## Navy's Gameday Facts

- ▶ Navy looks for its ninth win of the season in undoubtedly its stiffest test of the year against No. 18-ranked Villanova on Monday night at the Pavilion in Villanova, Pa. The game will wrap up a five-game roadswing in which Navy is 2-2 overall. Action will get underway at 7:30 pm, and the game will be aired on WNAV (1430 AM) with **Pete Medhurst** calling the action.
- ▶ Navy is looking for its ninth win of the season before Christmas for just the second time in school history. The other time it happened came in the 2006-07 season under Lange when the Mids won their ninth game against Washington (Md.) on Dec. 20, 2006.
- ▶ Head coach **Billy Lange** returns to Villanova for the second time since being named Navy's head coach before the 2004-05 season. Lange served as an assistant coach and director of basketball operations at Villanova under Jay Wright from 2002-04. He helped Villanova to a 52-46 record in those three years and three NIT appearances.
- ▶ It will mark Navy's second trip to Philadelphia this year, as the Mids defeated Penn, 76-65, in the Palestra on Dec. 5.
- ▶ After going on a seven-game win streak from Nov. 16 - Dec. 5, Navy has lost two of its last three games.
- ▶ Navy is 4-1 this season when trailing at halftime. Since the start of last year, Navy is 12-6 when trailing or tied at halftime.
- ▶ Only two teams (Virginia Tech and Towson) have scored more than 70 points against Navy in regulation time only. Two others (William & Mary and Radford) needed overtime to reach 70 points. In addition, no team has shot over 50.0 percent against the Mids and five teams have been under 40.0 percent, including two straight and three of the last five.
- ▶ Navy is 93-63 all-time against the Big East, but hasn't defeated a Big East team since Nov. 26, 1996 (Pitt, 60-49).
- ▶ Navy will face a ranked team for the first time Jan. 7, 2002, an 87-65 loss to No. 23-ranked Wake Forest. Navy's last win against a ranked team came on March 16, 1986, when No. 17-ranked Navy shocked No. 9 Syracuse in the Carrier Dome, 97-85, to advance to the NCAA Sweet 16.

## A Navy Win Would...

- ▶ give Navy alternating wins and losses in its last five games.
- ▶ give Navy nine wins before Christmas for just the second time ever (2006-07 season).
- ▶ improve Navy to 9-3 for the second time under Billy Lange (2006-07) and for just the third time since the 1987-88 season.
- ▶ improve head coach **Billy Lange's** overall record to 98-88, and be his first against Big East opponents (0-5 entering).
- ▶ improve Navy to 6-3 all-time against Villanova, and snap a three-game skid to the Wildcats. It would be Navy's first win against Villanova since Jan. 11, 1947.
- ▶ give Navy a 3-2 record on its season-long five-game roadswing (Penn, Virginia Tech, Mount St. Mary's, Canisius, Nova).

## Series History

- ▶ Monday's game will be just the ninth all-time meeting between the two teams. Navy leads the all-time series, 5-3, but the Wildcats have won the last three meetings.
- ▶ Navy won the first five meetings from 1921-47, but Villanova has stemmed the tide with three straight victories. Prior to the Nov. 25, 2006, meeting, the last meeting between the two teams was on Feb. 9, 1949.
- ▶ It will mark just the second trip to Philadelphia in the nine meetings. The other was two years ago on Nov. 25, 2006, a 70-61 Nova win.

## Villanova Scouting Report

- ▶ Villanova enters the contest with a 10-1 overall record and a No. 18 national ranking. The Wildcats have won two straight games against city rivals Saint Joseph's and La Salle after dropping their lone game of the season on Dec. 9, against Texas, 67-58. Villanova is winning its games by an average of 17.1 points per game. Villanova has been off since Dec. 14.
- ▶ Dante Cunningham leads the Wildcats in scoring (16.7 ppg), rebounding (7.6 rpg), blocks (15) and steals (19). He is shooting 57.6 percent from the field. Scottie Reynolds (13.9) and Corey Stokes (12.3) also average in double figures.
- ▶ Navy will be the only Patriot League team the Wildcats will face this year. The two teams have had two common opponents in Penn and Towson. Navy defeated Penn (76-65), but lost to Towson (86-68), while Villanova defeated both Penn (69-47) and Towson (64-47).

## Last Time vs. Villanova - Nov. 25, 2006

- ▶ Villanova held off a spirited Navy charge in the second half, 70-61, two days after Thanksgiving two years ago. **Greg Sprink** scored 22 points before fouling out and **Kaleo Kina** recorded his first career double-double (13 pts., 10 rebs., five steals, four assists) before leaving the game with about three minutes left after suffering an apparent concussion. Navy shot just 37.7 percent, but stayed in the game thanks to 11 three-pointers. Navy was outrebounded, 45-30, and outscored at the free throw line, 23-4. The Mids had just 11 turnovers, while forcing the Wildcats into 14 miscues.
- ▶ Mike Nardi led the Wildcats with 20 points, while Curtis Sumpter added 16. Dante Cunningham had nine points and 10 rebounds and Scottie Reynolds had seven points (1-7 FGs) with one assist and three turnovers.
- ▶ The Wildcats would lead by as much as 18 in the first half (31-13 with 2:45 to play), before Navy closed to 33-19 at the halftime break. Navy would open the second half on an 18-6 run to cut the margin to 39-37 with 14:18 to play.
- ▶ Navy would remain in striking distance for most of the second half, but Sprink fouled out with 5:06 to play and Kina left the game with a possible concussion after a hard fall with 3:11 to play and Navy down five (62-57), forcing Navy to play without its top two players down the stretch.

## Last Time Out - Canisius 68, Navy 63

- ▶ The Mids were held to season lows in points in a half (27), points in a game (63) and field goal percentage (.303). The Mids shot just 9-of-31 (.290) in the first half.
- ▶ The Mids allowed a season-high 57 rebounds, including 33 in the second half. The Mids were outrebounded by 12 in the second half and gave up 22 offensive rebounds, resulting in 17 second-chance points.
- ▶ The game featured 11 lead changes and 15 ties, and the largest lead for either team was seven points (14-7 by Canisius in the first half).
- ▶ Navy has held five of 11 opponents to shoot under 40.0 percent for the game this year, including two in a row.
- ▶ Navy point guards **O.J. Aworo** and **Chris Harris** both fouled out in the contest, forcing **Kaleo Kina** to play the point.

## Navy News, Notes and Tidbits

- ▶ With its four three-pointers against Canisius, Navy has made a three-pointer in 164 straight games and at least three three-pointers in 114 straight games.
- ▶ Navy is 21-9 in its last 30 games, dating back to last year. In the previous 30 games, Navy was 9-21.
- ▶ In the most-recent 21 wins, Navy has won 12 of them by double-digits.
- ▶ In the last 19 games, Navy is a stellar 14-5.
- ▶ Navy has not allowed an opponent to shoot over 50 percent yet this year. Colgate was the last opponent to shoot over 50.0 percent on Feb. 2, 2008, a span of 19 games.
- ▶ Foes are shooting just 39.2 percent from the field against Navy, which is on pace for the lowest opponent field goal percentage since 1998-99 (37.9 percent).
- ▶ Navy is shooting just 32.0 percent from three-point range, on pace for its lowest percentage since the 2004-05 season (31.8 percent).
- ▶ Navy's 30.3 shooting percentage against Canisius snapped a four-game streak of shooting over 40.0 percent.
- ▶ Navy is averaging just 5.8 made three-pointers per game in the last six games, compared to 9.6 in the first five games of the season.
- ▶ Navy is 2-0 in overtime games this year and is 6-4 under head coach **Billy Lange**.
- ▶ Navy is 4-0 this year and 35-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than its opponent.
- ▶ Navy is 5-0 this year and 36-7 under Lange when attempting more free throws than its opponent.
- ▶ Navy is 6-1 this year when it reaches 70 points. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** has now scored in double figures in 14 straight games, dating back to last year.
- ▶ **Chris Harris** has made a three-pointer in a school-record 32 straight games. Meanwhile, **Adam Teague** has made a three-pointer in 11 straight games.

## Up Next - Longwood (Dec. 30)

- ▶ Navy will close out 2008 on Dec. 30, with its first home game in 28 days, coming against Longwood. The game will be broadcast by WNAV (1430 AM) and will be streamed online as part of the Navy All-Access package.
- ▶ Navy is 5-0 all-time against Longwood, and with a win on Dec. 30, will push its winning streak over the Lancers to six games, the longest active streak against one opponent in school history.

## Looking Ahead

- ▶ The Mids will host a good Wofford squad on Jan. 2 to complete their brief two-game homestand.
- ▶ The Mids will then close out non-conference play at Elon on Jan. 5, and will open Patriot League play on Saturday, Jan. 10, at Alumni Hall against rival Bucknell. The game will be aired nationally on ESPNU, tipping off at 5:00 pm (ET). It will be the first game against the Bison since the memorable triple-overtime game in the Patriot League Quarterfinals last year.

## Familiar Face

- ▶ Navy's **Billy Lange** will return to Villanova for the second time after coming over from Jay Wright's staff before the 2004-05 season.
- ▶ Wright is 4-1 all-time against former assistants, including 1-0 against Lange.
- ▶ When asked the question, "My best friend in the coaching business from another school is..." before the season, Lange answered with Jay Wright from Villanova.
- ▶ Ironically, Wright attended one of Navy's chief rivals, graduating from Bucknell in 1983.

## Navy To Face Ranked Team

- ▶ For the first time in almost seven years, Navy will face a ranked team when it travels to the City of Brotherly Love on Monday night to face Villanova. In the Dec. 15 poll, the 10-1 Wildcats were ranked 18th in the Associated Press poll. It will be Navy's first game against a ranked foe since Jan. 7, 2002, vs. No. 23 Wake Forest (L, 65-87).
- ▶ The Mids will be looking for their first win against a ranked team since March 16, 1986, when Navy shocked ninth-ranked Syracuse in the Carrier Dome in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, 97-85.
- ▶ Navy's last win as an unranked team against a ranked opponent came a year earlier, when the unranked Mids toppled 20th-ranked LSU in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, 78-55.
- ▶ The Mids are 0-1 all-time against teams ranked 18th in the AP poll, falling to Princeton, 73-58, on Dec. 14, 1971.

## Navy's Off To A Fast Start

- ▶ Since 1938-39 (first year of the NCAA Tournament), Navy has started 8-2 or better 11 previous times. Five of those teams made the NCAA Tournament (1947, 1953, 1954, 1960 and 1985). Four of the last five teams that started 8-2 or better reached the NCAA Tournament.

## Mids Set the Nets on Fire

- ▶ Navy has struggled at times from the field this year, but you would have never known it on Dec. 2 against Texas-San Antonio. After missing its first five shots of the game, Navy connected on 25 of its last 30 field goal attempts (.833), including 7-of-8 from three-point range (.875), in the game's last 34 minutes.
- ▶ Navy finished the game shooting 71.4 percent from the field, the first time over 70.0 percent since Feb. 24, 1987, and the fourth-highest percentage in school history. In addition, Navy's 84.2 percent in the second half was tied for the third-best percentage in a half in school history, and the 71.4 overall percentage is the highest in the NCAA this year.
- ▶ Not only did Navy shoot well from the field against UTSA, but the Mids also found themselves in the record books in three-point percentage as well. Navy shot 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from beyond the arc, and after missing its first three three-point attempts, the Mids finished the game making seven of their last eight attempts. The percentage is tied for the seventh-best three-point performance in school history.

▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

▶ Senior guard **Kaleo Kina** has provided the bulk of Navy's offense this year, scoring in double figures in all 11 games (14 in a row overall) and leading the league in scoring at 20.8 ppg. He also ranks third in rebounding, ninth in assists and ninth in steals.

▶ Kina has scored at least 26 points in five of the last eight games, averaging 23.6 ppg, 6.8 rpg and 3.5 apg while shooting 45.6 percent (62-of-136) from the field during that span. He has scored at least 20 points in six of the last eight games, after tallying 21 against Canisius.

## Harris Fills It Up

▶ **Chris Harris** continues to play at a high level, ranking fifth in the Patriot League in scoring at 14.5 ppg and is making 2.91 three-pointers per game. Through Saturday's games, Harris' 96 three-point attempts are the ninth most nationally.

▶ Harris has now made 147 career three-pointers to rank fourth on the all-time Navy list and needs only one more to tie **Jason Jeanpierre** (2000-03) for third on the list with 148.

▶ Over the last 32 games, Harris has made a three-pointer in every game and is 112-of-277 (.404) in that span. The 32-game stretch is an ongoing school record. He has made at least three three-pointers in 22 of the 32 games, leading Navy to a 16-6 mark in those 22 games. In games that Harris made two or fewer three-pointers, Navy is 5-5.

▶ One of the more underrated players in the league, **Adam Teague** continues to play at a very high level. Through, games played on Dec. 18, Teague ranks 12th in the Patriot League in scoring (11.1 ppg), 17th in rebounding (4.6 rpg), seventh in field goal percentage (.457), third in three-point percentage (.460), third in three-pointers per game (2.63) and 13th in blocked shots (0.55 bpg).

▶ Teague has 143 career three-pointers to rank fifth on the all-time Navy chart. His 38.6 career three-point percentage is the fourth-best mark in school history.

▶ Since he has started coming off the bench five games ago, Teague is averaging 13.3 ppg, 3.5 rpg and 2.0 apg and is shooting 61.3 percent (19-of-31) from the field and 59.1 percent (13-of-22) from three-point range.

- ▶ Navy improved to 1-1 for the third straight year. Navy avoided its first 0-2 start since the 2005-06 season.
- ▶ Navy improved to 12-6 (.667) all time in Alumni Hall openers with the victory over Howard, and to 5-5 since 1999.
- ▶ Navy is now 3-2 under head coach **Billy Lange** in Alumni Hall openers.
- ▶ Navy won its third straight non-conference home game, winning the three games by an average of 19.3 ppg.

#### Game Notes

- ▶ Navy's 84.2 percent shooting in the second half is third only to a 15-of-17 (.882) performance against East Carolina (1-30-84) and a 17-of-20 (.850) showing against Lafayette (1-18-84).
- ▶ Navy's 71.4 percent shooting is fourth behind Lafayette (1-18-84 / .737 on 28-of-38), Fairfield (2-6-85 / .725 of 37-of-51 shooting) and Richmond (2-24-87 / .723 on 34-of-47 shooting). The percentage is the best single-game performance in the country so far this year. Before tonight, the top six percentage performances came from 1983 to 1987. In addition, Navy missed its first five shot attempts from the fie field and first three three-point tries. Over the last 34 minutes, Navy was 25-of-30 (.833) from the field and 7-of8 (.875) from three-point range.
- ▶ Navy's 35 field goal attempts are the second fewest in a game since the 1979-80 season. The lowest was 34 against Air Force on Jan. 3, 2005.
- ▶ The Mids are 5-0 at Alumni Hall and have won seven straight non-conference home games.
- ▶ Navy's six-game non-conference win streak equals the third longest in program history. The longest was a 13-game non-conference streak from Feb. 7, 1983, to Dec. 10, 1983.
- ▶ Navy has held six straight foes to 66 points or less in regulation time only.
- ▶ Navy's 27 turnovers were a season high and the most since committing 27 against Texas-San Antonio on Nov. 17, 2007.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina's** 29 points were one off a career high set when he scored 30 points against Radford last Saturday night. Over the last two games, Kina is 23-of-33 from the free throw line after going 11-of-15 tonight and 12-of-18 against Radford. Kina is averaging 24.0 ppg, 6.8 rpg and 2.8 apg in the last four outings. Kina went over 1,100 points in the contest.

- ▶ The game was Navy's third in five days after defeating Penn, 76-65, on Dec. 5, and falling to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ The win pushed Navy's record to 8-2 overall, matching its best 10-game start since the 1983-84 team started the season 9-1. The 1998-99 and 1984-85 teams also started their seasons 8-2.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** scored at least 26 points for the fifth time in the last seven games. He tallied 16 of Navy's last 25 points in the second half and scored 20 of Navy's 41 second-half points all together. Kina also moved into 17th place on the school's career scoring list with 1,195 points.
- ▶ Awworu hauled down a season-high seven rebounds. The seven boards were just two off his career high.

### Game Notes
