Navy's Gameday Facts

- ▶ Navy looks for its ninth win of the season on Saturday at Canisius. The game will be the fourth contest in a five-game stretch away from Annapolis. The Mids are currently 2-1 on their five-game road trip that will end Monday night at 17th-ranked Villanova. Tip-off for Saturday's game is at 2:00 pm.
- ▶ The Mids are looking for their ninth win on Dec. 20, which would equal the earliest Navy has ever won nine games. Navy also won its ninth game of the year on Dec. 20, in the 2006-07 season. However, that team needed 12 games, whereas a win against Canisius would come in the 11th game of the year.
- ▶ Navy's 8-2 start matches the program's best start since the 1983-84 team started 9-1. The 1998-99 and 1984-85 teams also went 8-2.
- ▶ Navy has won three straight "true" non-conference road games, defeating William & Mary (Nov. 22), Penn (Dec. 5) and Mount St. Mary's (Dec. 9). Navy's only loss away from Alumni Hall was a neutral-court loss to Virginia Tech (Dec. 7).
- ▶ The Mids have won five of their last six December games, dating back to last year.
- ▶ Navy is 4-1 this season when trailing at halftime. Since the start of last year, Navy is 12-5 when trailing or tied at halftime.
- ▶ The Mids have held eight of their last nine opponents to 66 or fewer points in regulation. The lone team to surpass 66 points in regulation play during that span is Virginia Tech (79 points on Dec. 7).
- ▶ Navy leads the all-time series with Canisius, 1-0, winning last year's battle in Annapolis, 71-60.
- ▶ Navy has received votes in the Associated Press poll for the second time in three weeks. The Mids received one vote in both the Dec. 1 and the most-recent poll, Dec. 15.
- ▶ In addition, Navy has seen its number of votes increase in each of the last three weeks in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll. Navy's 29 points ranks it 36th among all teams and the highest among all Patriot League teams.

A Navy Win Would...

- ▶ be Navy's second in a row and ninth in the last 10 games.
- ▶ tie (with the 2006-07 team) Navy's earliest date (Dec. 20) ever in winning its ninth game of the year.
- ▶ improve Navy to 9-2 for the first time since 1984-85. That team started 9-2 and was 14-2 after 16 games.
- ▶ improve head coach **Billy Lange's** overall record to 98-87.
- ▶ improve Navy to 2-0 all-time against Canisius.
- ▶ increase Navy's road-game winning streak to four games.
- ▶ push Navy's record all-time against the MAAC to 44-15, and move **Billy Lange's** record to 4-0 against the MAAC.

Series History

- ▶ Saturday's game will be just the second all-time meeting between the two teams. This year's game will be a return trip from Canisius' visit to Annapolis on Nov. 20, 2007.
- ▶ Navy is 1-0 all time against Canisius after winning last year's game, 71-60, on Nov. 20, 2007, in Annapolis.
- ▶ Navy is 43-15 all-time against the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. Canisius will be the only MAAC opponent Navy will play this year.

Canisius Scouting Report

- ▶ Canisius enters the the contest with a 3-7 record after falling to 11th-ranked Syracuse on Wednesday night, 82-60. The Golden Griffins have lost four games in a row since a 68-66 win over St. Bonaventure on Nov. 29. The four losses have come by an average of 23.0 ppg, with two of the losses coming in MAAC play against Manhattan and St. Peter's.
- ▶ Frank Turner leads the Griffis at 13.8 ppg, while Chris Gadley averages 11.8 ppg. As a team, Canisius is averaging just 58.6 ppg and shooting 38.0 percent from the field.
- ▶ Navy will be the only Patriot League team the Golden Griffins will play this year. Both teams have played Howard already this year. Navy topped the Bison, 66-55, on Nov. 16 in Annapolis, while Canisius defeated the Bison, 70-46, on Dec. 1 in Washington, D.C.

Last Time vs. Canisius - Nov. 20, 2007

- ▶ Navy won last year's meeting, 71-60, in Alumni Hall for its second win of the season. Navy overcame a tough shooting night (39.1 percent) by forcing 30 turnovers to earn the victory. **Greg Sprink** scored 17 points and **Brian Richards**, making his first career start, scored 15 points with six rebounds. **Kaleo Kina** added 10 points off the bench.
- ▶ Frank Turner led the Golden Griffins with 19 points and seven rebounds. Tomas Vazquez-Simmons recorded eight blocks for Canisius.
- ▶ Canisius jumped out to its largest lead of the game at 32-26 with 4:01 to play in the first half, but Navy held the Griffis score less for the remainder of the half to take a 33-32 lead into intermissions
- ▶ Navy would still only lead by one, 50-49, with 6:56 to play before embarking on a 9-2 run for a 59-51 advantage with 4:17 to play. Navy would push the lead into double figures in the last minute of the game for the 11-point victory.
- ▶ Navy shot just 35.0 percent in the first half, but warmed up to 44.4 percent in the second half. Navy was just 4-of-12 from the three-point line and only 13-of-19 from the free throw line.
- ▶ The 30 turnovers forced by Navy were a season high. Navy outscored the Griffis, 30-3, in points off turnovers.

Last Time Out - Navy 68, Mount St. Mary's 65

- ▶ Navy shot 59.1 percent in the second half to rally for a 68-65 victory over Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 9. The Navy defense held the Mount to just 37.3 percent from the field. Navy outscored the Mount, 41-33, in the second half.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** led Navy with 26 points, seven rebounds and four assists, while **Chris Harris** added 14 points.
- ▶ Mount St. Mary's, the preseason favorite in the Northeast Conference, was led by Jean Cajou's 15 points.
- ▶ Navy helped its second-half cause, by making 11-of-12 free throw attempts and 4-of-6 three-point tries.
- ▶ The Midshipmen, particularly **O.J. Aworo**, held Mount's leading scorer, Jeremy Goode, to just eight points on 3-of-15 shooting. He entered the game averaging 19.9 ppg.
- ▶ The game was Navy's third in five days after defeating Penn, 76-65, on Dec. 5, and falling to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ The win pushed Navy's record to 8-2 overall, matching its best 10-game start since the 1983-84 team started the season 9-1. The 1998-99 and 1984-85 teams also started their seasons 8-2.

Navy News, Notes and Tidbits

- ▶ With its six three-pointers against Mount St. Mary's, Navy has made a three-pointer in 163 straight games and at least three three-pointers in 113 straight games.
- ▶ Navy has received votes in the Associated Press Top 25 in two of the last three weeks. Navy received one vote in both the Dec. 1 and Dec. 15 polls.
- ▶ Navy is 21-8 in its last 29 games, dating back to last year. In the previous 29 games, Navy was 8-21.
- ▶ In the most-recent 21 wins, Navy has won 12 of them by double-digits.
- ▶ In the last 18 games, Navy is a stellar 14-4.
- ▶ Navy's three-minute, 51-second scoreless stretch at the start of the game against Mount St. Mary's was its longest scoreless stretch to start a game this year.
- ▶ Navy has not allowed an opponent to shoot over 50 percent yet this year. Colgate was the last opponent to shoot over 50.0 percent on Feb. 2, 2008, a span of 18 games.
- ▶ Foes are shooting just 39.9 percent from the field against Navy, which is on pace for the lowest opponent field goal percentage since 1999-2000 (39.8 percent).
- ▶ Meanwhile, Navy has shot at least 40.0 percent in four straight games and in six of the 10 games this year.
- ▶ Navy is 2-0 in overtime games this year and is 6-4 under head coach **Billy Lange**.
- ▶ Navy is 4-0 this year and 35-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than its opponent.
- ▶ Navy is 5-0 this year and 36-7 under Lange when attempting more free throws than its opponent.
- ▶ Navy is 6-1 this year when it reaches 70 points. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** has now scored in double figures in 13 straight games, dating back to last year.
- ▶ **Chris Harris** has made a three-pointer in a school-record 31 straight games. Meanwhile, **Adam Teague** has made a three-pointer in 10 straight games.

Up Next - Villanova (Dec. 22)

- ▶ Navy concludes the pre-Christmas portion of its schedule on Monday, Dec. 22, taking on 17th-ranked Villanova at the Pavilion on Villanova's campus. Tip time is slated for 7:30 pm and will be carried by WNAV (1430 AM), WFED (1050 AM) and WWWT (820 & 1500 AM), as well as All-Access on Villanova.com (for CBS College Sports XXL All-Access subscribers).
- ▶ It will be Navy's second appearance against a team from a power conference this year (Virginia Tech; L, 79-70).
- ▶ Navy is 93-63 all-time against the Big East, including 5-3 against Villanova. However, Navy hasn't defeated a Big East foe since defeating Pitt, 60-49, on Nov. 26, 1996.
- ▶ Monday's meeting will mark the second time Navy head coach **Billy Lange** will have faced his mentor, Jay Wright. Lange's squad fell to the Wildcats, 70-61, on Nov. 25, 2006. Villanova has won three straight in the series.

Looking Ahead

- ▶ Following an eight-day break for the holiday season, Navy will host a pair of games around New Year's Day as the Patriot League season draws closer. The Mids will host Longwood on Dec. 30 and Wofford on Jan. 2 to complete a brief two-game homestand. The Dec. 30 game with Longwood will be the first home game in 28 days (Dec. 2 vs. Texas-San Antonio; W, 78-65).
- ▶ Navy will play just three more non-conference games after Monday, taking on Longwood (Dec. 30), Wofford (Jan. 2) and at Elon (Jan. 5). Both Wofford and Elon are members of the Southern Conference. Navy has faced Southern Conference foes just 23 previous times in school history, and has never faced Elon.
- ▶ The Mids will then open Patriot League play on Saturday, Jan. 10, at Alumni Hall against rival Bucknell. The game will be aired nationally on ESPNU, tipping off at 5:00 pm (ET). It will be the first game against the Bison since the memorable triple-overtime game in the PL Quarterfinals last year.

Mids Set the Nets on Fire

▶ Navy has struggled at times from the field this year, but you would have never known it on Dec. 2 against Texas-San Antonio. After missing its first five shots of the game, Navy connected on 25 of its last 30 field goal attempts (.833), including 7-of-8 from three-point range (.875), in the game's last 34 minutes.

▶ Navy finished the game shooting 71.4 percent from the field, the first time over 70.0 percent since Feb. 24, 1987, and the fourth-highest percentage in school history. In addition, Navy's 84.2 percent in the second half was tied for the third-best percentage in a half in school history, and the 71.4 overall percentage is the highest in the NCAA this year.

▶ Not only did Navy shoot well from the field against UTSA, but the Mids also found themselves in the record books in three-point percentage as well. Navy shot 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from beyond the arc, and after missing its first three three-point attempts, the Mids finished the game making seven of their last eight attempts. The percentage is tied for the seventh-best three-point performance in school history.

Navy To Face Ranked Team

- ▶ For the first time in almost seven years, Navy will face a ranked team when it travels to the City of Brotherly Love on Monday night to face Villanova. The 10-1 Wildcats are ranked 18th in the current Associated Press poll and are off until Monday's game, assuring themselves a spot in the national rankings.
- ▶ The Mids will be looking for their first win against a ranked team since March 16, 1986, when Navy shocked ninth-ranked Syracuse in the Carrier Dome in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, 97-85.
- ▶ Navy's last win as an unranked team against a ranked opponent came a year earlier, when the unranked Mids topped 20th-ranked LSU in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, 78-55.
- ▶ The Mids are 0-1 all-time against teams ranked 18th in the AP poll, falling to Princeton, 73-58, on Dec. 14, 1971.

Harris Fills It Up

- ▶ **Chris Harris** continues to play at a high level, ranking fifth in the Patriot League in scoring at 15.5 ppg. In addition, Harris ranks second, and 50th nationally, in three-pointers made per game (3.10). Through Tuesday's games, Harris' 91 three-point attempts are the fourth most nationally.
- ▶ Harris has now made 146 career three-pointers to rank fourth on the all-time Navy list and needs only two more to tie **Jason Jeanpierre** (2000-03) for third on the list with 148.
- ▶ Over the last 31 games, Harris has made a three-pointer in every game and is 111-of-272 (.408) in that span. The 31-game stretch is an ongoing school record. He has made at least three three-pointers in 22 of the 31 games, leading Navy to a 16-6 mark in those 22 games.

Teague Strong Off Bench

- ▶ One of the more underrated players in the league, **Adam Teague** continues to play at a very high level. Teague ranks 12th in the Patriot League in scoring (11.4 ppg), 17th in rebounding (4.5 rpg), seventh in field goal percentage (.476), third in three-point percentage (.482), third in three-pointers per game (2.70) and 13th in blocked shots (0.50 bpg).
- ▶ Teague has 141 career three-pointers to rank fifth on the all-time Navy chart. His 38.8 career three-point percentage is the fourth-best mark in school history.
- ▶ Since he has started coming off the bench four games ago, Teague is averaging 13.3 ppg, 3.5 rpg and 2.0 apg and is shooting 61.3 percent (19-of-31) from the field and 59.1 percent (13-of-22) from three-point range.

Going The Extra Minute

- ▶ Navy has already played in a pair of overtime games this year, posting a 2-0 record in those games. The Mids defeated William & Mary, 102-99, in three overtimes on Nov. 22, then topped Radford, 73-71, in one overtime on Nov. 29. Navy improved to 6-4 under head coach **Billy Lange** in overtime games.
- ▶ In addition, Navy's triple-overtime battle with William & Mary gave Navy two three-overtime games in a five-game span after falling to Bucknell, 87-86, in three overtimes in the final game of the 2007-08 season. Not official, but playing two three-overtime games in a span of five games is believed to be an NCAA first.
- ▶ Navy played in just one triple-overtime game in the first 101 years and 2,116 games in school history.
- ▶ In the win over William & Mary, **Chris Harris** played every second, setting a school record with 55 minutes played. The 36 points scored in the overtime sessions also was a school record.

Navy Trio Providing Lethal Combination

- ▶ The Navy trio of **Kaleo Kina**, **Chris Harris** and **Adam Teague** are giving the Mids a strong 1-2-3 punch on the offensive end.
- ▶ The trio is averaging 47.7 ppg and has scored 477 of Navy's 752 points of Navy's scoring this year. When compared with last year's explosive trio of **Greg Sprink**, **Harris** and **Kina**, the numbers look quite similar.

- ▶ A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.
- ▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

Game Notes

- ▶ Navy shot 59.1 percent in the second half to rally for a 68-65 victory over Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 9. The Navy defense held the Mount to just 37.3 percent from the field. Navy outscored the Mount, 41-33, in the second half.
- ▶ Navy helped its second-half cause, by making 11-of-12 free throw attempts and 4-of-6 three-point tries.
- ▶ Navy has rallied from halftime deficits in four of its eight wins. Navy trailed by five at the halftime break.
- ▶ Navy has now won two games this year (Howard and Mount St. Mary's) when being held to 69 points or less. Last year, Navy went 0-6 when scoring 69 or fewer points.
- ▶ The Mids held the Mount to just 32 and 33 points in each half. Just two teams (Towson and Virginia Tech) have managed to crack 40 points in a half this year as both teams accomplished it in the second half of their respective games.
- ▶ The Midshipmen, particularly **O.J. Awworo**, held Mount's leading scorer, Jeremy Goode, to just eight points on 3-of-15 shooting. He entered the game averaging 19.9 ppg.
- ▶ The game was Navy's third in five days after defeating Penn, 76-65, on Dec. 5, and falling to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ The win pushed Navy's record to 8-2 overall, matching its best 10-game start since the 1983-84 team started the season 9-1. The 1998-99 and 1984-85 teams also started their seasons 8-2.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** scored at least 26 points for the fifth time in the last seven games. He tallied 16 of Navy's last 25 points in the second half and scored 20 of Navy's 41 second-half points all together. Kina also moved into 17th place on the school's career scoring list with 1,195 points.
- ▶ Awworo hauled down a season-high seven rebounds. The seven boards were just two off his career high.
