

Navy's field goal percentage defense of 40.2 percent ranks second in the Patriot League and is 86th nationally. Last year's team ranked seventh in the Patriot League in all games played in field goal percentage defense (.434).

## Halftime Adjustments

So far this year, Navy is 3-1 in games when trailing or tied at halftime, rallying to beat William & Mary, Radford and Texas-San Antonio. This comes on the heels of last year when Navy went 8-4 in games when it was behind or tied at halftime. Since the start of last year, Navy is 11-5 when tied or trailing at halftime.

However, in the second half of the last two games, foes are shooting 28-of-50 (.560) from the field and averaging

## Kina Pouring In The Points

Senior guard **Kaleo Kina** has provided the bulk of Navy's offense this year, scoring in double figures in all nine games (12 in a row overall) and leading the league in scoring at 20.2 ppg. He also ranks sixth in rebounding and eighth in steals and surpassed the 1,100-point plateau in the win over Texas-San Antonio.

Kina tallied a career-high 30 points against Radford (11-29-08). For his efforts last week (20.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 2.5 apg and 2.5 spg) in wins over Radford and Maryland-Eastern Shore, Kina earned Patriot League Player of the Week honors.

He was then named Player of the Week for the second consecutive week after averaging 25.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg and 3.3 apg in helping Navy to a 2-1 mark last week. He scored 29 points against UTSA last Tuesday, then added 28 points in Navy's first win over Penn at the Palestra in 49 years.

Lastly, he recorded his first double-double of the season with an 18-point, 10-rebound performance against Virginia Tech on Sunday. He added six assists and three steals.

Over the last two weeks, Kina has saved his best for late in games. After halftime, he is averaging 14.0 ppg while shooting 52.5 percent from the field. In the first half, he averages just 6.2 ppg and shoots 35.1 percent.

In wins over William & Mary, Radford and UTSA, Kina scored a combined 73 points after halftime, pouring in 26 in games against William & Mary and Radford and 21 in last

In addition, Kina has played very well against teams from power conferences. Since the start of his sophomore year, Kina has averaged 11.5 ppg, 7.5 rpg, 4.3 apg and 3.3 spg in four games against Virginia Tech, Seton Hall, Villanova and Georgetown. Two of his double-doubles have come against these teams (18 p, 10 r vs. Virginia Tech and 13 p, 10 r against Villanova).

In addition, he has committed just 15 turnovers against the four teams (five games including his first career game which came against Georgetown as a freshman) for an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.33. In 92 career games against non-power conference teams, Kina has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 284-to-350 (0.81).

## Kina Joins Elite Group

In the loss to Virginia Tech, **Kaleo Kina** became the seventh player in Patriot League history with 1,000 points, 300 assists and 150 steals. He is the first Navy player in school history to reach those marks.

Kina became the fourth Navy player with 150 career steals and the third of the four to score 1,000 points. **Chris Williams** and **David Robinson** are the other two Navy players with 1,000 points and 150 steals.

Kina needs 41 rebounds for 400 in his career and reaching that plateau would make him the first Navy player and fifth Patriot League to reach 1,000 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 150 career steals, joining Holy Cross' **Torey Thomas**, **Kevin Hamilton** and **Jave Meade** and Lafayette's **Brian Ehlers** as league players to reach that mark.

## Harris Fills It Up

**Chris Harris** continues to play at a high level, ranking fifth in the Patriot League in scoring at 15.7 ppg. In addition, Harris leads the league in three-pointers made per game (3.22).

Harris has now made 144 career three-pointers to rank fourth on the all-time Navy list and needs only four more to tie **Jason Jeanpierre** (2000-03) for third on the list with 148.

Over the last 30 games, Harris has made a three-pointer in every game and is 109-of-267 (.408) in that span.

Also a very good ballhandler, Harris owns a 1.53 (23-to-15) assist-to-turnover ratio this year and since the start of last year has 133 assists against just 103 turnovers (1.29 ratio).

## Teague Bolsters Navy's Bench With Strong Performances

One of the more underrated players in the league, **Adam Teague** continues to play at a very high level. Teague ranks 11th in the Patriot League in scoring (11.7 ppg), 15th in rebounding (4.8 rpg), 10th in field goal percentage (.474), third in three-point percentage (.480), fourth in three-pointers per game (2.67) and 13th in blocked shots (0.44 bpg).

Teague went 6-of-6 from the field and 4-of-4 from three-point range against UTSA. His performance ranks as the sixth best nationally in the category of points / weighted shot (measures how efficiently a player translates field goal attempts and free throw attempts into points).

Teague has 138 career three-pointers to rank tied for fifth on the all-time Navy chart. His 38.7 career three-point percentage is the fourth-best mark in school history.

Since he has started coming off the bench three games ago, Teague is averaging 14.7 ppg, 4.0 rpg and 2.0 apg and is shooting 64.0 percent (16-of-25) from the field and 62.5 percent (10-of-16) from three-point range. He has just two turnovers in his last five games, while dishing out 10 assists.

When Teague scores in double figures in his career, Navy is 16-7 all-time, including 5-1 this year.

## Navy Mentioned in Several Polls

Thank to its strong start, Navy was mentioned in several polls on both the national and local level last week.

The Mids received one vote in the Associated Press poll last week (Dec. 1), ranking 43rd nationally. The Mids did not receive a vote in this week's poll after falling to Virginia Tech on Sunday.

Navy garnered two votes in last week's (Dec. 1) CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll. This week's poll has not been released yet.

Lastly, Washington Times' college basketball writer **Patrick Stevens** has Navy seventh in this week's Del-MarVa/DC basketball rankings out of 29 teams that are located in Delaware, Maryland, Virginia and DC. The Mids were 11th last week and sit behind Georgetown, Maryland, Virginia Tech, Virginia Commonwealth, Liberty and George Mason.

## Navy Trio Providing Lethal Combination

The Navy trio of **Kaleo Kina**, **Chris Harris** and **Adam Teague** and giving the Mids a strong 1-2-3 punch on the offensive end.

The trio is averaging 47.6 ppg and has scored 428 of Navy's 684 points (62.6 percent) of Navy's scoring this year. When compared with last year's explosive trio of Greg Sprink, Harris and Kina, the numbers look quite similar.

A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "copilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

Three seniors received their first choice, as Richards was not able to receive his first choice. However, his first choice was pilot and he knew going in that he would not be able to receive that selection, because he is too tall.

## Navy-Mount St. Mary's History

This will be the 12th meeting between the two teams, with Navy holding a slim 6-5 advantage. The series began in 1919 and following a game in 1920, it had been 67 years between meetings until a 1987 meeting. The two teams have met five previous times since 2000.

Mount St. Mary's won last year's contest in Annapolis, which also came the Tuesday after the Army-Navy football game. The Mount defeated the Mids, 62-58, as Navy was held to its lowest scoring output of the year.

## Navy vs. The Northeast Conference

This will be just the 32nd meeting against the Northeast Conference, as Navy holds a 21-10 advantage all-time over the league. The Mids are 1-0 this year after defeating St. Francis (N.Y.), 75-63, on Dec. 18.

Navy has won two straight games against the conference, with both of the victories coming over St. Francis (N.Y.). The Mids also defeated the Terriers, 85-83, on Dec. 29, 2007.

**Billy Lange** is 3-2 while at Navy against the Northeast Conference. Besides the two wins over St. Francis (N.Y.), Navy has also defeated Mount St. Mary's in the 2004-05 season. Navy has lost to Robert Morris and Mount St. Mary's under Lange's watch (both were last year).

## Navy vs. the State of Maryland

Navy has played seven schools from Maryland and owns a 71-51 record against the state. Navy is 1-1 this year, falling to Towson in the opener, 86-68, and routing Maryland-Eastern Shore, 76-51, on Nov. 25.

This will be Navy's last meeting against a team from the state of Maryland this year.

Head coach **Billy Lange** is 9-4 at Navy against Maryland's Division I schools (2-0 vs. Loyola, 0-2 vs. UMBC, 3-0 vs. UMS, 2-0 vs. Morgan State, 1-1 vs. Mount St. Mary's and 1-1 vs. Towson).

The Navy basketball team is 12-7 in 19 all-time meetings on Dec. 9. However, Navy has lost three of the last four on the date, dating back to 1992.

## Last Year's Meeting (Dec. 3, 2007)

Navy held Mount St. Mary's to shoot just 27.9 percent from the field, but Navy's offense struggled just as much in a 62-58 loss at Alumni Hall.

The Mids shot just 32.7 percent (18-of-55) from the field, including an icy 18.2 percent (4-of-22) from beyond the arc. Navy was outrebounded, 51-37, by The Mount.

Navy fell behind 13-0 just five minutes into the game and never led in the contest.

Navy would twice cut the lead to one in the first half, the last time coming at 30-29, before The Mount took a 32-29 halftime lead.

The story was much of the same in the second half. Mount St. Mary's would surge to its largest lead of the half at 55-46 with 4:06 to play, but Navy wouldn't fold. Navy cut the margin to 55-51 with 2:38 to play on a Chris Harris three-pointer (Mechanicsville, Va.), and then to three points at 61-58 with 17 seconds left.

But Jeremy Goode made one of two free throws with 17 seconds left to bump the lead to four and Mount St. Mary's ran out the clock for the four-point decision, 62-58.

Mount St. Mary's won the contest, despite making just 4-of-26 shots (.154) in the second half. The Mount's last field goal came with 7:19 to play. Its last 13 points came from the free throw line and 20 of its 30 second-half points came from the charity stripe. Mount St. Mary's shot just 27.9 percent (17-of-61) from the field for the contest.

▶ **Seventh Year Overall:** 96-87 (.525)

▶ **Fifth Year at Navy:** 57-68 (.456)

▶ Led Navy to its first winning record since the 2000-01 season a year ago with a 16-14 record ... the Mids also finished 9-5 in the Patriot League, good for second place ... the second-place finish was Navy's best league finish since the 2000-01 season ... for his efforts, he was named Patriot League Coach of the Year.

▶ Last year's Navy team led the Patriot League in scoring offense, free throw percentage, turnover margin and steals.

▶ The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years that Lange has been in charge ... the lone time it didn't lead the league in scoring came in 2006-07, where the Mids ranked 45th nationally in scoring defense.

▶ Navy set the school record for three-pointers made (288) and attempted (820) a year ago ... four of the top five single-season three-pointers made and attempted totals have come under Lange.

▶ Navy has made at least 13 three-pointers in a game 13 times under Lange ... prior to his arrival, Navy had just five such instances.

▶ Navy set a school record last year for free throw percentage (.749) in a season ... the total eclipsed the record set the previous year (.747 in 2006-07) ... three of the top seven single-season free throw percentage marks have come during Lange's tenure.

### Game 1 ▶ Towson 86, Navy 68

Nov. 14, 2008 ▶ Towson Center (2,789) ▶ Towson, Md.

▶ Navy fell to 76-26 all-time in season openers with the loss to Towson ... the Mids are now 2-3 under Billy Lange in season openers ... the 18-point setback was the largest since a 62-43 loss to Bucknell in the final game of the 2007-08 season ... Navy dropped to 5-16 all-time under Lange when allowing 80+ points ... the Mids also lost their 17th straight game when being held to 69 or fewer points ... Navy committed 13 turnovers and shot just 34.5 percent from the field in the first half ... the Mids turned the ball over just five times in the second half ... Navy's +15 rebound margin was the largest against a Division I opponent since a +27 margin against Morgan State on Dec. 8, 2005 ... in addition, Navy's 50 rebounds were the most since that day ...
