Navy's Gameday Facts

- ▶ Navy returns to Alumni Hall for the first time in 28 days with Tuesday, Dec. 30, with a contest against Longwood beginning at 7:00 pm. The game will be broadcast on WNAV (1430 AM) with **Pete Medhurst** and **Michael Heary** calling all the action, beginning at 6:45 pm. The contest will be streamed online as part of the Navy All-Access package at www.navysports.com.
- ▶ Navy is looking for its ninth win of the season before New Year's Day for just the fourth time in school history. Navy also won nine games before the calendar turned in the 2006-07 (9-5), 1998-99 (9-3) and 1983-84 (9-2) seasons.
- ▶ Navy concluded its season-long five-game road trip with a 2-3 record. The Mids defeated Penn and Mount St. Mary's and lost to Virginia Tech, Canisius and No. 18-ranked Villanova.
- ▶ Navy is looking to remain undefeated at Alumni Hall, as it currently holds a 5-0 record in the facility. Navy has won all five of its home games this year by an average of 12.6 ppg. With wins over Longwood on Tuesday and Wofford on Jan. 2, Navy can complete its first unblemished non-conference record in Alumni Hall.
- ▶ In addition, Navy has won seven straight non-conference home games, dating back to last year. Navy has won nine of its last 10 non-conference home games, dating back to last year. Eight of the nine wins have come by double digits.
- ▶ Navy continues to lead the Patriot League in scoring (73.6 ppg). The Mids have led the league in scoring in three of the four years under head coach **Billy Lange**.
- ▶ After embarking on a seven-game win streak from Nov. 16 - Dec. 5, Navy has lost three of its last four games.
- ▶ Only three teams (Villanova, Virginia Tech and Towson) have scored more than 70 points against Navy in regulation time only. Two others (William & Mary and Radford) needed overtime to reach 70 points. In addition, no team has shot over 50.0 percent against the Mids and five teams have been under 40.0 percent, including two of the last three opponents.
- ▶ Navy is averaging just 65.5 ppg in the last two outings and have been held to 68 points or less in three straight games. In the first nine games of the season, Navy had been held to 68 or fewer points just twice.

A Navy Win Would...

- ▶ end Navy's season-long two-game losing streak.
- ▶ give Navy nine wins before New Year's Day for just the fourth time ever (2006-07, 1998-99 and 1983-84 seasons).
- ▶ improve Navy to 6-0 all-time against Longwood. A win would give Navy its longest-active winning streak over an opponent at six games. The current longest-active winning streak is against both Longwood and Harvard (five games).
- ▶ push Navy's home record to 6-0, and give Navy a chance on Friday night to wrap up its first-ever perfect non-conference home record. A win would give Navy its eighth straight non-conference road win.

Series History

- ▶ Tuesday's game will be the sixth meeting all-time between the two teams, with the Mids holding a 5-0 advantage. The five-game active winning streak is tied for the longest active streak for Navy over one opponent (Harvard). A win on Tuesday will make it a six-game streak, the longest streak over one foe.
- ▶ Navy has won the five games by an average margin of 12.6 ppg, including 15.0 ppg in three games in Annapolis.
- ▶ Navy defeated the Lancers twice last year and are 4-0 against Longwood under **Billy Lange**. The only other meeting came in the 1981-82 season.

Longwood Scouting Report

- ▶ Longwood enters the game with a 6-7 overall record after falling to Patriot League member Lehigh, 72-57, on Sunday night. The Lancers enter the game not having won more than two games in a row and not having lost more than two games in a row as well. The Lancers do own wins over Gardner-Webb, Delaware State and James Madison. Its other Division I win was a 12-point triumph over Maryland-Eastern Shore.
- ▶ Dana Smith has overcome multiple knee injuries to lead the Lancers in scoring at 15.5 ppg and 6.1 rpg, while shooting 53.3 percent from the field. Ryan Bogan also averages double figures at 13.7 ppg and has made a team-best 27 three-pointers.
- ▶ The Lancers as a team are averaging 71.6 ppg while allowing 73.7 ppg. The Lancers are shooting 39.9 percent from the field and allowing foes to shoot 44.1 percent. Longwood is committing 5.8 turnovers per game fewer than its foes.

Last Time vs. Longwood - Jan. 5, 2008

- ▶ Navy outscored Longwood, 50-32, in the second half to break open a 23-23 tie at halftime and cruise to a 73-55 victory in the final non-conference game of the season for the Midshipmen.
- ▶ The Mids held Longwood to shoot just 26.2 percent from the field, a season best for the Navy defense.
- ▶ **Greg Sprink** led Navy with 21 points and 11 rebounds, but went just 5-of-20 from the field. Navy shot just 21-57 (.368) from the field as a team.
- ▶ **Romeo Garcia** grabbed a career-high 10 rebounds and dominated the game with his defense. Garcia held Longwood's leading scorer, Kirk Williams, to just 4-of-15 shooting and 11 points. Garcia had two points, two assists and two blocks in addition to his 10 rebounds.
- ▶ **Chris Harris** and **Kaleo Kina** added 18 points each for the Mids. Harris was 5-of-8 from the field and added five assists with no turnovers and two steals. Kina added seven rebounds and five dimes.

Last Time Out - [18] Villanova 78, Navy 68

- ▶ Navy dropped its second game in a row for the first time all season. Following its seven-game winning streak, Navy has lost three of its last four games.
- ▶ The Mids went 10-of-27 in both halves against the Wildcats, while Villanova attempted 33 field goals in both halves.
- ▶ Navy shot zero free throws in the first half, but went 14-of-18 in the second half.
- ▶ Navy was outrebounded 27-16 in the second half, including 12-5 on the offensive end.
- ▶ Navy's 14 three-pointers tied for the fifth most in a game in school history. The Mids also made 14 three-pointers against William & Mary and Maryland-Eastern Shore this year.
- ▶ Navy has now lost 12 straight games against ranked opponents, dating back to a 97-85 win over No. 9-ranked Syracuse in the NCAA Tournament on March 16, 1986. It was Navy's first contest against a ranked foe since Jan. 7, 2002, a 87-65 loss to 23rd-ranked Wake Forest.
- ▶ Navy ended its five-game roadswing with a 2-3 record, defeating Penn and Mount St. Mary's and losing to Virginia Tech, Canisius and Villanova.
- ▶ **Chris Harris'** eight three-pointers tied for the third most in a game in school history. He now has four different games of at least seven three-pointers during his career. Entering the season, he and **Greg Sprink** were the only players with at least two games of seven three-pointers.
- ▶ **O.J. Aworo** had a season-high seven assists, while **Jordan Sugars** had career highs in rebounds (7) and minutes (20).

Navy News, Notes and Tidbits

- ▶ With its 14 three-pointers against Villanova, Navy has made a three-pointer in 165 straight games and at least three three-pointers in 115 straight games.
- ▶ Navy is 21-10 in its last 31 games, dating back to last year. In the previous 31 games, Navy was 10-21.
- ▶ In the most-recent 21 wins, Navy has won 12 of them by double-digits.
- ▶ In the last 20 games, Navy is a stellar 14-6.
- ▶ Navy has not allowed an opponent to shoot over 50 percent yet this year. Colgate was the last opponent to shoot over 50.0 percent on Feb. 2, 2008, a span of 20 games.
- ▶ Foes are shooting just 39.4 percent from the field against Navy, which is on pace for the lowest opponent field goal percentage since 1998-99 (37.9 percent).
- ▶ Navy's 30.3 shooting percentage against Canisius snapped a four-game streak of shooting over 40.0 percent.
- ▶ Navy is 2-0 in overtime games this year and is 6-4 under head coach **Billy Lange**.
- ▶ Navy is 4-0 this year and 35-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than its opponent.
- ▶ Navy is 5-0 this year and 36-7 under Lange when at-

tempting more free throws than its opponent.

- ▶ Navy is 6-1 this year when it reaches 70 points. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** has now scored in double figures in 15 straight games, dating back to last year.
- ▶ **Chris Harris** has made a three-pointer in a school-record 33 straight games. Meanwhile, **Adam Teague** has made a three-pointer in 12 straight games.

Looking Ahead

- ▶ The Mids will host a good Wofford squad on Jan. 2 to complete their brief two-game homestand. The game will be the second in a row at Alumni Hall after being on the road for 28 days from Dec. 2 to Dec. 30.
- ▶ The Mids will then close out non-conference play at Elon on Jan. 5, and will open Patriot League play on Saturday, Jan. 10, at Alumni Hall against rival Bucknell. The game will be aired nationally on ESPNU, tipping off at 5:00 pm (ET). It will be the first game against the Bison since the memorable triple-overtime game in the Patriot League Quarterfinals last year.

▶ Kina needs 28 rebounds for 400 in his career and reaching that plateau would make him the first Navy player and fifth Patriot Leaguer to reach 1,000 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 150 career steals, joining Holy Cross' **Torey Thomas**, **Kevin Hamilton** and **Jave Meade** and Lafayette's **Brian Ehlers** as league players to reach that mark.

Harris With Another Big Night

▶ **Chris Harris** continues to play at a high level, ranking fourth in the Patriot League in scoring at 15.8 ppg and is making a league-best 3.50 three-pointers per game. Through Saturday's games, Harris' 106 three-point attempts are the ninth most nationally and his 40 three-pointers made are 12th.

▶ Harris made eight three-pointers against Villanova, tied for the third most in school history. He now has four games of seven or more three-pointers in his career. He and **Greg Sprink** are the only players in school history to have made seven three-pointers in a game at least twice, and Sprink did it just twice. His eight three-pointers tied for the most ever against a Villanova team.

▶ Harris has now made 155 career three-pointers to rank third on the all-time Navy list and needs 46 more to tie **Michael Heary** (1995-98) for second on the list with 201.

▶ Over the last 33 games, Harris has made a three-pointer in every game and is 120-of-287 (.418) in that span. The 33-game stretch is an ongoing school record. He has made at least three three-pointers in 23 of the 33 games, leading Navy to a 16-7 mark in those 23 games. In games that Harris made two or fewer three-pointers, Navy is 5-5.

Kina In Elite Company, Part II

▶ **Kaleo Kina** was named Patriot League Player of the Week on Monday, Dec. 15, for the third straight week, after scoring 26 points with seven rebounds, four assists and a blocked shot against Mount St. Mary's. He also earned the award on Dec. 1 and Dec. 8.

▶ Kina became just the fifth Patriot Leaguer to win the weekly award three straight times. Just one player, Bucknell's Patrick King, has won the award four straight times.

▶ The record for most Patriot League Player of the Week awards in one season is four, set by six players, including Navy's **Michael Heary** in the 1996-97 season.

▶ All four previous players that won three straight PL Player of the Week honors were named Patriot League Player of the Year that season.

Teague Strong Off Bench

- ▶ One of the more underrated players in the league, **Adam Teague** continues to play at a very high level. Through games played on Dec. 27, Teague ranks 15th in the Patriot League in scoring (10.7 ppg), 14th in rebounding (4.7 rpg), ninth in field goal percentage (.449), third in three-point percentage (.449), fourth in three-pointers per game (2.58) and 11th in blocked shots (0.58 bpg).

Mids Set the Nets on Fire

- ▶ Navy has struggled at times from the field this year, but you would have never known it on Dec. 2 against Texas-San Antonio. After missing its first five shots of the game, Navy connected on 25 of its last 30 field goal attempts (.833), including 7-of-8 from three-point range (.875), in the game's last 34 minutes.
- ▶ Navy finished the game shooting 71.4 percent from the field, the first time over 70.0 percent since Feb. 24, 1987, and the fourth-highest percentage in school history. In addition, Navy's 84.2 percent in the second half was tied for the third-best percentage in a half in school history, and the 71.4 overall percentage is the highest in the NCAA this year.
- ▶ Not only did Navy shoot well from the field against UTSA, but the Mids also found themselves in the record books in three-point percentage as well. Navy shot 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from beyond the arc, and after missing its first three three-point attempts, the Mids finished the game making seven of their last eight attempts. The percentage is tied for the seventh-best three-point performance in school history.

The Mids defeated William & Mary, 102-99, in three overtimes on Nov. 22, then topped Radford, 73-71, in one overtime on Nov. 29. Navy improved to 6-4 under head coach **Billy Lange** in overtime games.
- ▶ In addition, Navy's triple-overtime battle with William & Mary gave Navy two three-overtime games in a five-game span after falling to Bucknell, 87-86, in three overtimes in the final game of the 2007-08 season. Not official, but playing two three-overtime games in a span of five games is believed to be an NCAA first.
- ▶ Navy played in just one triple-overtime game in the first 101 years and 2,116 games in school history.
- ▶ In the win over William & Mary, **Chris Harris** played every second, setting a school record with 55 minutes played. The 36 points scored in the overtime sessions also was a school record.

Seniors Learn of Their Service Selections

- ▶ Navy's four seniors all earned their post-graduate service selections in a ceremony on Wednesday, Nov. 19.
- ▶ **Clif Colbert**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** all received Surface Warfare Officer (SWO), while **Brian Richards** received Naval Flight Officer (NFO).
- ▶ A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.
- ▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

Game Notes

- ▶ Navy shot 59.1 percent in the second half to rally for a 68-65 victory over Mount St. Mary's on Dec. 9. The Navy defense held the Mount to just 37.3 percent from the field. Navy outscored the Mount, 41-33, in the second half.
- ▶ Navy helped its second-half cause, by making 11-of-12 free throw attempts and 4-of-6 three-point tries.
- ▶ Navy has rallied from halftime deficits in four of its eight wins. Navy trailed by five at the halftime break.
- ▶ Navy has now won two games this year (Howard and Mount St. Mary's) when being held to 69 points or less. Last year, Navy went 0-6 when scoring 69 or fewer points.
- ▶ The Mids held the Mount to just 32 and 33 points in each half. Just two teams (Towson and Virginia Tech) have managed to crack 40 points in a half this year as both teams accomplished it in the second half of their respective games.
- ▶ The Midshipmen, particularly **O.J. Awworu**, held Mount's leading scorer, Jeremy Goode, to just eight points on 3-of-15 shooting. He entered the game averaging 19.9 ppg.
- ▶ The game was Navy's third in five days after defeating Penn, 76-65, on Dec. 5, and falling to Virginia Tech, 79-70, on Dec. 7.
- ▶ The win pushed Navy's record to 8-2 overall, matching its best 10-game start since the 1983-84 team started the season 9-1. The 1998-99 and 1984-85 teams also started their seasons 8-2.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina** scored at least 26 points for the fifth time in the last seven games. He tallied 16 of Navy's last 25 points in the second half and scored 20 of Navy's 41 second-half points all together. Kina also moved into 17th place on the school's career scoring list with 1,195 points.
- ▶ Awworu hauled down a season-high seven rebounds. The seven boards were just two off his career high.
