Navy's Gameday Facts

- ▶ Navy closes out the non-conference portion of its schedule on Monday, Jan. 5, as it travels down I-95 to battle Elon in a 7:00 pm tipoff. The contest, which will be the first meeting between the two schools, will be broadcast on the radio waves on WNAV (1430 AM) and SIRIUS (Channel 123), beginning with the Navy pregame show at 6:45 pm. **Pete Medhurst** will handle the call from Elon's Alumni Gym.
- ▶ It will be Navy's second straight game against a Southern Conference team, as the Mids defeated Wofford, 75-70, on Friday night in Annapolis.
- ▶ Navy is looking for its 11th win in non-conference play for only the third time since joining the Patriot League in 1991-92. The 1998-99 and 1999-2000 teams won 11 non-conference games each.
- ▶ Navy has lost two straight road games (68-63 to Canisius on Dec. 20; 78-68 to 18th-ranked Villanova on Dec. 22), and boasts a 3-4 record in games away from Annapolis. Navy is 7-0 at home.
- ▶ The Mids have won their final tune-ups before conference play in each of the last two seasons. Navy defeated NJIT, 52-50, in the 2006-07 season, and Longwood, 73-55, in the 2007-08 season. The Mids will open Patriot League play on Saturday, Jan. 10, with a 5:00 pm tipoff against Bucknell in Annapolis on ESPN2.
- ▶ Navy shot 50.0 percent from the field for the second straight game in the Mids' 75-70 win over Wofford.
- ▶ After allowing just four of the first 11 opponents to reach 70 points, Navy has allowed each of its last three foes to score at least 70 points. However, no team has managed to shoot 50 percent from the field against the Mids.
- ▶ Navy continues to lead the Patriot League in scoring at 74.2 ppg. The Midshipmen have led the league in scoring in three of the past four years under **Billy Lange**.
- ▶ Navy boasts two of the Patriot League's top three scorers in **Kaleo Kina** (1st - 19.6 ppg) and **Chris Harris** (3rd - 16.2 ppg).
- ▶ Lange won his 99th career game against Wofford. He is now 99-89 in his seventh year as a collegiate head coach, including 60-70 in his fifth year at Navy. He went 39-19 in two years as the head coach at the US Merchant Marine Academy.

A Navy Win Would...

- ▶ be Navy's third in a row, improving Navy to 11-4 overall.
- ▶ give Navy 11 non-conference wins for just the third time since joining the Patriot League in 1991-92.
- ▶ even Navy's record away from Annapolis to 4-4, and snap a two-game road losing streak.
- ▶ be Billy Lange's 100th career victory in his seventh season as a college coach.
- ▶ improve Navy's overall record against SoCon opponents to 12-13, and be the third win in a row against the league.

Series History

- ▶ Friday night's game will be the first meeting all-time between Navy and Elon.
- ▶ Navy is 11-13 all-time against the Southern Conference, after defeating Wofford, 75-70, on Friday night in Annapolis.
- ▶ Navy has played just six of the 11 teams that make up the Southern Conference. Elon will be opponent No. 7.

Elon Scouting Report

- ▶ Elon enters the game with a 4-5 overall record and is 1-1 in Southern Conference games.
- ▶ The Phoenix lost to Maryland, 76-50, in its last outing on Dec. 30. The loss to Maryland snapped a three-game winning streak.
- ▶ Elon's other four losses have come to West Virginia, Tenn.-Martin, Virginia Tech and College of Charleston.
- ▶ Both Navy (79-70) and Elon (76-67) loss to Virginia Tech by nine points.
- ▶ Elon is led by Brett James (15.6 ppg, 5.2 rpg) and Ola Atoyebi (14.2 ppg, 5.8 rpg) in both scoring and rebounding. Chris Long has 58 assists in nine games (6.4 apg).
- ▶ Otoyebi is shooting a sizzling 59.5 percent from the field.
- ▶ Elon is averaging 66.3 ppg and giving up 71.1 ppg. The Phoenix is shooting 44.5 percent from the field, 36.1 percent from three-point range and just 61.8 percent from the free throw line.
- ▶ Opponents are shooting 44.6 percent and 33.3 percent from three-point range.
- ▶ Elon averages 15.0 turnovers per game, but are among the nation's leaders in assists (16.4 apg). The Phoenix have an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.10.
- ▶ Navy's **Chris Harris** and Elon's Scott Grable were teammates at Fork Union Military Academy. Both players are juniors on their respective teams.

Looking Ahead

- ▶ The Mids will open Patriot League play on Saturday, Jan. 10, at Alumni Hall against rival Bucknell. The game will be aired nationally on ESPNU, tipping off at 5:00 pm (ET). It will be the first game against the Bison since the memorable triple-overtime game in the Patriot League Quarterfinals last year.
- ▶ Following the league opener against Bucknell, Navy will head to the Lehigh Valley to face Lehigh (Jan. 14) and Lafayette (Jan. 17) in Patriot League action.

Last Time Out - Navy 75, Wofford 70

- ▶ Navy completed a perfect home non-conference schedule with a 7-0 mark. It is the first time Navy has gone undefeated at home in non-conference play since Alumni Hall was built in 1991-92, also the first year Navy joined the Patriot League. In addition, Navy has won nine straight non-conference home games.
- ▶ The Mids shot 50.0 for the second straight game, and have shot at least 45.0 percent in five games this year. Last year, Navy shot 45.0 percent just eight times for the entire year.
- ▶ Wofford's 48.3 percent was a season best for a Navy foe this year, surpassing the 47.3 percent shot by William & Mary.
- ▶ Navy placed five players in double figures for the first time since Dec. 4, 2006, against Howard (65 games). Navy didn't have a 20-point scorer for just the third time this year and first time since Nov. 18, 2007 (10 games).
- ▶ Navy is now 7-0 this year and 38-7 under Lange when shooting more free throws than its foes.
- ▶ When Navy shoots 45 percent or better, the Mids are 6-0 this year. When Navy has a higher percentage than its opponents from the field, Navy is also 6-0 and 37-8 under Lange.

- ▶ Navy is 6-0 this year when shooting more free throws than its foe this year (38-7 under Lange).
- ▶ Navy is 8-1 this year when scoring at least 70 points (50-20 under Lange).
- ▶ Navy won its ninth game before New Year's Day for just the fourth time in school history. The other times came in the 2006-07 (9-5), 1998-99 (9-3) and 1983-84 (9-2) seasons.

Offense Performs Efficiently vs. Wofford

- ▶ Navy tied a season low with nine turnovers against the Terriers and had 16 assists to boot. The 1.78 assist-to-turnover ratio is a season best, and the highest since Feb. 27, 2008 vs. American (18 assists; 8 turnovers). It was the fourth-highest assist-to-turnover ratio in the Billy Lange era.
- ▶ In addition, Navy shot at least 50.0 percent for the second straight game. The Mids made 51.6 percent of their first-half shots and 47.8 percent in the second half.

- ▶ Navy has held five of its opponents to under 40.0 percent from the field, posting a 4-1 record. When Navy holds its foes to under 45.0 percent shooting, Navy is 8-3. Ironically, when opponents shot over 45.0 percent, Navy is 2-1.

- ▶ Colgate was the last team to shoot over 50.0 percent against the Mids, coming on Feb. 2, 2008.
- ▶ Navy is 16-6 during the 22-game span.

Kina In Elite Company

▶ **Kaleo Kina** became the fourth Navy player with 150 career steals and the third of the four to score 1,000 points. **Chris Williams** and **David Robinson** are the other two Navy players with 1,000 points and 150 steals.

▶ Kina needs 12 rebounds for 400 in his career and reaching that plateau would make him the first Navy player and fifth Patriot Leaguer to reach 1,000 points, 400 rebounds, 300 assists and 150 career steals, joining Holy Cross' **Torey Thomas**, **Kevin Hamilton** and **Jave Meade** and Lafayette's **Brian Ehlers** as league players to reach that mark.

Kina Off to Fantastic Start

▶ Senior guard **Kaleo Kina** has provided the bulk of Navy's offense this year, scoring in double figures in all 14 games (17 in a row overall) and leading the league in scoring at 19.6 ppg. He also ranks fifth in rebounding, ninth in steals and 10th in assists.

▶ Kina has led the team in scoring in nine of Navy's games so far this year, leading the Mids to a 7-2 record when that happens.

▶ Kina has scored at least 21 points in seven of the last 11 games, leading the Mids to a 6-1 record when he scores at least 21 points.

▶ Had a five-game stretch against William & Mary, UMES, Radford, Texas-San Antonio and Penn, where he averaged 24.8 ppg, 6.2 rpg and 2.6 apg.

▶ Won three straight Patriot League Player of the Week accolades on Dec. 1, Dec. 8, Dec. 15.

▶ Needs 38 points and 12 rebounds to become only the third Patriot League player with 1,300 career points, 400 career rebounds, 300 career assists and 150 career steals, showing off his versatility.

▶ Was honored as one of four finalists for Mid-Major Hon-Player of the Week on Dec. 15, by the website, collegehoopsnet.com.

Kina, Harris Rack Up Weekly Awards

▶ With just seven Player of the Week awards being handed out so far by the Patriot League, Navy has dominated the honor.

▶ A Navy player has been named Player of the Week in four of the last five weeks. **Kaleo Kina** earned the award on Dec. 1, 8 and 15, and **Chris Harris** won the award on Dec. 29. It marked the first time two Navy teammates have won the award in the same season since the 1999-2000 season when Sitapha Savane and Chris Williams both won weekly awards.

Kina In Elite Company, Part II

▶ **Kaleo Kina** was named Patriot League Player of the Week on Monday, Dec. 15, for the third straight week, after scoring 26 points with seven rebounds, four assists and a blocked shot against Mount St. Mary's. He also earned the award on Dec. 1 and Dec. 8.

Teague Gives Mids a Boost

▶ Senior forward **Adam Teague** has given the Navy offense a boost both off the bench and in the starting lineup.

▶ Teague ranks third on the team in scoring at 10.9 ppg and has chipped in with seven double-figure games this year. When Teague scores in double figures this year, the Mids are 6-1 and when he reaches double figures for his career, Navy is a brilliant 17-7.

▶ Teague reached double-figures for the first time since Dec. 7, in the win over Wofford, connecting for 16 points on 6-of-9 shooting. In the previous four games, Teague averaged 7.8 ppg while shooting just 10-of-30 (.333) from the field and 8-of-26 (.308) from three-point range.

▶ Teague is also well-represented on the Patriot League charts, ranking 13th in scoring, 16th in rebounding, eighth in field goal percentage, fourth in three-point percentage, fourth in three-pointers per game, 10th in blocked shots and ninth in defensive rebounds per game.

▶ Teague moved into fourth place on the career three-pointers list with 149, when he made three against Wofford. He is also tied for sixth on the career three-point percentage chart (.384).

Colbert Does the Little Things

▶ Senior guard **Clif Colbert** does all the little things that don't appear on the scoresheet and is always around the ball.

▶ Colbert is averaging career highs in points (5.1), rebounds (4.5) and minutes (17.8), while shooting 46.8 percent from the field. He is just 2-of-15 (.133) from three-point range, but both three-pointers have come in the last two games in key spots. He is 27-of-47 (.574) from inside the three-point arc.

▶ Per 40 minutes this season, Colbert is averaging 11.5 ppg and 10.1 rpg. For his career per 40 minutes, Colbert is averaging 13.1 ppg, 8.3 rpg and 3.2 spg.

▶ After slumping for about five games, Colbert has turned it on again the last two games, averaging 9.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg and 1.0 spg in just 18.0 mpg. He is 7-of-10 from the field.

Veazey Gives a Presence In the Middle

▶ Sophomore center **Mark Veazey** has improved significantly over the last year and head coach **Billy Lange** says his development is one of the keys to Navy's league season.

▶ Veazey has scored in double figures in four games this year, helping Navy to a 4-0 record in those games. In addition, when Veazey leads the team in rebounding, Navy is 6-1. When he doesn't, the Mids are just 4-3.

▶ In the first six games Veazey played this year (he missed the opener against Towson with an injury), he averaged 8.8 ppg, 7.2 rpg and 1.3 bpg while shooting 17-of-28 (.607) from the field in 27.5 mpg.

▶ In the last seven games, Veazey is averaging 6.7 ppg, 5.3 rpg and 0.9 bpg while shooting 20-of-41 (.488) from the field in 24.9 mpg.

▶ It is important for Veazey to stay in the game and not get into foul trouble. In games he has played at least 30 minutes, the Mids are 4-1. In games under 30 minutes, Navy is 6-3.

▶ In addition in four Navy losses, Veazey has not attempted a free throw yet and is averaging just 4.3 rpg. In 10 Navy wins, Veazey has shot 31 free throw attempts and is averaging 6.7 rpg.

Navy Off To A Fast Start

▶ Since 1938-39 (first year of the NCAA Tournament), Navy has started 8-2 or better 11 previous times. Five of those teams made the NCAA Tournament (1947, 1953, 1954, 1960 and 1985). Four of the last five teams that started 8-2 or better reached the NCAA Tournament.

Mids Set the Nets on Fire

▶ Navy has struggled at times from the field this year, but you would have never known it on Dec. 2 against Texas-San Antonio. After missing its first five shots of the game, Navy connected on 25 of its last 30 field goal attempts (.833), including 7-of-8 from three-point range (.875), in the game's last 34 minutes.

▶ Navy finished the game shooting 71.4 percent from the field, the first time over 70.0 percent since Feb. 24, 1987, and the fourth-highest percentage in school history. In addition, Navy's 84.2 percent in the second half was tied for the third-best percentage in a half in school history, and the 71.4 over-all percentage is the highest in the NCAA this year.

▶ Not only did Navy shoot well from the field against UTSA, but the Mids also found themselves in the record books in three-point percentage as well. Navy shot 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from beyond the arc, and after missing its first

three three-point attempts, the Mids finished the game making seven of their last eight attempts. The percentage is tied for the seventh-best three-point performance in school history.

Going The Extra Minute

▶ Navy has already played in a pair of overtime games this year, posting a 2-0 record in those games. The Mids defeated William & Mary, 102-99, in three overtimes on Nov. 22, then topped Radford, 73-71, in one overtime on Nov. 29. Navy improved to 6-4 under head coach **Billy Lange** in overtime games.

▶ In addition, Navy's triple-overtime battle with William & Mary gave Navy two three-overtime games in a five-game span after falling to Bucknell, 87-86, in three overtimes in the final game of the 2007-08 season. Not official, but playing two three-overtime games in a span of five games is believed to be an NCAA first.

▶ Navy played in just one triple-overtime game in the first 101 years and 2,116 games in school history.

▶ In the win over William & Mary, **Chris Harris** played every second, setting a school record with 55 minutes played. The 36 points scored in the overtime sessions also was a school record.

Seniors Learn of Their Service Selections

▶ Navy's four seniors all earned their post-graduate service selections in a ceremony on Wednesday, Nov. 19.

▶ **Clif Colbert**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** all received Surface Warfare Officer (SWO), while **Brian Richards** received Naval Flight Officer (NFO).

▶ A Surface Warfare Officer manages and motivates personnel, assumes responsibility for multimillion-dollar systems and equipment on the world's most powerful vessels and gains valuable insight from traveling the world. It provides officers with experience that is invaluable to employers in the private sector.

▶ A Naval Flight Officer (often called a "backseater") is an officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps that specializes in airborne weapons and sensor systems. NFOs are not pilots (naval aviators), but they may perform many "co-pilot" functions, depending on the type of aircraft.

- ▶ Navy's 84.2 percent shooting in the second half is third only to a 15-of-17 (.882) performance against East Carolina (1-30-84) and a 17-of-20 (.850) showing against Lafayette (1-18-84).
- ▶ Navy's 71.4 percent shooting is fourth behind Lafayette (1-18-84 / .737 on 28-of-38), Fairfield (2-6-85 / .725 of 37-of-51 shooting) and Richmond (2-24-87 / .723 on 34-of-47 shooting). The percentage is the best single-game performance in the country so far this year. Before tonight, the top six percentage performances came from 1983 to 1987. In addition, Navy missed its first five shot attempts from the fie field and first three three-point tries. Over the last 34 minutes, Navy was 25-of-30 (.833) from the field and 7-of8 (.875) from three-point range.
- ▶ Navy's 35 field goal attempts are the second fewest in a game since the 1979-80 season. The lowest was 34 against Air Force on Jan. 3, 2005.
- ▶ The Mids are 5-0 at Alumni Hall and have won seven straight non-conference home games.
- ▶ Navy's six-game non-conference win streak equals the third longest in program history. The longest was a 13-game non-conference streak from Feb. 7, 1983, to Dec. 10, 1983.
- ▶ Navy has held six straight foes to 66 points or less in regulation time only.
- ▶ Navy's 27 turnovers were a season high and the most since committing 27 against Texas-San Antonio on Nov. 17, 2007.
- ▶ **Kaleo Kina's** 29 points were one off a career high set when he scored 30 points against Radford last Saturday night. Over the last two games, Kina is 23-of-33 from the free throw line after going 11-of-15 tonight and 12-of-18 against Radford. Kina is averaging 24.0 ppg, 6.8 rpg and 2.8 apg in the last four outings. Kina went over 1,100 points in the contest.

Longwood had trailed 49-34 with 19:00 left, and 64-51 with 9:15 to play, but took an 80-79 lead with 11.2 seconds left on a Kevin Swecker jumper. Kina was fouled while going to the hoop, made both free throws, and E.J. Dawson's lay-up at the buzzer rolled off the front of the rim allowing Navy to escape with the one-point victory.
- ▶ Navy ended the first half on a 19-7 run over the last 5:58.
- ▶ The win over Longwood gives Navy a 6-0 series advantage. The six-game win streak is the longest active streak for the Mids over a single foe.
- ▶ Navy improved to 4-0 this year in games decided by three or fewer points. Since the start of last year, Navy is 6-2 in such games.
- ▶ The Mids improved to 6-0 this year when attempting more free throws and 37-7 under **Billy Lange**.
- ▶ Navy also improved to 5-0 this year and 36-8 under Lange when shooting a better percentage from the field than its opponent.
- ▶ Kina tallied his 16th straight double-figure scoring game, dating back to last year. He also recorded his seventh 20-point game of the year. Lastly, he moved into 14th place on the school's career scoring list with 1,252 points.
- ▶ **Chris Harris** tallied his ninth double-figure scoring game of the year and 35th of his career. When Harris scores in double figures this year, the Mids are 8-1. He has five 20-point games on the season now after his 20-point effort against Longwood. Harris has also made a three-pointer in 34 straight games.
